AT A GLANCE: The Yankees complete their nine-game road trip today with the final game of the Subway Series at Citi Field (1-1 thus far)...are 2-6 on their current road trip after being swept by Milwaukee in a three-game series, dropping two-of-three games at Baltimore and splitting their first two games at the Mets...following this series, will return home for a seven-game homestand, featuring a four-game series vs. Toronto (Mon.-Thurs.) and a three-game set vs. Tampa Bay (5/22-24).

- **Their 28-18 (.609) record is the second-best in the American League and tied with Los Angeles-NL for the fourth-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (31-15, .674), Tampa Bay (29-15, .659) and Chicago-NL (29-17, .630).
- The Yankees are 18-9 in their last 27 games (since 4/17), 19-10 in their last 29 games (since 4/15) and 20-11 in their last 31 games (since 4/13).
- Have won seven of their last nine completed series (6-2-1)...have won or split 10 of their 14 completed series this season (9-4-1).
- The Yankees' .699 differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (+91) and Los Angeles-NL (+85).
- The Yankees are 23-7 this season when scoring first.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees fell to the Mets, 6-3, on Saturday at Citi Field...**LHP Carlos Rodón** (3.2IP, 3H, 3R/2ER, 3BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP) started and suffered his first loss of the year...**CF Trent Grisham** (1-for-4, 1RBI) hit a go-ahead RBI single in the second inning...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1RBI, 1HP) hit an RBI single in the fifth inning...**RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1BB) reached base three times...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (2-for-5, 1R, 1 double) recorded his second straight multi-hit game...**RHP Jake Bird** (0.2IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 1K), **LHP Brent Hedges** (1.2IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 3K) and **LHP Tim Hill** (0.1IP, 2H, 1R/ER) each allowed a run in relief...**RHP Camilo Doval** (0.2IP) and **RHP Paul Blackburn** (1.0IP, 1H, 1BB, 1K) were each scoreless in relief.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice

has hit .305/.412/.667 (43-for-141) with 34R, 9 doubles, 14HR, 30RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 41 games this season...23 of his 43H this season have gone for extra bases (9 doubles, 14HR)...has reached base safely in 31-of-37 starts.

- **Has hit 10HR in his last 24 games (since 4/16).**
- Has hit 6HR in his last 14 Interleague games (since 8/16/25).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.12 ERA

(251.0IP, 87ER) and 255K in 46 starts this season...marks the **third-best ERA in the Majors**, trailing only Tampa Bay (2.93) and Atlanta (2.95)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 24 of their last 27 starts (since 4/17), including 2ER-or-fewer in 20 of those starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 13 starts...have posted a 2.93 ERA (147.2IP, 48ER) over that span.

- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 39 of their 46 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most starts in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 46 games of a season**, trailing only their 42 starts in 2022.
- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.316), opponents' OPS (.596) and HR/9.0IP (0.75)**, rank second in opponents' BA (.207, first in AL) and strikeout rate (25.1%, first in AL), third in strikeouts (255, first in AL), ERA (3.12, second in AL), opponents' OBP (.279, second in AL) and WHIP (1.09, second in AL), tied for fifth in innings pitched (251.0, tied for third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.04, third in AL) and K/9.0IP (9.14, third in AL), and eighth in BB/9.0IP (3.01, fourth in AL).

RISPY BUSINESS: Yankees batters have hit .322/.402/.541 (66-for-205) with 12 doubles, 3 triples, 9HR, 92RBI, 32BB/6IBB, 1HP and 8SF with RISP over their last 26 games (since 4/18).

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge reached base three times on Saturday at the Mets...has reached base multiple times in nine of his last 15 games (since 5/1) and 16 of his last 24 games (since 4/21), hitting .313/.472/.627 (26-for-83) with 20R, 5 doubles, 7HR, 14RBI, 24BB/5IBB, 1HP and 15B over that 24-game span.

- Has reached base in 37 of his last 40 games (since 4/3), batting .298/.441/.652 (42-for-141) with 36R, 8 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 34BB/5IBB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.
- 24 of his 45H this season have been extra-base hits (8 doubles, 16HR).
- **Has hit .333/.538/.778 (9-for-27) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/5IBB and 1HP with RISP this season.**
- Has hit .305/.396/.712 (36-for-118) with 24R, 6 doubles, 14HR, 26RBI, 16BB/2IBB, 3HP, 2SF and 15B in 33 career games vs. the Mets...**has 9HR in his last 18 games against New York-NL** (since 9/11/21)...**has hit 9HR in 19 career games at Citi Field against the Mets, including 7HR in his last 11 games at the venue** (since 9/11/21).

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham hit a go-ahead RBI single in the second inning on Saturday at the Mets...has hit .300/.343/.800 (9-for-30) with 1 double, 1 triple, 4HR, 24RBI, 3BB and 2SF with RISP this season.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt hit an RBI single in the fifth inning on Saturday at the Mets...has hit .625/.750/1.125 (5-for-8) with 1 double, 1HR, 8RBI, 3BB and 1HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .333/.420/.444 (39-for-117) with 7 doubles, 2HR, 42RBI, 17BB/5IBB, 2HP and 2SF with RISP.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger has hit .390/.468/.756 (16-for-41) with 8R, 6 doubles, 3HR, 11RBI and 6BB in his last 11 games vs. the Mets (since 6/21/24)...in 47 career games vs. New York-NL has batted .282/.342/.638 (49-for-174) with 31R, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 16HR, 42RBI, 16BB/3IBB and 2SB.

- Has hit .429/.467/.714 (6-for-14) with 1 double, 1HR and 1BB vs. the Mets' RHP Freddy Peralta.
- His nine go-ahead RBI this season are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- Has hit .350/.420/.550 (14-for-40) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. recorded his second straight multi-hit game on Saturday at the Mets...is batting .500/.538/.750 (6-for-12) with 2R, 2 doubles, 2RBI, 1BB and 15B over his last three games (since 5/13).

- Has recorded a hit in 11 of his last 14 starts (since 5/1).
- His 12SB are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the eighth-most in the Majors this year.

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters have walked an AL-best 207 times this season, their most walks through their first 46 games of a season in the last 22 seasons (since 2005) and most since recording 211BB in 2004.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners have recorded 41 stolen bases this year, their most through their first 46 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 52SB in 2001.

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (14HR) are only the third pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 14HR in the club's first 46 games of a season, joining Roger Maris (15HR) and Mickey Mantle (15HR) in 1961 and Mantle (21HR) and Yogi Berra (14HR) in 1956.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP ELMER RODRÍGUEZ (0-1, 5.19 ERA)

RHP Elmer Rodríguez will make his third career start in today's series finale at New York-NL...was recalled from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Saturday...the 22-year-old will make the start on extended six days' rest...last pitched on 5/10 at Worcester with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, allowing 1R/ER over 4.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 2BB, 6K, 1HP)...made his last Major League start on 5/5 vs. Texas, allowing 3R/ER over 4.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 4BB, 2K, 1HP, 1WP)...in five starts with the RailRiders this season, has gone 1-2 with a 1.38 ERA (26.0IP, 18H, 5R/4ER, 9BB, 26K, 1HR)...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in all five starts, including 1R-or-fewer in four starts...**was named by Baseball America as the Yankees' 2025 Minor League "Player of the Year" after going 11-8 with a 2.58 ERA (150.0IP, 104H, 52R/43ER, 57BB, 176K, 3HR) in 27 combined appearances (26 starts) with High-A Hudson Valley (15G/14GS), Double-A Somerset (11GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (1GS) last season**...among qualified minor league pitchers in 2025, ranked second in strikeouts, was tied for fifth in innings pitched and eighth in opponents' BA (.192) and ERA...also ranked first among Yankees farmhands in strikeouts and innings pitched, was tied for first in starts, second in ERA, opponents' BA and WHIP (1.07), and tied for third in wins... following the 2025 season, was tabbed by *Baseball America* as the Yankees' No. 2 prospect and the No. 59 prospect in baseball...was also tabbed as the Yankees' No. 3 prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 82 prospect in baseball...over parts of five minor league seasons in the Boston Red Sox (2022-24) and Yankees (2025-26) organizations, has gone 23-21 with a 2.51 ERA (354.2IP, 255H, 135R/99ER, 149BB, 391K, 13HR) in 79 career games (74 starts)...the San Juan, P.R., native was originally selected by Boston in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by the Yankees along with international signing bonus pool money from the Red Sox in exchange for C Carlos Narváez on 12/11/24.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on 5/10 at Worcester with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, allowing 1R/ER over 4.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 2BB, 6K, 1HP)...made his last Major League start on 5/5 vs. Texas, allowing 3R/ER over 4.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 4BB, 2K, 1HP, 1WP).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Made his Major League debut on 4/29 at Texas, taking the loss after allowing 2R/ER in 4.0IP (4H, 4BB, 3K, 0HR, 1HP)...struck out Josh Jung (swinging) in the first inning for his first career strikeout.

- ✦ Was the first Yankee to make his Major League debut as a starting pitcher since Cam Schlichter on 7/9/25 vs. Seattle and the first to do so on the road since Will Warren on 7/30/24 at Philadelphia.
- ✦ **Was the third Yankees pitcher in the last 19 seasons (since 2008) to make his Major League debut as a starting pitcher at age 22-or-younger**, joining Deivi García (21y, 103d on 8/30/20-G2 vs. the Mets) and Luis Severino (21y, 166d on 8/5/15 vs. Boston).
- ✦ Was the first Yankee to make his Major League debut this season.

2026: Has made two starts for the Yankees this season, going 0-1 with a 5.19 ERA (8.2IP, 5ER) and 5K.

- ✦ Made his Major League debut on 4/29 at Texas, recording the loss after allowing 2R/ER in 4.0IP (4H, 4BB, 3K, 0HR, 1HP)...struck out Josh Jung (swinging) in the first inning for his first career strikeout.
- ✦ Made his second Major League start on 5/5 vs. Texas, allowing 3R/ER in 4.2IP (ND, 6H, 4BB, 2K, 0HR, 1HP, 1WP).
- ✦ In five starts with the RailRiders this season, has gone 1-2 with a 1.38 ERA (26.0IP, 18H, 5R/4ER, 9BB, 26K, 1HR)...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in all five starts, including 1R-or-fewer in four starts
- ✦ Earned his first minor league win of the season on 4/15 at Syracuse after tossing 5.2 scoreless innings (2H, 2BB, 6K, 1HP).
- ✦ Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2026 World Baseball Classic...made one start vs. Team Cuba on 3/9, earning the win after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings (1H, 3BB, 3K).

LA ISLA DEL ENCANTO: Became just the fourth Puerto Rican-born pitcher to start a game for the Yankees, joining Javier Vázquez (58 combined starts in 2004 and '10), Ed Figueroa (126 starts from 1976-80) and Ricky Bones (one start in 1996)...additionally, became just the ninth Puerto Rican-born pitcher in franchise history to appear in game (also Jonathan Albaladejo, Luis Arroyo, Fernando Cruz, Bobby Muñoz and Juan Padilla).

- ✦ Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2026 World Baseball Classic...made one start vs. Team Cuba on 3/9, earning the win after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings (1H, 3BB, 3K).

2025: Was named by Baseball America as the Yankees' 2025 Minor League "Player of the Year" after going 11-8 with a 2.58 ERA (150.0IP, 104H, 52R/43ER, 57BB, 176K, 3HR) in 27 combined appearances (26 starts) with High-A Hudson Valley (15G/14GS), Double-A Somerset (11GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (1GS).

- ✦ Among qualified minor league pitchers, ranked second in strikeouts, was tied for fifth in innings pitched and eighth in opponents' BA (.192) and ERA...also ranked first among Yankees farmhands in strikeouts and innings pitched, was tied for first in starts, second in ERA, opponents' BA and WHIP (1.07), and tied for third in wins.
- ✦ Allowed 3R-or-fewer in 21 of his 27 games, 2R-or-fewer in 18 games and 1R-or-fewer in 13 games (including 0R in 10 games)...had tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in his lone relief appearance on 6/13 vs. Greenville.
- ✦ Tossed at least 6.0IP in 14 of his starts and at least 7.0IP in four starts.
- ✦ Began the season with High-A Hudson Valley, going 6-4 with a 2.26 ERA (83.2IP, 52H, 27R/21ER, 37BB, 99K, 1HR) in 15 games (14 starts)...was named the South Atlantic League "Pitcher of the Week" for 4/21-27 after allowing only 1H and striking out 12 batters over 6.1 scoreless innings in his start on 4/25 at Asheville (W, 1BB).
- ✦ Was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 7/11 and went 5-3 with a 2.64 ERA (61.1IP, 44H, 21R/18ER, 20BB, 74K, 2HR) in 11 starts...was named the Eastern League "Pitcher of the Week" for 9/1-7 after going 1-0 over two scoreless starts (11.0IP, 3H, 2BB, 16K).
- ✦ Made his final appearance of the year with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (L, 5.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 0BB, 3K, 0HR, 1HP, 1BK)...also made a postseason start with the RailRiders on 9/25 at Jacksonville in Game 3 of the International League Championship Series at Jacksonville (L, 0.2IP, 4H, 5R/ER, 2BB, 2K, 0HR).
- ✦ Following the season, was tabbed by *Baseball America* as the Yankees' No. 2 prospect and the No. 59 prospect in baseball...was also tabbed as the Yankees' No. 3 prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 82 prospect in baseball...was named by *Baseball America* as a High Class A All-Star and as a First-Team All-Star...was also labeled by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Curveball" and "Best Control" in the Yankees system.
- ✦ Was added to the Yankees' 40-man roster on 11/18.
- ✦ In 2026 spring training, was named along with OF Spencer Jones as the winners of the 2025 Kevin Lawn Awards as the Yankees' minor league "Position Player of the Year" and "Pitcher of the Year"...the annual awards are dedicated to Kevin O'Brien Lawn—the son of longtime Yankees Vice President and Chief of Operations Jack Lawn—who passed away in 1999.

CAREER NOTES: Over parts of five minor league seasons in the Boston Red Sox (2022-24) and Yankees (2025-26) organizations, has gone 23-21 with a 2.50 ERA (359.1IP, 261H, 136R/100ER, 151BB, 397K, 13HR) in 80 career games (75 starts).

- ✦ Was originally selected by Boston in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.
- ✦ Was acquired by the Yankees along with international signing bonus pool money from the Red Sox in exchange for C Carlos Narváez on 12/11/24.
- ✦ Is a San Juan, P.R., native...attended Leadership Christian Academy (P.R.).
