**THE TWINS:** Have gone 0-4 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip...after getting swept in three games at Cleveland over the weekend, the Twins began their series in D.C. with a loss to the Nats last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Nationals Park and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's finale, they will travel back to the Twin Cities for an off-day on Thursday, then begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Rangers (May 24-26) and four against the Royals (May 27-30).  
 After going 17-3 in 20 games from April 22-May 12, the Twins have gone 0-7 since May 14.  
 Minnesota's current seven-game losing streak marks a season-long and longest since April 20-27, 2018, when they lost eight straight.  
 Twins are looking to avoid falling to .500 for the first time since being 13-13 through their game on April 27 at Anaheim.

**NATS PILE ON PABLO, TAKE OPENER:** The Twins lost to the Nationals last night in Washington D.C. by a score of 12-3...Pablo López (4-4) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched...seven runs allowed tied his most as a Twin (also July 15, 2023 at Oakland)...Twins pitchers (López, Thielbar, Boushley) combined to allow a season-high 12 runs...the offense recorded eight hits, two coming from Willi Castro...Carlos Correa drove in two of the club's three runs, hitting a two-run homer, his third longball of the season.

**THIS HAS TO BE A RECORD FOR MOST TIMES HAVING A NOTE ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THE GAME NOTES:** Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...he has been sitting on 399 since last Sunday's win in Toronto on May 12...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (446-310) and Aaron Boone (442-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**FAST TIMES:** Last night, Nationals starter Mitchell Parker threw 39 4-seam fastballs, 30 curveballs, 24 splitters and one slider...Minnesota has seen 3,415 fastballs this season, the fewest in baseball...additionally, they have seen the sixth-most breaking pitches in baseball (2,336)...they have a .448 slugging percentage off fastballs in 2024, fifth-best in baseball...their .357 wOBA vs. fastballs ranks seventh in baseball.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** The Twins are 2-4 in Interleague Play this season...their only three series this season were a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2) and this current one...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Pirates at PNC Park for a three-game weekend series from June 7-9.  
 Ryan Jeffers is hitting .311 (28-for-90) with five doubles, nine home runs, 17 RBI, a .431 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.098 OPS vs. NL opponents since the start of 2023...Jeffers' IL OPS ranks second in baseball since the start of last season (chart lower right)...additionally, he has homered four times in his last eight games vs. the NL.

**MATCH-UPS AT THE MONUMENT:** The Twins are 10-12 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise, including 7-12 since the franchise moved to D.C...the Twins have gone just 2-10 in their last 12 vs. the Nats, dating back to 2013...the Twins are just 1-6 all-time at Nationals Park, going 1-2 in 2013, 0-3 in 2016 and 0-1 this season.  
 Minnesota's only win in this ballpark came in their first game here on June 8, 2013, in a 4-3, 11-inning victory...Joe Mauer had three hits, including his 100th career home run (off Gio González)...Denard Span also had three hits for the Nats...Glen Perkins earned his 13th save of that season with a scoreless 11th.

**DOUBLE LIFE:** The Twins enter today with 92 doubles...they have doubled in 23 consecutive games, their longest streak since April 7-May 15, 2018, when they doubled in 32 straight.  
 Ryan Jeffers ranks tied for seventh in the AL in doubles (12) and Willi Castro and Max Kepler rank tied for 12th (11).

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** Twins hitters are slashing .271/.316/.421 with a .737 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .218/.296/.379 with a .676 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...the .271 average vs. lefties ranks fourth among AL teams and sixth in all of baseball.  
 Since April 24, the Twins are slashing .306/.340/.468 (.807 OPS) vs. lefties — the highest batting average in baseball since that date.  
 Willi Castro is hitting .436 (17-for-39) with a 1.104 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 15 games, he is 17-for-29 (.586) with a 1.448 OPS vs. lefties.

**WILL-MATIC:** In his last 30 games since April 19, Willi Castro is hitting .327 (37-for-113) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 12 RBI, 15 runs scored and an .886 OPS...since that date, he ranks fifth in the AL in batting average and 14th in OPS.  
 Since April 24, Castro ranks tied for seventh in baseball in line drives hit with 24...his line drive percentage of 30.5 marks his highest since 2020 (30.9%).

**MORRIS AND MERCEDES:** High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris has been named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week and FCL Twins outfielder Yasser Mercedes has been named Florida Complex League Player of the Week.  
 Morris, 22, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Quad Cities, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and six strikeouts.  
 Mercedes, 19, hit .500 (8-for-16) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, six runs scored, a .529 on-base percentage, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.529 OPS.

**HAPPY HRBIE DAY!** Twins Hall of Famer Kent Hrbek is celebrating his 64th birthday today...he played eight games on his birthday during his 14-year career with Minnesota, hitting .240 (6-for-25) with two doubles, one home run and two RBI...Hrbek had a 38.6 BWAR for his career, second best of any player born on May 21, behind Hall of Famer Earl Averill (51.1)...he shares a birthday with National Baseball Hall of Famer Bobby Cox (83), Al Franken (73) and Mr. T (72).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his ninth start of the season on May 16 against New York-AL; took his third loss, allowing six runs on four runs (1 HR), one walk and five strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched...allowed a leadoff home run to Anthony Volpe...ended his season-high four game quality start streak dating back to April 24...three of the four runs he allowed came in the first inning...his four earned runs given up were a season high.

- ☞ One of four Twins starters to be in the top 25 among qualified American League pitchers in strikeout-to-walk ratio with 8.29; currently ranks fourth in the American League.
- ☞ Generated 11 swings and misses on 44 strikes thrown (25%).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made his eighth start of the season on May 10 at Toronto; earned his second win on the year and first road win, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR) in a season-high 7.0 innings, with no walks and seven strikeouts...recorded his fourth consecutive quality start and a team-leading sixth...allowed a third-inning home run to Isiah Kiner-Falefa which was the only run he allowed...eighth time in his career he has gone 7.0-or-more innings and allowed one-or-fewer runs.

- ☞ Per Baseball Savant, Isiah Kiner-Falefa's home run would have been a home run at 11 of 30 ballparks, but not Target Field.

**VS. A NEW FACE:** Facing Washington Nationals for the first time in his career tonight...has faced three active Nationals in Joey Gallo, Eddie Rosario and Jesse Winker

- ☞ One career start against the National League East on June 27, 2023 (Atlanta Braves)...allowed six runs on nine hits (5 HR), no walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings -- his five home runs allowed matched his single-game career high.
- ☞ Making his 14th career Interleague start, in the previous 13 he is 5-6, 6.75 ERA (64.0 IP, 48 ER), 19 walks and 73 strikeouts a 1.48 WHIP and a .287 (76-for-265) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Last Interleague win came on May 24, 2023 vs. San Francisco, tossing 5.0 innings, allowing one run on six hits, two walks and four strikeouts...two of his five wins against the National League have come against San Francisco.
- ☞ Is 0-3, 12.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 23 ER) in his last four Interleague starts since June 27, 2023, after going 3-1, 2.45 ERA (22.0 IP, 6 ER) in his four starts before that from August 9, 2022-May 24, 2023.

**BACK ON THE ROAD:** Through four starts on the road in 2024, Ryan has tossed 24.1 innings going 1-0 with 21 hits allowed, three walks, 27 strikeouts and two home runs compared to 1-3, 5.02 ERA (28.2 IP, 16 ER), four walks, 31 strikeouts and five home runs in five home starts.

- ☞ In 33 career road starts, he is 13-10, 4.16 ERA (179.2 IP, 83 ER), 166 hits, 41 walks and 189 strikeouts...Twins are 20-13 in Ryan's 33 road starts.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 13 road wins...behind him are Griffin Jax (9) and Bailey Ober (9).
- ☞ Has allowed seven home runs this year...only two have come on the road.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .222/.260/.313 with six extra-base hits, including one home run, four walks and 31 strikeouts in 104 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .238/.259/.486 with eight doubles, six home runs, three walks and 27 strikeouts in 108 plate appearances.

- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .210 (147-for-701) with 28 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs and a .627 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .242 (186-for-770) with 47 doubles, no triples and, 42 home runs with a .749 OPS.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in his ninth start this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 75.2 percent of the time in his last start against the Yankees...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ In his last start two starts against Toronto and New York-AL, hitters went 1-for-19 vs. the split finger with six strikeouts.
- ☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .244 (11-for-45) with three home runs and 12 strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball in 2024.

**RUNNERS ON:** With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .282 (11-for-39) with two home runs, one walk and nine strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .194 (27-for-139) with four home runs, five walks and 44 strikeouts.

**UNDER THE LIGHTS:** Making his fifth night start of the year...has gone 2-0, 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER) with three walks, 24 strikeouts and a .247 (23-for-93) opponent batting average in his four outings...is 12-11, 3.23 ERA (167.0 IP, 60 ER), .208 BAA in 30 career day starts, compared to 16-11, 4.55 ERA (221.1 IP, 112 ER), .240 BAA in 40 career night starts.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Enters today with 436 career strikeouts, 30th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Mike Smithson in 29th place with 438.

**HEART OF THE ORDER? NO PROBLEM:** Opposing hitters 4-6 in the lineup are hitting a combined .180 (13-for-72) with 15 strikeouts, no walks and just four extra-base hits (three double and one home run) against Ryan this season.

**QUALITY STARTER:** Recorded four-straight quality starts from April 24-May 10...leads the Twins with six quality starts this season...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in eight of his nine starts.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 1-0, 2.97 ERA // CAREER: 1-1, 3.83 ERA)**

Right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the series finale against the Washington Nationals tomorrow afternoon...in his last start against Cleveland he took a no-decision allowing one run on four hits, no walks and two strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched...has made six starts in 2024, four coming on the road...in those starts he is 1-0, 3.72 ERA (19.1 IP, 8 ER), four walks, 11 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP and a .276 (21-for-76) opponent batting average...facing the Nationals for the second time in his career after coming in relief against them on April 22, 2023; allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR), three walks and five strikeouts in that outing.
