That Ninth Inning

Atlanta entered last night's ninth inning trailing, 2-0, with just seven total baserunners on the game. The Braves then scored six runs on four hits and two walks to walk off with a win, 6-2.

Atlanta last scored as many ninth-inning runs on August 26 of last season at Miami, when the club plated nine in an 11-2 win. The Braves last scored as many in the ninth inning **at home** on May 20, 2018, when the club rallied for a 10-9 win also over the Marlins.

Atlanta has now scored at least six runs in the ninth inning 23 times since Elias began per-inning run tracking in 1969, and last night marked just the third time the club did so while entering the frame scoreless. The Braves last such game came on May 4, 1995, when the club scored six times in the ninth to win, 6-3. That victory also came versus the Marlins.

Opening in Interleague

For the first time in franchise history, Atlanta opens its season with an interleague series as the Braves host the Kansas City Royals this weekend.

The Royals are opening with interleague play for just the second time, after hosting the Mets in 2016 in a World Series rematch from the previous autumn.

Atlanta will play 12 of its first 16 games against American League opponents to open the year, with just one of its first five series of the season against a fellow NL club. The Braves will host the Athletics (AL) to complete its opening homestand, before subsequent series against the D-backs (NL), Angels (AL) and Guardians (AL).

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Royals conclude their first series of the 2026 season today with the finale of a three-game set...This weekend marks the only scheduled games between the two teams this year.

A Atlanta rallied with six runs in the bottom of last night's ninth inning to beat Kansas City, 6-2...The Braves have won both games of the series and will play for the sweep this afternoon.

A Atlanta dropped two-of-three against Kansas City last season at Kauffman Stadium in Missouri, its first series defeat to the Royals since 2019...The Braves won the opener before losing the next two games...Since MLB moved to a balanced schedule in 2023, meaning the two clubs now play every year, Atlanta is 8-3 (.727) vs. Kansas City.

A Last night's win moved Atlanta to 4-3 against Kansas City all-time here at Truist Park...The Braves dropped the first two games between the clubs here in 2019, but have since won 4-of-5... The Braves are 9-6 (.600) against the Royals all time in the city of Atlanta.

A Entering this weekend, Atlanta and Kansas City had played just 26 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with the Braves going 14-12 (.538) in these games...Atlanta's 26 games versus the Royals were its second-fewest against any team that was in the AL at the time interleague play was introduced (Cleveland - 24 games)...For comparison, Atlanta has played Boston 100 times in interleague play.

A RH Seth Lugo is set today to make the 31st appearance and seventh start of his career against Atlanta...The 6-foot-4, 225-pound native of Shreveport, La, is 6-5 with a 3.76 ERA (27 ER/64.2 IP) and three saves versus the Braves all-time, including wins in each of his last two decisions dating to 2023.

GRANT HOLMES: Makes his first start of the season in his third major league campaign...The 6-foot-0, 226-pound native of Conway, SC, went 4-9 with a 3.99 ERA (51 ER/115.0 IP) in 22 games, 21 starts, for Atlanta before being placed on the injured list last season.

A In four Grapefruit League starts and five total appearances this spring, he went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA, allowing just seven hits and two earned runs in 17.2 innings...He struck out 20.

A Holmes was placed on the 15-day injured list with right elbow inflammation on July 27 of last season and missed the remainder of the year.

A The right-hander has made just one career relief appearance against the Royals, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts on September 29, 2024...In 28 career starts, Holmes is 5-9 with a 4.02 ERA, compared to a 1-1 record with a 3.03 mark in 20 relief appearances.

A Holmes had an ERA over 2.50 points better at home (2.93) than on the road (5.51) last season... He fanned 82 batters in just 67.2 innings here.

NEWCOMERS: Dominic Smith, Mike Yastrzemski, Jorge Mateo and Osvaldo Bido all made their Braves debuts in Atlanta's victory last night...Smith and Yastrzemski combined to plate five of Atlanta's six runs, while Mateo scored the tying run and Bido earned the win.

A Per Elias, Smith became the first player in MLB history to hit a walk-off grand slam in his team debut, and the second player in Braves history to hit a walk-off home run in his first game with the club...Bobby Ávila hit a two-run walk off on July 22, 1959 versus Cincinnati.

A Smith's homer marked the team's first walk-off grand slam since May 20, 2010, when Brooks Conrad hit one versus Cincinnati...Last night's homer was the first full-count, walk-off homer in franchise history...For Smith, it was his second career walk-off home run and his third career walk-off RBI...His previous game-ending homer occurred on September 29, 2019, when he defeated the Braves as a Met at Citi Field.

A Yastrzemski went 2-for-4 in his debut, including a run-scoring single in the ninth...In the fifth inning, he collected his first hit of the season with a bunt-single up the third base line...He became the second Braves player aged 35 years or older with a bunt-single in the last three seasons, joining Whit Merrifield (also 35) in 2024...Just eight total MLB players have recorded such a hit at such an age since 2024, and Atlanta is the only team to claim two of them...Since his debut with San Francisco in 2019, Yastrzemski's 20 bunt-hits are tied for fourth in the National League, only trailing TJ Friedl (37), Victor Robles (29) and Garrett Hampson (25).

A Mateo entered the game in the ninth inning as a pinch runner for Matt Olson, and tied the game four batters later when he scored on Michael Harris II's single.

A Bido pitched the top of the ninth inning after Atlanta claimed him off waivers on Tuesday, and he struck out the side to earn the win...It marked just the fourth inning in his career in which the faced exactly three batters in an inning and fanned them all.

HARRIS II ON BASE: Michael Harris II reached base three times last night, going 3-for-4 with the game-tying RBI...Through two games this season, he is batting exactly .500 (4-for-8) with a homer and three RBI.

A He extended his on-base streak to 16 consecutive games with a fifth-inning single...The run dates to September 14, 2025, and includes a nine-game hitting streak that started on September 21.

A Just two players in the NL have a longer on-base run...Shohei Ohtani has reached in 34 straight, while Geraldo Perdomo has done so in 20.

A With three hits last night he has recorded four or more hits across the first two games of the season for the second time in his career (also: 2024)...He is the first Braves center fielder to do so twice since Andruw Jones in 2001 and '06.

Today's Game

- A Set to make his first start of the season and 29th career start for the Braves.
 - A Made his second career Opening Day roster with Atlanta this season after also making the club's roster to open 2025.
- A A native of Conway, South Carolina...His 28 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.
- A Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), striking out 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk...Did not allow a run in his first four outings before surrendering two earned runs over 5.1 innings in his final spring start on March 24 against Tampa Bay.
- A Has made just one career appearance against Kansas City, tossing 1.2 scoreless innings with two strikeouts in relief on September 29, 2024.
- A Needs seven strikeouts to reach 200 on his career.
- A Missed the final 57 games of the 2025 season after being placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27 with right elbow inflammation.
- A Since June 5, 2025, averaged 11.01 strikeouts per nine innings pitched over an eight-game span, the seventh-highest rate among qualified starters in baseball at the time of his injury.
- A Is 5-3 with a 2.97 ERA in 26 career appearances at home and 1-7 with a 5.12 ERA in 22 outings on the road.

2025

- A Was placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27, 2025 with right elbow inflammation and missed the final 57 games of the season.
- A In his second major league season, went 4-9 with a 3.99 ERA (51 ER/115.0 IP) in 22 games, 21 starts, for Atlanta.
- A Became the fourth pitcher, sixth instance, in franchise history to record 15 or more strikeouts within a single game, joining Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn, twice, Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz, twice, and teammate Spencer Strider.
 - A Was the first National League pitcher to fan 15 in a losing decision since Cliff Lee with Philadelphia, May 6, 2011 against Atlanta.
 - A Generated 25 swings and misses during the outing, tied for the fifth most in a single game in the majors at that time.
- A Was 2-8 in 10 decisions over 16 starts from May 2 through the end of the season, with a 3.86 ERA over 86.1 innings in that span.
- A Made 21 starts for Atlanta, third most on the club behind Bryce Elder (28) and Spencer Strider (23).
- A In his debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

- A Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- A In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- A Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- A Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- A Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- A Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- A On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- A Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- A Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.

- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025...He allowed just five barrels in 156 batted balls...His seven total barrels and 2.3% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).

- In his third full season with Atlanta, appeared in a career-high 70 games and went 29-for-34 in save opportunities...Pitched to a 3.21 ERA (24 ER/67.1 IP)...Ranked fourth in the NL and tied for ninth in the majors in saves.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (222 apps.), Iglesias owns the best WHIP (0.94) and second-best ERA (2.35, 57 ER/218.2 IP).
- Ranks second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (180), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.88), fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.5) and fifth in ERA and saves (97).

- Set a career high and led the team with 74 appearances, going 2-4 with a 3.29 ERA (25 ER/68.1 IP) and matching a career high with 76 punchouts...Collected the first two saves of his major league career.
- Did not allow a run in 31 of his first 38 appearances through June 29, tying for the sixth-lowest ERA (1.67, 7 ER/37.2 IP) among major league pitchers in that span (min. 35.0 IP).
