AROUND THE HORN

GABRIEL MORENO SOCCER JERSEY GIVEAWAY TONIGHT: Tonight, fans can get the newest kit for their collection, courtesy of Diamondbacks BC, with the Gabriel Moreno Soccer Jersey courtesy of Wendy's for the first 20,000 fans inspired by Moreno's love for the world's game and features the team's iconic bright colors with the state flag pattern and a unique team patch on the front.

FATHER'S DAY POLO GIVEAWAY TOMORROW: Tomorrow, the D-backs give dads the gift of baseball and the annual, always-anticipated Father's Day Polo for the first 15,000 dads.

TV ON PEACOCK TOMORROW: Tomorrow's game will be a Peacock-exclusive MLB Sunday Leadoff game with Matt Vasgersian on the call with analysts Trevor Plouffe and Luis Gonzalez, and field reporter Caroline Pineda.

VOTE D-BACKS: In the first update (June 15) for NL All-Star Balloting Phase 1 voting, Nolan Arenado is third (3B), Ketel Marte is seventh (2B), Ildemaro Vargas is seventh (1B), Corbin Carroll is eighth (OF) and Gabriel Moreno is eighth (C)...2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot voting continues thru June 25 (9:00 a.m. AZ) at dbacks.com/vote, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 games.

- The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 home series (4W-1S-1L) and 9 of their 12 overall (6W-3S-3L).
- Corbin Carroll** is looking to become the first D-back all-time with 3 straight 4+-RBI games...first time in his career with consecutive 4-RBI games...is 1 of 9 D-backs (12th time) to reach the feat (last: Jake McCarthy, Aug. 10-11, 2024, 8 RBI).
- Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13, has reached base safely in a career-high 14 straight games (.314 AVG/1.004 OPS)...has reached base safely in 25 of his last 28 games, including 2+ times in 16 of them, hitting .324 (33-for-102)/.946 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 16 RBI and 15 walks.
- Nolan Arenado**, vs. Twins, has reached base safely in 16 straight games, batting .383 (23-for-60)/.997 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 4 walks... has hit safely in 16 of his 18 career games, including 9 straight.
- Ketel Marte** has an 8-game hitting streak, hitting .333 (11-for-33)/.921 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games since June 2, hitting .327 (17-for-52)/.857 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 11 walks (9 K).

LAST GAME: Won 9-5 vs. Twins last night.

- The D-backs' 8 pitchers used [Michael Soroka (1.0), Taylor Clarke (1.0), Ryan Thompson (1.0), Drey Jameson (1.2), Jonathan Loáisiga (1.1), Brandyn Garcia (1.0), Kevin Ginkel (1.0), Paul Sewald (1.0)] tied the second most in any 9.0-inning game in franchise history (14th time, first since Sept. 21, 2019 @ Padres), 1 shy of the record (9 on June 24, 2016 @ Rockies).
- Corbin Carroll** (3-for-4, 2B, 3B, 4 RBI, BB) finished a homer shy of the cycle.
- Ketel Marte** (1-for-4, HR, RBI, BB) hit his 12th homer in the sixth inning.
- Michael Soroka** exited after 1.0 inning with left glute discomfort.
- Jordan Lawlar** (2-for-4) exited after an eighth-inning leadoff single with a strained right hamstring.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled INF/OF **Tim Tawa** and LHP **Philip Abner** from Triple-A Reno, placed INF/OF **Jordan Lawlar** on the 10-day injured list (strained right hamstring) and placed RHP **Michael Soroka** on the 15-day injured list (strained left glute).

COACHING FIRST BASE TONIGHT: D-backs Outfield/Baserunning Coordinator **Peter Bourjos** served as first base coach last night and will again tonight vs. Twins for D-backs first base coach **Dave McKay** (attending a family member's wedding)....McKay will return tomorrow.

CORBIN 1 SHY OF TRIPLE KING: Corbin Carroll (52 in 560 G since 2022) is 1 triple shy of setting a new franchise record...is currently tied with Stephen Drew (52 in 773 G from 2006-12).

CARROLL'S NO-DOUBT TRIPLES: Corbin Carroll (52 triples) is 1 of 5 players since 2006 to amass 50+ triples without ever being thrown out trying to stretch a hit into a triple, with Shane Victorino/PHI-LAD-BOS-LAA (70), Charlie Blackmon/COL (68), Alcides Escobar/MIL-KC-WSH (58) and Alex Rios/TOR-CWS-TEX-KC (50).

CARROLL ADDS TO MLB HISTORY AGAIN: Corbin Carroll is the first player in MLB history to have consecutive seasons of 9+ triples and 10+ homers within the team's first 75 games of a season (9 triples/20 homers in 2025, 72 G).

- The only other player to have multiple seasons reaching the feat since 1900 was Kiki Cuyler (1925 and 1930) [h/t @SlangsOnSports].

RECENTLY WITH RISP: In their last 5 games, since June 14, the D-backs have scored 18 runs with runners in scoring position...compared to their 20 runs scored with runners in scoring position in their previous 14 games from May 30-June 13.

SWIPIN' BAGS: The D-backs are 11-for-12 in stolen bases the last 7 games (1 SB in 2 attempts in prior 14 G).

- Since May 21, the D-backs' 89.5 stolen base pct. (17-for-19) is second in the NL, behind the Cardinals (90.0, 18-for-20).

DEFENSE IS KEY: Since May 1, the D-backs' .994 fielding pct. and 10 errors (3 throwing, 6 fielding, 1 catcher) rank best and fewest, respectively, in the Majors.

- Since May 12, the D-backs' 33 double plays turned are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Royals (32).
- Since May 1, the D-backs are 1 of 3 teams to only have 1 game with 2+ errors (also: Tigers and Dodgers).

WHEN ALLOWING FIRST AND TRAILING: The D-backs' 23 wins when allowing the game's first run are most in the Majors, ahead of the Braves (17).

- The D-backs' 26 wins when trailing at any point in a game are most in the Majors, ahead of the Braves (24) and Dodgers (23).

OUTFIELD ASSISTS: Since May 15, the D-backs' 8 outfield assists rank second in the NL, behind the Dodgers (9).

- Since 2025, Corbin Carroll's 13 outfield assists rank tied for second among NL outfielders (also: Jordan Beck/COL), behind only Andy Pages/LAD (17), while **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s** 9 are tied for ninth (also: 4 others).

VS. TWINS: The D-backs are hosting the Twins at Chase Field for the sixth time ever (2004, '05, '11, '22, '24).

- Is tied for the second-longest tenured active D-back with Merrill Kelly and Kevin Ginkel, behind Ketel Marte (10th season), and is 1 of 12 D-backs all-time to play 8+ seasons: Ketel Marte (10), Nick Ahmed (10), Miguel Montero (9), David Peralta (9), **Zac Gallen (8)**, Merrill Kelly (8), Kevin Ginkel (8), Randy Johnson (8), Luis Gonzalez (8), Andrew Chafin (8), Christian Walker (8) and Paul Goldschmidt (8).

LAST START: Recorded a quality start in the 5-3 win on June 14 @ Reds (ND, 3 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 4 K).

VS. TWINS: Third start, second as a D-back.

- In his 2 career starts (both quality), is 0-1 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER in 14.0 IP), opponent .178 AVG (8-for-45), 0.93 WHIP, 5 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- In 14 career starts vs. AL Central, is 5-4 with a 3.58 ERA (35 ER in 88.0 IP), opponent .239 AVG (78-for-327), 19 walks and 85 strikeouts.

AT HOME: In his 7 home starts, is 3-2 with a 3.65 ERA (16 R-15 ER in 37.0 IP), 7 walks and 25 strikeouts.

- Ranks among D-backs starters [min. 50 GS] in strikeouts (2nd, 1,067), opponent AVG (2nd, .232), wins (3rd, 68), innings (3rd, 1046.2), starts (3rd, 184) and quality starts (3rd, 89).

GETTING GROUNDERS: His 46.7 ground ball pct. ranks eighth among qualified NL starters, behind Cristopher Sánchez/PHI (1st, 57.2 pct.), Andre Pallante/STL (2nd, 53.9 pct.), Landen Roupp/SF (3rd, 51.4 pct.), Jesús Luzardo/PHI (4th, 49.4 pct. pct.), Michael King/SD (5th, 47.6 pct.), Braxton Ashcraft/PIT (6th, 47.5 pct.) and Nolan McLean/NYM (7th, 47.1 pct.).

STARTING SATURDAYS: In 3 Saturday starts, is 1-0 (team is 2-1) with a 3.21 ERA (5 ER in 14.0 IP), 2 walks and 12 strikeouts.

1,000 INNING CLUB: Is 1 of 4 D-backs all-time to reach 1000.0 innings with the franchise (1046.2 IP) along with Randy Johnson (1630.1 IP), Brandon Webb (1319.2 IP) and Merrill Kelly (1022.2 IP).
