TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Dodgers play the final game of this three-game series...the Giants need a win tonight to avoid being swept by the Dodgers for the first time in a series of three-or-more games since Sept. 16-18, 2022, and for the first time in a series of three-or-more games here at Dodger Stadium since July 21-24 (four games).

- The Giants enter tonight having lost 13 of their last 18 games to the Dodgers here at DodgerStadium, dating back to 2022
- For the first time in franchise history, the Dodgers have scored five-plus runs in each of their first eight games.
- The Giants meanwhile, have allowed 41 runs in the first six games...that is the second-most runs allowed in the SF-era through the teams first six games of a season, behind the 1983 team (43)...only the Padres (52), Rockies (49) and A's (43) have allowed more runs than the Giants this season

TONIGHT'S STARTER: LHP Kyle Harrison makes his second start of the season tonight...ranked as the \#22 prospect across the Majors according to MLB.com, Harrison faced the Dodgers twice last season and allowed just two runs on three hits in 10.1 innings ( 1.74 ERA).

- The Giants could use some innings from Harrison tonight as SF starters have combined for just 10.2 innings over the past three games, allowing 17 runs ( 13 earned) ...the Giants bullpen has thrown 13.1 innings in that span.

BYE BYE BABY: The Giants have hit at least one home run in all six of their games to start the season...it is San Francisco's longest streak of games with a homer to start a season since 2016 (10-straight).

- OF Michael Conforto paces the team with three home runs this season....his three homers are tied for the third-most in the NL...Conforto has reached base safely in each of his first six games, slashing .391/.440/.870 (9-for-23) with eight runs scored, two doubles, three homers, seven RBI and two walks.

BIRTHDAY WISHES: Happy Birthday to Giants C Tom Murphy, who turns 33 years old today.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: The Giants continue a divisionalheavy early-season schedule after splitting four games in San Diego this past weekend...the Giants host the Padres for three games this weekend at Oracle Park then play the Diamondbacks for four in two weeks... 14 of SF's first 23 games come against division opponents.
the real bay Area bob: Bob Melvin was named the 39th manager in club history on October 25, 2023..the Bay Areaborn and raised Melvin played with the Giants from 19861988, appearing in 265 games

DEBUT DAY: Bob Melvin announced to media that 2023 NL Cy Young Award winner LHP Blake Snell will make his Giants debut this Monday against the Washington Nationals at Oracle Park...Snell signed a two-year, $\$ 62$ million contract with the Giants exactly two weeks ago on March 19.


IN THE BULLPEN: The Giants' bullpen has not been at its best through the first six games, accounting for 22.1 innings, 20 earned runs, four home runs, 13 walks and 22 strikeouts.

- The Giants have had four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past six games (RHP Nick Avila, LHP Erik Miller, RHP Landen Roupp, RHP Kai-Wei Teng)
- SF's bullpen ERA of 8.06 (20er, 20.2ip) is the second-highest in MLB ahead of only the Phillies (8.71)
- Every reliever has been scored up expect for RHP Landen Roupp
GRIND UNTIL THE CLOCK STOPS: It was yet another busy offseason for the Giants and they used every bit of it, rounding out this roster by signing reigning Cy Young Award winner LHP Blake Snell just two weeks ago....below is a look at SF's key signings and trade acquisitions this past offseason.


HOME OPENER THIS FRIDAY: The Giants host the Padres this Friday for the start of a three-game series and six-game homestand that also includes a three-game matchup with the Washington Nationals next Monday-Wednesday.

- SF is 40-26 (.606) in home openers since 1958, including a 16-8 mark (.667) at Oracle Park (since 2000)...SF has won 16 of their last 23 home openers
- SF went 45-36 (.556) at home in 2023 and since 2020, the Giants have played good baseball on the Shores of McCovey Cove...since 2020, SF is 162-114 (.587) at Oracle Park, sixthbest in MLB and third-best in the NL in that stretch....only the Dodgers (194-86, .693) and Braves (168-104, .618) have been better at home since 2020 .

ABOUT KYLE: The No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to MLB.com and Baseball America...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned win \#1 last Friday at San Diego, limiting the Padres to two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings of SF's 8-3 victory...completed 6.0 innings only once in his seven big league starts last season, but managed to match that mark in his first appearance this season...threw his fastball 55 times out of his 76 total pitches (72\%).
SPRING TRAINING: Went 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) in four Cactus League starts...struck out 17 batters and issued eight walks...did not allow a home run...his last Cactus League start came last Saturday, March 23, in which he tossed 3.1 innings and allowed four runs on five hits and four walks against Arizona.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected.. went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2 ip ) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6\%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors this year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip)
CURRENTLY THE \#2: Is currently slotted behind RHP Logan Webb for the number 2 spot in the starting rotation, but will slide back to the third or fouth slot once LHP Blake Snell joins the rotation this upcoming Monday...as told to the San Francisco Chronicle this spring, in 2018 while a student at De La Salle-Concord, Harrison met Snell, then with the Rays, after a Giants game he was attending as a fan...he remembers Snell making a point of coming out to shake his hand and offer advice..."he just told me to throw strikes," Harrison said.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since Madison Bumgarner in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).
