**THE GIANTS:** Begin a 10-day, 10-game road trip starting with a four-game series against the Dodgers tonight...the Giants took two of three games against the Dodgers in the first meeting at Oracle Park from April 21-23, limiting LA to four runs in the series...Ohtani went 1-for-13 (.077) in the three-game set with a single and five strikeouts...SF has lost 13 of its last 16 games here at Uniqllo Field at Dodger Stadium.

- ▶ SF is coming off their first walk-off win of the season yesterday, a 7-6, 12-inning victory against the Pirates...**Jesús Rodríguez** recorded the first walk-off hit of his career with a single in the 12th.
- ▶ Enter today eight games under the .500 mark.
- ▶ The Giants will be seeking to win consecutive games for the first time since April 25-26 vs. Miami.
- ▶ SF's 16-24 (.400) record entering play today is the third-worst in the National League, ahead of the Mets (15-25, .375) and Rockies (16-25, .390).

**TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:** The Giants made the following roster moves today:

- ▶ **C Logan Porter & RHP Dylan Smith** optioned post-game yesterday to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Tristan Beck** (#43) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Harrison Bader** (#9) returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10-day IL.

**ON THE ROAD:** Tonight is the start of a 10-game, 10-day road trip for the Giants, in which they'll play the Dodgers (four games), Athletics (three) and Diamondbacks (three)...SF has lost each of its last seven games away from Oracle Park, totaling just nine runs (last road win came April 18 at WSH).

- ▶ The Giants' 6-12 (.333) road record is tied for the fourth-worst in MLB.
- ▶ The Giants are currently in a stretch of playing 13 consecutive days without an off day, matching their longest such streak of the season.
- ▶ Tonight also begins a stretch in which the Giants will play 20 of their next 26 games on the road.

**TONIGHT'S STARTER:** **RHP Trevor McDonald** takes the hill tonight for his second start of the season and the fourth of his career...McDonald, who was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento this past Friday to replace **RHP Logan Webb** (IL) on the roster, defeated the Padres last Monday, allowing one run on two hits in 7.0 innings...the Giants needed a starter for that game after a doubleheader in Philadelphia the previous week...McDonald was optioned to Triple-A after the outing.

- ▶ In his win last Monday, McDonald was the first Giants rookie with at least 7.0 innings, eight strikeouts and two or fewer hits allowed since Chris Heston's no-hitter in 2015.
- ▶ McDonald has faced the Dodgers once in his career on Sept. 21 of last season, firing off 6.0 innings and allowing just one run on six hits with three strikeouts in a 3-1 Giants win.

**LEAVING THE YARD:** The Giants have homered in six straight games, their longest streak of the season and the second-longest active streak in MLB (Phillies, eight)...the Giants are 13-6 (.684) when they homer this season, the seventh-best mark in MLB.

- ▶ The Giants' 26 home runs overall this season are tied with the Brewers for the fewest among all Major League teams...they've hit just 11 of their 26 homers on the road and haven't hit a home run in their last seven road games.

**HEATING UP:** **IF/DH Rafael Devers** is 10-for-30 (.333) with six extra-base hits (four doubles, two homers) and five RBI in nine games this month after going 25-for-121 (.207) with two homers and 11 RBI in 31 games in March/April...Devers owns a 1.049 OPS in nine games this month, seventh-best in the NL (min. 25 PA)...his .938 career OPS in May is third-best among active players (min. 300 PA) behind Aaron Judge (1.149) and Mike Trout (.973)...Devers' career slugging in May (.575) is second among active players to Judge (.717) (Stats, LLC).

**FOR THE FIRST TIME:** No Giants active player has ever faced tonight's opposing starter Roki Sasaki, who faces the Giants for the first time in his MLB career.

# TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

## 2026 RECORD: 1-0, 1.29 ERA

**T-MAC:** Is pitching in a part of his third different season with SF (also 2024 and 2025)...was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, Mississippi...was originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was called up to spot start against the Padres last Monday and was once again excellent when putting on a big league uniform...he limited San Diego to a run on just two hits, hit one batter, didn't walk anyone and struck out eight over 7.0 innings in SF's 3-2 win...he was incredibly efficient, needing only 81 pitches to navigate the 7.0 innings...part of that was getting ahead often with a 75.0% first pitch strike percentage.

**THERE AND BACK:** Despite his solid outing last Monday vs. San Diego he was optioned back to Triple-A the next day so he could remain stretched out as a starter in case a need arose...the need arose rather quickly with **RHP Logan Webb** hitting the IL retroactive to last Wednesday with right knee bursitis...with the injury, SF recalled McDonald and he's starting in Webb's spot tonight.

**VS. LOS ANGELES-NL:** Is making his second career start against the Dodgers tonight...he opened a lot of eyes in his first start against them here at Chavez Ravine last September in the Giants' 3-1 victory...in that outing he limited LA to a single run on six hits with one walk and three strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a no-decision.

**IN TRIPLE-A:** Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento prior to being called up early last week...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) compared to on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

**LAST SEASON IN TRIPLE-A:** Spent the majority of the 2025 season pitching for Triple-A Sacramento, going 9-9 with a 5.31 ERA (84er, 142.1ip), 144 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP over 29 games (24 starts) in the hitter-friendly PCL.

**IN THE MAJORS:** When his number has been called at the Major League level he's been incredibly effective...he made his MLB debut on the last day of the season in 2024, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...in three games (two starts) last year he went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3er, 15.0ip) with SF winning both of his starts...in his brief MLB career thus far he owns a 1.44 ERA (4er, 25.0ip) with 23 strikeouts in five games (three starts).

**A MEMORABLE OUTING:** In his second career MLB start (September 26, 2025 vs. Colorado) he earned his first career win and recorded the first double digit strikeout (10) game of his career while allowing three unearned runs in 7.0 innings...became one of five Giants in the SF era to have a 10+ strikeout game in career game four or fewer, joining **Kyle Harrison** (2023), **Tim Lincecum** (2007), **Shawn Estes** (1996) and **Juan Marichal** (1960).

**GROUNDING:** Albeit a small sample size, McDonald posted a 54.5% groundball rate in 2025...in his outing last Monday vs. San Diego he had a 66.7% ground ball percentage (10 grounders of the 15 balls put in play).

**SLIDE OVER:** His slider was his most-used pitch in the Majors last season (50.5% usage rate), with a .125 opposing batting average (4x32), a 36.4% whiff rate and a +4 run value while accounting for 12 of his 14 strikeouts...he used it 25 times last time out against the Padres (30.9% usage rate).

# ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

## 2026 RECORD: 0-4, 6.19 ERA

▶ Received a loss in his last start despite putting forth an overall solid outing...allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits (one being a homer) and a walk while striking out three over 6.0 innings vs. San Diego on May 6.

▶ Will be facing the Dodgers for the fourth time in his career (all at Dodger Stadium)...he is 0-3 with a 12.34 ERA (16er, 11.2ip), 13 strikeouts and a 2.14 WHIP.

▶ Lefties are slashing .386/.447/.747 vs. Houser while righties are slashing .191/.214/.294.

### #43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 5/9 vs. RNO; 2.1ip, 2k (23 pitches) (w/AAA)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento earlier today...made 13 appearances with the River Cats out of the 'pen and had a 5.40 ERA (10er, 16.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks.
- ▶ In his last two games with the River Cats last week, Beck combined to throw 4.0 scoreless with one hit, no walks and four strikeouts.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; W, 2.0ip, 2bb, ibb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings with a strikeout to get his first win as a Giant yesterday.
- ▶ Has a 5.06 ERA (3er, 5.1ip) and .316 BAA over his last five games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-29 (.172) with four walks and eight strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (72-for-398) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-26 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/9 vs. PIT; 0.2ip, 4h, 4r, 3er, k (30 pitches)

- ▶ In his last four outings, he has a 7.11 ERA (5er, 6.1ip) and .370 BAA (10x27)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x48).
- ▶ Has thrown 8.1 scoreless innings in six appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 13 contests (5.60 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-40 (.325) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-27 (.259).

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 5/9 vs. PIT; 0.2ip, h, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two ER) in 1.6.0ip this year (1.13 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 10g (7.2ip, 4h, 1r, 6bb, 3k).
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-18 (.111) against him this season, and 19-for-101 in his career (.188).
- ▶ His 26.7% hard hit rate ranks in the top 6% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 0.1ip, bb (9 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first appearance with SF yesterday, throwing 0.1 innings...the outing marked his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL yesterday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, 2bb (19 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first career save last Monday vs. SD.
- ▶ Has allowed a run in three of his last four outings after allowing just one run in his first 14 games.
- ▶ Owns a 24.0% strikeout rate and .148 BAA (9x61) this season.
- ▶ Has a 6.00 BB/9ip...his 16% walk rate ranks in the bottom 4% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-37 (.135) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 1.1ip, h, 2r, er, bb, hb (30 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on Tuesday after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 3.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in three games so far.
- ▶ Had a 4.82 ERA (5er, 9.1ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the 10 rehab outings.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h (7 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with eight holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 14 of his 18 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.60 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 8-for-64 (.140) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 4-for-33 with 12 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ His 84.3 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 3% of the league while his 25.0% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
