BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals play the final game of a three-game series with the San Francisco Giants and wrap up a nine-game road trip through the National League West. The Cardinals are 4-4 on the road trip (LAD 2-1, COL 2-1, SF 0-2) and looking to earn a winning road trip for the first time since June 30-July 5 (4-2 at ATL & CHI). Following an open date on Thursday, the Cardinals will begin their final homestand of the season hosting the Chicago White Sox (Sept. 11-13), San Francisco Giants (Sept. 14-16) and Washington Nationals (Sept. 18-20). St. Louis will conclude the 2026 regular season on the road at Pittsburgh (Sept. 22-24) and Milwaukee (Sept. 25-27).

FLIGHT PATTERN: With last night's loss, St. Louis was mathematically eliminated from the National League Central division race and dropped into 4th place in the division for the first time since Aug. 4, trailing the Pirates by a half-game and are 18.0 games out of first place. St. Louis has seven road games remaining and nine home games.

HAPPY HOMECOMING: The Cardinals return home from this road trip to a weekend of celebrations when they host the Chicago White Sox. On Friday, the 20th anniversary of the 2006 World Championship squad will be honored, and on Saturday, **Albert Pujols**, **Yadier Molina** and **Bill Sherdel** will be inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame.

IT'S NOT GOOD-BYE: The Cardinals and Giants complete their three-game series in San Francisco today, but after the Cardinals host the White Sox this weekend, the Giants will be in St. Louis to play a three-game series at Busch Stadium (Sept. 14-16). The two squads play each other 6 times over 10 days.

CLOSE CALLS: The Cardinals and Giants have played seven straight one-run games dating back to Sept. 6, 2025 at Busch Stadium. The Giants won the last non one-run game with an 8-2 victory at Busch Stadium on Sept. 5, 2025.

SWEEP-STAKES: A win by the Cardinals today would avoid their first four-game losing streak to the Giants since April 18-July 7, 2007. The Cardinals have also not been swept in a three-game series in San Francisco since June 29-July 1, 2001. They dropped a pair of two-game sets in 2003 and 2007 and lost three straight at Oracle Park during the 2014 National League Championship Series (Games 3-5).

SAN FRANCISCO TREAT: Cardinals first baseman **Alec Burleson** has hit the Giants well, posting his highest career batting average against them at .375 (21-56), tied with the Yankees. Burleson's .375 mark ranks 4th among active players vs. SF behind former teammate and friend **Brendan Donovan** (.419), **Mike Trout** (.391) and **Aaron Judge** (.386).

55 AND THRIVE: Cardinals slugging outfielder **Jordan Walker** has hit his first 55 career home runs off 55 different pitchers. He's two behind Giants' **Willy Adames** at 57 to hit his next mark. The Giants are one of five teams (ARI, BAL, HOU, STL), Walker has yet to homer against. He has not homered against any of the active pitchers on the Giants squad.

NO FLY ZONE: **Andre Pallante** enters this afternoon's game on a 43.0-inning streak without allowing a home run, the longest by a Cardinals pitcher this season and longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher since **Jack Flaherty** ran off a 56.1 inning streak May 9-July 16, 2023. Pallante's last longball was to **Jake Bauers** (MIL) on July 9 at Busch Stadium. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

SEPTEMBER SENSATIONS: Through the first eight games of September, the Cardinals lead all of Major League Baseball with a .286 batting average, 52 runs, 85 hits and 50 RBI.

BABY BIRDS ARE BASHIN': Two 2026 St. Louis Cardinals draft picks were selected by their respective leagues as Player of the Week. Peoria (A+) OF **Andrew Williamson** (2nd round, UCF) was named Midwest Player of the Week; while Palm Beach (A) INF **Owen Henne** (6th Round, Seton Hill-PA) was named Florida State League Player of the Week.

SAN FRANCISCO CONNECTIONS

Nathan Church and **Matt Chapman** are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Bryan Torres was selected by the Giants from the Brewers in the Triple-A phase of the 2019 Rule 5 Draft & played in 43 games for Double-A Richmond in 2021.

Quinn Mathews pitched at nearby Stanford University from 2020-23, going 25-10 in 68 games (45 starts) and was the 2023 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City and resides in Danville, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at UC-Davis (2005-07).

Hayden Birdsong was born in Mattoon, Ill...pitched at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Ill., where Sr. Dir., Player Dev. **Kyle Haines** graduated with a kinesiology and sports mgt. degree.

Alec Burleson and **Carson Whisenhunt** were teammates at East Carolina University in 2020.

Andrew Knizner played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2019-23)...selected in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Cardinals.

Giants Manager **Tony Vitello** is a St. Louis native...attended De Smet High School and the University of Missouri, where he played baseball from 2000-02...was an asst. coach at Mizzou from 2003-10.

Giants Hitting Coach **Hunter Mense** played baseball at the Univ. of Missouri from 2004-06 and was an assistant coach from 2011-16...Bench Coach **Jayce Tingler** played at Mizzou from 2000-03.

Justin Bruihl was born in nearby Petaluma, Calif., and earned his first save on Sept. 18, 2022 at San Francisco while with the Dodgers.

Giants 1B Coach **Shane Robinson** was selected by St. Louis in 5th round of the 2006 MLB Draft and played in 268 games for STL from 2009, 11-14.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Willie McGee** played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...resides in Hercules...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Harrison Bader was a 3rd-round selection by St. Louis in the 2015 MLB Draft and played in 523 games for the Cardinals from 2017-22.

JT Brubaker (July 26, 2020 at STL w/ PIT), **Adrian Houser** (Sept. 26, 2015 at STL w/MIL), **Trevor McDonald** (Sept. 29, 2024 at Oracle Park w/SF), **Blade Tidwell** (May 4, 2025[1] at STL w/NYM) & **Keaton Winn** (June 13, 2023 at STL w/SF) all made their MLB debuts against the Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in San Francisco (2006-07).

Cardinals Bullpen Coach **Julio Rangel** was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 26th start of the season and his 87th career start (195th career appearance) ... Has recorded three consecutive 20+ start seasons (2024-26) with a career-high 31 starts in 2025.
- Missed 15 games from Aug. 18-Sept. 3 due to right elbow inflammation.
- Enters on a 43.0-inning homerless streak, 5th-longest active streak in MLB, and longest by a Cardinal since **Jack Flaherty** (56.1 IP from May 9-July 16, 2023). - *Elias*
- Pallante's 12 wins in his first 22 starts were the most since 2015: **Carlos Martinez** (12-3) and **Michael Wacha** (13-4).
- Andre is the first Cardinal since **Joaquin Andujar** (1983-84) to bounce back from a 15+ loss season and win 10 or more games the very next season; Andujar lost 16 games in 1983 but then produced a 20-win season in 1984 and a 21-win season in 1985.
- Owns an 9.85 Run Support Average on the road (6th-highest in MLB) but just 3.12 at home ... Received 3 runs or fewer in 12 of his 14 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 7 of his 11 Road starts.
- Making his 195th career appearance to pass **Tony Fossas** (1995-97) for 60th all-time among Cardinals. ... Andre has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 190+ career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 85+ starts.
- Is 7-0 in 10 road starts (St. Louis is 8-3) ... His 7 road wins are T-3rd in the NL, while Pallante and Jesus Lizardo (9-0) are the only two undefeated MLB pitchers with 5+ road victories.**
- Has made 11 consecutive road starts of 5.0+ IP, matching **Kyle Leahy** for team-high this season. **Sonny Gray** (14 from 2024-25) was the last Cardinal with more.
- Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (86), wins (36), and innings pitched (601.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26) most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, Sept. 4 at Coors Field): ND, W, 7-6, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 0 HR, 1 SO - 72 pitches.

- Exited with the Cardinals leading 4-1 after 5.0 innings as St. Louis blew the lead, but scored 3 in the 9th to comeback and win.
- Was Pallante's 7th straight start without allowing a home run (43.0 IP).
- Did not factor in the decision, but has not lost on the road this season. Last road loss (Sept. 12, 2025 at Milwaukee).

2026 NOTES:

MY BEST FRIEND: Has induced career-high 18 groundball double plays this season (T-3rd in NL), most since 2024 by Cardinals duo of **Kyle Gibson** (21) and **Miles Mikolas** (18).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .205 BA (32-156) with his slider, and 44 of his 98 strikeouts this season have come via the slider. Boasts a 13 Run Value on his slider, 5th-best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 24 of his 25 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 16 of those games.

RIGHT ON: His .233 Opp. BA vs. RHB (55-236) would be the lowest of his career by a -.034 margin, behind his .267 mark (65-243) in 2024.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .751 OPS, 16 runs and 4 HR in 1st inning. Batters are hitting .318 (21-66) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

YANKEE DOODLE: With 1 run allowed on 3 hits in 5.1 IP on 8/5 at NYY, became the 3rd Cardinals starter in regular-season play to pitch at least 5.0 frames with 3-or-fewer hits allowed to the Yankees (Last: **Jordan Montgomery** on 7/2/23 at Busch Stadium), and the 2nd to do so at New York in franchise history (Also: **Clarence Mitchell**; 5.2 IP, 2 H in 1928 World Series Game 2 at Yankee Stadium).

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (61.8%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.*** As a starting pitcher (469.1 IP), Pallante's 58.7 career groundball pct. currently is the 9th-highest in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987

(min. 450.0 IP as starter).

PALLANTE vs. COLORADO:

- Makes his 3rd career start and 8th career appearance vs. the Rockies ... Is 2-1 with an 2.95 ERA covering 18.1 innings pitched.
- Hurled 5.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts in a 5-1 win at Busch Stadium on June 9, 2024.
- Prior to his last start, his only run allowed came on a solo home run to **Ryan McMahon** on Aug. 5, 2023 at Busch Stadium.
- St. Louis is 5-2 in his seven appearances vs. Colorado.
- Was 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP) in five relief appearances, three of those appearances of 2.0+ innings.

LAST START vs. ROCKIES (July 23, 2025 at Coors Field): L, 6-0: 5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 5 K - 97 pitches

- Dropped a 6-0 decision to the Rockies at Coors Field, allowing 5 runs on 9 hits, with 4 of the runs and 5 hits coming in the Rockies 2nd inning.
- The Cardinals were blanked in Denver for just the 4th time ever.

PALLANTE vs. SAN FRANCISCO:

- Career 1-0 with a 5.16 ERA in four career starts (8 appearances) vs. San Francisco, including a 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP) in four games (two starts) at Oracle Park.
- Made his final start of the 2025 season at Oracle Park (Sept 23, 2025), yielding five runs (two earned) in 2.2 innings in a no-decision that Cardinals won 9-8.
- Started at Oracle Park on the second to last day of the 2024 regular season (Sept. 28, 2024). Received a no decision in 5.0 innings allowing four runs (3 ER) as the Cardinals fell 6-5.
- Won a 6-5 decision vs. the Giants at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., on June 20, 2024; making him the second Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site game joining **Alan Benes** vs. SD at Aloha Stadium (Honolulu, Hawaii) on April 19, 1997.
- Pitched a no decision vs. the Giants on Sept. 6 at Busch Stadium in a 3-2 Cardinals win. Exited trailing 2-0 to Justin Verlander before the Cardinals rallied for three 9th inning runs.

LAST START vs. GIANTS (Sept. 23, 2025 at Oracle Park): ND, W, 9-8, 2.2 IP, 3 H, 5 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 4 K, 0 HR - 66 pitches

- Was Pallante's final start of the 2025 season.
- All five runs came in the 3rd inning, three unearned on a Nolan Arenado throwing error.
