AROUND THE HORN

CARROLL'S 50 TRIPLES SPARKS 50% OFF TICKETS: In celebration of Corbin Carroll's 50th career triple on May 24 vs. Rockies, fans can receive 50% off tickets to the D-backs' June 15-17 series vs. Angels by using the code CORBIN50 at dbacks.com/tickets...the offer ends tonight, May 26 at 11:59 p.m. AZT...to redeem the offer, fans should select the game they wish to attend, click "Unlock" and enter the code.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 9-2 in their last 11 games and 12-4 since May 9, the NL's most wins in the span (ahead of 11 by the Brewers).

- The D-backs are a season-high-tying 5 games above .500 (also: 13-8 on April 18)...last were 6+ games above at the end of 2024 (16 above on Sept. 29, 2024 at 89-73).
- Since May 10, **Ketel Marte** (.439 AVG, 1.239 OPS) and **Corbin Carroll** (.396 AVG, 1.228 OPS) rank first and second, respectively, in MLB AVG and OPS.
- **Corbin Carroll's** season-high 13-game hitting streak is the Majors' longest active streak...is batting .429 (21-for-49)/1.321 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 10 walks (9 K).
- **Ketel Marte's** season-high 9-game hitting streak is tied for the Majors' second longest active streak...is batting .568 (21-for-37)/1.568 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 15 RBI and 4 walks (2 K).
- **Ketel Marte**, who has posted consecutive games with 3+ hits and 3+ RBI, is 1 shy of the club-record 3 straight games with 3+ hits and 3+ RBI (Steve Finley from June 1-4, 1999).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 6-2 @ Giants.

- **Merrill Kelly** earned his fourth straight win in his 7.0-inning bid (2 R, 4 H, 2 BB, 4 K).
- **Ketel Marte** posted a career-high-tying 4 hits for the 14th time in his career...was his second straight 3-hit, 3-RBI game and third straight with 3+ hits.
- **Corbin Carroll** had his second straight multi-hit game and third in his last 4.
- **Gabriel Moreno** hit his third homer in the third.

MARTE NAMED NL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **Ketel Marte** earned his second career NL Player of the Week honor (also: Sept. 2-8, 2019).

- Hit safely in his 7 games at a .536 clip (15-for-28)/1.563 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 3 walks (1 K).
- Led MLB on the week in AVG (.536), SLG (1.000), OPS (1.563), RBI (12), H (15), XBH (7), TB (28) and R (11).

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 series (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies).

THE DIVISION SHOWDOWN: The D-backs are 9-2 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 1-0 @ Giants)...also will face NL West opponents 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

1-2-3: Since May 11 (14 G), D-backs' 1-3 batters have combined for an MLB-best .352 AVG and 1.012 OPS...are hitting a combined .352 (57-for-162) with 14 doubles, 4 triples, 5 homers, 33 RBI and 25 walks (16 K).

4-HIT TRAIN KEEPS ROLLING: **Corbin Carroll** (May 24 vs. Rockies) and **Ketel Marte** (May 25 @ Giants) have each posted a 4-hit game over the last 2 days...they last did so on Sept. 19, 2023 vs. Giants (Marte) and Sept. 20, 2023 (Carroll) vs. Giants.

- The D-backs last had 3 straight games featuring a 4-hit game in 2015: Aug. 20 @ Reds (A.J. Pollock), Aug. 21 @ Reds (Pollock) and Aug. 22 @ Reds (Paul Goldschmidt).

OPPOSING STARTER RISP: Since May 4 against opposing starters with runners in scoring position, the D-backs boast an MLB-best .360 AVG (31-for-86)/918 OPS with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 41 RBI and 10 walks.

OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES: In their last 11 games since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs' 32 runs are the most in MLB, ahead of the Nationals (26) and Brewers (22)...are batting .348 (48-for-138)/.955 OPS with 12 doubles, 4 triples, 3 homers and 12 walks.

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 15 quality starts in their last 20 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 13 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 131.2), IP/G (1st, 6.2), WHIP (1st, 0.99), OBP (1st, .258), wins (T-2nd, 13) and ERA (3rd, 2.46).
- The D-backs have had 8 seasons all-time with 16+ quality starts in the month of May: 16 in 1999, 16 in 2001, a franchise-best 18 in 2002, 16 in 2006, 16 in 2007, 16 in 2008, 16 in 2009 and 16 in 2011.

BULLPEN IN MAY: In May, the D-backs' bullpen ranks among the Majors in hits (1st, 38), walks (1st, 18), extra-base hits (2nd, 12), OPS (2nd, .532), WHIP (2nd, 0.98), opponent AVG (2nd, .188) and ERA (3rd, 2.20).

CARROLL TRIPLE WATCH: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.

- Is the 1 of 2 MLB players all-time to reach 50+ triples and 80+ homers in 537 career games or less (also: Lou Gehrig, 461 G).
- Is 1 of 9 players in the last 50 years with 5+ multi-triple games (George Brett-KC/5 from 1979-90, Brett Butler-ATL-CLE-LAD-NYM/5 from 1983-95, Lance Johnson-CWS-NYM/8 from 1991-97, Omar Vizquel-CLE-SF/5 from 1998-2006, Jimmy Rollins-PHI/5 from 2001-08, Carl Crawford-TB-BOS/8 from 2004-11, Curtis Granderson-DET-NYY/5 from 2007-10, and José Reyes-NYM/9 from 2005-17).

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won 4 straight games and are 7-1 in their last 8.

- Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 9 straight games, batting .344 (11-for-32)/1.070 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 8 straight games, carrying a 1.087 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 6-game hit streak, batting .417 (10-for-24)/1.153 OPS with 1 double, 3 triples, 2 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base...has reached 2+ times in 5 straight games.
- **Nolan Arenado's** 35 homers, 85 extra-base hits and 119 RBI vs. Giants lead all active MLB players.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MICHAEL SOROKA (6-2, 3.27)

- Tossed his fourth quality start in the 3-2 loss on May 22 vs. Rockies after exiting with a 2-1 lead (1 ER in 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 2 K).
- In his last 2 starts vs. Giants, is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER in 14.0 IP), 1 walk and 9 strikeouts.

- Since Aug. 30, 2025, his 8 wins are tied for second most by a lefty starter (also: Chris Sale/ATL and Parker Messick/CLE), behind Max Fried/NYY (9)...in his 16 starts in the span, is 8-2 with a 2.45 ERA (27 R-26 ER in 95.2 IP) and 70 strikeouts.

LAST START: Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with a no-decision in the 2-1 win on May 21 vs. Rockies (4 H, 1 BB, 4 K).

- Tossed multiple 7.0+-inning shutout bids in a season for the first time since 2023 with the Tigers (Aug. 8 vs. Twins and Sept. 24 @ Athletics).

VS. GIANTS: Sixth start, third on the road.

- Won his last road start on Sept. 10, 2025 (0 ER in 6.1 IP, 2 H, 6 K).
- The D-backs went 3-0 in his 3 starts in 2025.
- In his last 8 starts vs. NL West, is 3-2 with a 2.64 ERA (15 R-14 ER in 47.2 IP) and 39 strikeouts.

MAY DAYS: In 4 May starts, is 2-1 with a 1.30 ERA (4 ER in 27.2 IP), an opponent .196 AVG (19-for-97), 7 walks and 21 strikeouts...no D-back starter has posted a May ERA of 1.52 or better in 5+ starts (last: Patrick Corbin, 1.53 in 5 GS, May 2013).

 - Has allowed 2 runs (1 ER) in his last 23 games, going 1-1 with a 0.40 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 22.1 IP), opponent .139 AVG (10-for-72), 0.58 WHIP, 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.

 - Has not allowed a run in 7 of his last 8 road games, going 0-1 with 5 saves...owns an opponent .154 AVG, 0.82 WHIP with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.
