

#### San Francisco Giants (2-4) at Los Angeles Dodgers (6-2) LHP Kyle Harrison (1-0, 3.00) vs. RHP Tyler Glasnow (1-0, 2.45)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Dodgers play the final game of this three-game series...the Giants need a win tonight to avoid being swept by the Dodgers for the first time in a series of three-or-more games since Sept. 16-18, 2022, and for the first time in a series of three-or-more games here at Dodger Stadium since July 21-24 (four games).

- The Giants enter tonight having lost 13 of their last 18 games to the Dodgers here at Dodger Stadium, dating back to 2022.
- For the first time in franchise history, the Dodgers have scored five-plus runs in each of their first eight games.
- ▶ The Giants meanwhile, have allowed 41 runs in the first six games...that is the second-most runs allowed in the SF-era through the teams first six games of a season, behind the 1983 team (43)...only the Padres (52), Rockies (49) and A's (43) have allowed more runs than the Giants this season.

**TONIGHT'S STARTER: LHP Kyle Harrison** makes his second start of the season tonight...ranked as the #22 prospect across the Majors according to MLB.com, Harrison faced the Dodgers twice last season and allowed just two runs on three hits in 10.1 innings (1.74 ERA).

The Giants could use some innings from Harrison tonight as SF starters have combined for just 10.2 innings over the past three games, allowing 17 runs (13 earned)...the Giants' bullpen has thrown 13.1 innings in that span.

**BYE BYE BABY:** The Giants have hit at least one home run in all six of their games to start the season...it is San Francisco's longest streak of games with a homer to start a season since 2016 (10-straight).

▶ OF Michael Conforto paces the team with three home runs this season...his three homers are tied for the third-most in the NL...Conforto has reached base safely in each of his first six games, slashing .391/.440/.870 (9-for-23) with eight runs scored, two doubles, three homers, seven RBI and two walks.

**BIRTHDAY WISHES:** Happy Birthday to Giants **C Tom Murphy**, who turns 33 years old today.

**WITHIN THE DIVISION:** The Giants continue a divisionalheavy early-season schedule after splitting four games in San Diego this past weekend...the Giants host the Padres for three games this weekend at Oracle Park then play the Diamondbacks for four in two weeks...14 of SF's first 23 games come against division opponents.

**THE REAL BAY AREA BOB: Bob Melvin** was named the 39th manager in club history on October 25, 2023..the Bay Areaborn and raised Melvin played with the Giants from 1986-1988, appearing in 265 games.

**DEBUT DAY: Bob Melvin** announced to media that 2023 NL Cy Young Award winner **LHP Blake Snell** will make his Giants debut this Monday against the Washington Nationals at Oracle Park...Snell signed a two-year, \$62 million contract with the Giants exactly two weeks ago on March 19.

**IN THE BULLPEN:** The Giants' bullpen has not been at its best through the first six games, accounting for 22.1 innings, 20 earned runs, four home runs, 13 walks and 22 strikeouts.

- The Giants have had four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past six games (RHP Nick Avila, LHP Erik Miller, RHP Landen Roupp, RHP Kai-Wei Teng).
- SF's bullpen ERA of 8.06 (20er, 20.2ip) is the second-highest in MLB ahead of only the Phillies (8.71).
- Every reliever has been scored up expect for RHP Landen Roupp.

**GRIND UNTIL THE CLOCK STOPS:** It was yet another busy offseason for the Giants and they used every bit of it, rounding out this roster by signing reigning Cy Young Award winner **LHP Blake Snell** just two weeks ago...below is a look at SF's key signings and trade acquisitions this past offseason.

**HOME OPENER THIS FRIDAY:** The Giants host the Padres this Friday for the start of a three-game series and six-game homestand that also includes a three-game matchup with the Washington Nationals next Monday-Wednesday.

- SF is 40-26 (.606) in home openers since 1958, including a 16-8 mark (.667) at Oracle Park (since 2000)...SF has won 16 of their last 23 home openers.
- ▶ SF went 45-36 (.556) at home in 2023 and since 2020, the Giants have played good baseball on the Shores of McCovey Cove...since 2020, SF is 162-114 (.587) at Oracle Park, sixthbest in MLB and third-best in the NL in that stretch...only the Dodgers (194-86, .693) and Braves (168-104, .618) have been better at home since 2020.

**ABOUT KYLE:** The No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned win #1 last Friday at San Diego, limiting the Padres to two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings of SF's 8-3 victory...completed 6.0 innings only once in his seven big league starts last season, but managed to match that mark in his first appearance this season...threw his fastball 55 times out of his 76 total pitches (72%).

**SPRING TRAINING:** Went 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) in four Cactus League starts...struck out 17 batters and issued eight walks...did not allow a home run...his last Cactus League start came last Saturday, March 23, in which he tossed 3.1 innings and allowed four runs on five hits and four walks against Arizona.

**2023 SEASON:** Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected... went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors this year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

**CURRENTLY THE #2:** Is currently slotted behind **RHP Logan Webb** for the number 2 spot in the starting rotation, but will slide back to the third or fouth slot once **LHP Blake Snell** joins the rotation this upcoming Monday...as told to the San Francisco Chronicle this spring, in 2018 while a student at De La Salle-Concord, Harrison met Snell, then with the Rays, after a Giants game he was attending as a fan...he remembers Snell making a point of coming out to shake his hand and offer advice..."he just told me to throw strikes," Harrison said.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the south-paw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

**AGAINST LOS ANGELES:** Faced the Dodgers twice last year and allowed two runs on three hits in 10.1 innings...looking for his first career win against the Dodgers.

**CAN'T TOUCH THIS:** Tossed 5.0 innings of no-hit ball in his last start of the year last year on October 1 vs. the Dodgers... struck out five and walked three to become the first Giants rookie to exit with a no-hitter intact through 5.0 innings since **Chris Heston** threw a no-hitter on June 9, 2015...Harrison also became the third rookie in the SF era to accomplish that feat (also: **Jim Barr** on September 11, 1971).

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball **Last Game:** 4/1 at LAD; 2.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2k (38 pitches)

- Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Monday and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first action Triple-A action...went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.
- Spring Stats: 3.97 ERA, 11.1ip, 10h, 5er, bb, 15k, 0.97 WHIP (7g).

#### #75 CAMILO DOVAL► RHP

#### Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 3/30 at SD; 0.2ip, h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 1hr (17 pitches) Made his third Opening Day roster.

- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only
   Rod Beck in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
   The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since Brian Wilson (48 in '10).
- Spring Stats: 1.50 ERA, 6.0ip, 5h, r, er, 2bb, 7k, 1.17 WHIP (6g).

#### #68 ERIK MILLER > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/1 at LAD; 0.1ip, h, 2r, 2er, bb (10 pitches)

- Made his first career Opening Day roster...the southpaw was recalled from AAA on Thursday and made his debut that night.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 30 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- In five spring outings, Miller gave up one earned run (a HR) on four hits (.211 avg) with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings.
- Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.
- Spring Stats: 1.93 ERA, 4.2ip, 4h, er, 2bb, 6k, 1.29 WHIP (5g).

#### #33 TAYLOR ROGERS > LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

- Last Game: 4/2 at LAD; 0.2ip, h, bb (13 pitches)
- Made his eighth Opening Day roster, second with SF.
- Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
   Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with
   2.82 EPA and averaging 11.15 SO/0 (444, 51.2)
- a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
  Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).
- Spring Stats: 6.14 ERA, 7.1ip, 7h, 5er, 7bb, 13k, 1.91 WHIP (8g).

#### #71 TYLER ROGERS ► RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

- Last Game: 4/1 at LAD; 0.2ip, h, r, er, hr, 2k (13 pitches)
- Made his fifth Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco).
- Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
- Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (265g).
