AROUND THE HORN

VOTE D-BACKS: Phase 1 voting is open on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot for the MLB All-Star Game thru June 25 (9:00 a.m. AZ) exclusively online and via mobile devices at dbacks.com/vote, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App.

D-BACKS TO HOST ARIZONA CARDINALS ROOKIE CLASS MONDAY: On Monday, June 15, the D-backs will welcome the Arizona Cardinals 2026 rookie class to the game with a special pregame recognition and a ceremonial first pitch thrown by first-round pick Jeremiyah Love.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 9-5 in their last 14 games vs. Reds.

- The D-backs are 90-90 all-time vs. Reds, including 49-44 on the road.
- The D-backs seek their first series win in June and fifth series win vs. Reds in their last 6.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 1 win shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure to become MLB's eighth active manager and 106th all-time manager to reach the feat.
- **Michael Soroka's** 8 wins are tied for most among NL starters with Chris Sale/ATL and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI...in his last 3 road starts (@ TEX, @ COL, @ SF), is 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4 ER in 18.0 IP), opponent .197 AVG (13-for-66), 0.89 WHIP, 3 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 games since June 2, hitting .353 (12-for-34)/.774 OPS with 1 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13, has reached base safely in 20 of his last 23 games, hitting .309 (25-for-81)/.919 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 14 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-2 @ Reds last night in a season-long 3 hour and 29-minute game.

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, tied 2-2 with 2 outs in the top of the ninth, knocked in the go-ahead third run on a fly to left field that resulted in a missed catch (E7).
- **Nolan Arenado**, in the bottom of the eighth inning with runners on first and second, made a game-saving play on a 105.0 MPH grounder down the third-base line for the putout at first to hold the tie.
- **Corbin Carroll** (1), **Geraldo Perdomo** (1), **Jordan Lawlar** (2) and **Gabriel Moreno** (1) combined for a season-high 5 stolen bases...first time with 5+ stolen bases in a game since April 17, 2025 @ Marlins (6).
- **Jordan Lawlar** (2-for-4, 2 RBI, 2 SB), in his return off the injured list, had his first career multi-stolen base game and multi-RBI game.
- **LuJames Groover** delivered a game-tying single in the sixth inning.
- 5 relievers - **Ryan Thompson**, **Jonathan Loaisiga**, **Taylor Clarke**, **Kevin Ginkel** (W) and **Paul Sewald** (SV) - combined for 6.1 scoreless innings.

RAKING ON THE ROAD: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely 2+ times in 10 of his last 12 road games since May 13, hitting .405 (17-for-42)/1.119 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 9 walks.

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached safely in 11 of his last 14 road games, including 2+ times in 9 games, with an .852 OPS, 3 doubles, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 9 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 13 road games with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 5 walks.

THE BULLPEN: The D-backs' bullpen, since May 1, ranks among MLB in hits (1st, 89), homers (1st, 6), earned runs per game (2nd, 0.97), earned runs (T-2nd, 38) and extra-base hits (T-3rd, 30).

RELIEVER FOCUS: Since May 1, **Taylor Clarke** (1.29 ERA) and **Kevin Ginkel** (1.38 ERA) have posted the ninth and 10th lowest ERA's among NL relievers (min. 15 G).

- **Ryan Thompson** has 17 consecutive scoreless road appearances (since March 26), tied for the third-longest active road scoreless reliever streak with Robert Suarez/SD-ATL (since Sept. 21, 2025), behind Mason Miller/SD (20 since Aug. 6, 2025) and Luke Weaver/NYY-NYM (18 since Sept. 17, 2025).
- **Kevin Ginkel** is scoreless in 6 straight games and has stranded 11 of his 16 inherited runners.
- **Paul Sewald** is scoreless in 9 of his last 10 appearances with 7 saves...his opponent .202 OBP ranks fourth among relievers (min. 20 G) while his opponent .138 AVG ranks ninth.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: **Ketel Marte** ranks among NL second basemen in homers (2nd, 11), extra-base hits (2nd, 27) and RBI (3rd, 40)...defensively, is the only qualified second baseman without an error.

- **Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in triples (1st, 8), extra-base hits (T-1st, 34), OPS (3rd, .916), SLG (4th, .543) and OBP (5th, .372).
- **Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in SLG (2nd, .416), doubles (2nd, 12), OPS (3rd, .744), homers (T-3rd, 8) and extra-base hits (T-4th, 20)...defensively, is tied for the second fewest errors (3) with Nolan Gorman/STL, behind Manny Machado/SD (2).

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 22 comeback wins are second most in the Majors, behind the Braves (23).

TRIPLE THREAT: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.

DEFENSE! DEFENSE! Since May 1, the D-backs' .994 fielding pct. and 8 errors (3 throwing, 4 fielding, 1 catcher) rank best in the Majors.

VS. REDS: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 series, including their last from Aug. 22-24, 2025 at home.

- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 games, including 2+ times in 7 of those, hitting .394 (13-for-33)/1.197 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 5 straight games and reached base 2+ times in 3 of those with 2 doubles, 1 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** @ Reds has reached base safely in 13 straight games, batting .360 (18-for-50)/1.248 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 10 RBI and 7 walks...has reached 2+ times in 7 of those games.

- His 1,063 strikeouts as a D-back are 2 away from tying Brandon Webb (1,065) for second most in franchise history (behind Randy Johnson's 2,077).
- Did not factor in the decision in the 10-6 loss on June 9 @ Marlins (4 ER in 5.1 IP, 9 H, 1 BB, 3 K).
- In his last 4 starts vs. Reds, is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA (7 ER in 25.2 IP), opponent .149 AVG (13-for-87), 0.78 WHIP, 7 walks and 23 strikeouts.
