THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals are past the midpoint of their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days. Tonight, the Cardinals conclude a three-game series with the Texas Rangers. Tomorrow, the Cardinals will have an open date before welcoming the Cincinnati Reds for three games (June 5-7), the final N.L. Central team who has yet to visit Busch Stadium this season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and one game behind Pittsburgh. The 6.5 games is the largest deficit of the season for the Cardinals.

SWEEP-STAKES: The Cardinals are looking to avoid being swept for the 3rd time this season, previously swept by Seattle (Apr. 24-26) at Busch Stadium and by Milwaukee (May 25-27) at American Family Field. The Cardinals were swept by the Rangers their first two regular season matchups at Busch Stadium (2013 & 2016) and are trying to avoid a 3rd sweep tonight. The only other time the Cardinals played the Rangers at Busch Stadium in the regular season was in July 2024, when they won 2-of-3 games

WESTWARD HO'(ME)?: St. Louis is 5-1 on the road against American League West opponents this season and 0-5 at home. Following tonight's game, the Cardinals only have the Los Angeles Angels remaining, and will be playing them in a three-game series in Orange County (July 20-22).

BIG HITS: The Cardinals have three players with 12 or more RBI in situations to tie the game or take the lead. **Alec Burleson** (13), **JJ Wetherholt** (12) and **Jordan Walker** (12) lead the list with Walker adding to his total last night.

HIT ME!: **Iván Herrera** was hit by pitch for the 12th time last night, three shy of his career high (15) set last season. His 12 HBP in the first 59 games of a season are the most by a Cardinal since **Fernando Viñia** with 13 in 2000. Rookie **JJ Wetherholt** has also been hit by pitch 10 times and ranks 2nd in the National League. The Cardinals lead all National League teams getting hit 41 times this season and trailing only the Los Angeles Angels (42) in MLB.

HOME RUN CYCLE: Cardinals third baseman **Nolan Gorman** blasted his 7th home run of the season last night and has now homered against 26-of-29 (Cardinals excluded) opponents in his career. Only the White Sox, Tigers and Giants remain on his punch list with the Cardinals already having played the Tigers (April 3-5) this season.

GOING OFF COURSE: **Andre Pallante** snapped his rotating win-loss pattern in his last start vs. Chicago (NL) taking a no decision departing after 3.0 innings in a game the Cardinals won 6-5. Prior to Friday, Pallante had won his four previous road starts and lost his four previous home starts. This pattern ran from April 12 vs. Boston to May 23 at Cincinnati. Pallante's only winning decision at home came on March 31 vs. New York (NL).

NICE SHOOTING, TEX!: Shortstop **Masyn Winn** has had a lot of success against teams from his home state this season. He hit both of his home runs this season (4/18 at HOU & 6/1 vs. TEX) once against each team and is batting .333 (8-24) with 8 RBI over five games. Winn has hit safely in 7-of-8 career games vs. the Rangers with two solo home runs. Against tonight's starter, **MacKenzie Gore**, Winn has posted a .455 (5-11) career batting mark with a home run, double and 4 RBI.

NOOT NEWS & INJURY VIEWS: Cardinals outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (heel surgery) concluded his 20-day injury rehabilitation assignment this afternoon in Memphis (AAA). Nootbaar's 12-game tour compiled a .257 BA (9-35), 3 HR, 8 RBI, 9 walks and a .962 OPS. Cardinals manager Oliver Marmol informed the media yesterday outfielder **Nathan Church** is scheduled to begin his rehab assignment on Thursday in Memphis (AAA).

Michael McGreevy made his MLB debut against the Rangers (July 31, 2024 at Busch III).

George Soriano's first cousin, **Alfonso Soriano**, played two All-Star seasons with Texas (2004-05).

Thomas Saggese was originally selected by Texas in the 5th round of the 2020 MLB Draft...played parts of his first three seasons (2020-23) in the Rangers system before traded to St. Louis with RHP **Tekoah Roby** and LHP **John King** for **Jordan Montgomery** and **Chris Stratton** (July 30, 2023).

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Making his 12th start of the 2026 season tonight & his 2nd of the homestand - it's his 73rd career start (181st career appearance).
- Is seeking his 6th win of the season which would match his season total from last year when he went 6-15; It would also be his 30th career win.
- Had his streak of 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP to begin the season snapped last Fri. (5/29) vs. CHC when he exited after 3,0 IP (75 pitches). His 10 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season were the most since **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- He alternated Home & Road starts to begin the season in his first 11 starts, but that trend ends tonight with his first consecutive Home start.
- Is trying to snap a 4-game losing streak at Busch Stadium dating back to his lone Home win on 3/31 vs. NYM; Has received just 8 total runs of support for a 2.32 RSA at Busch Stadium in 2026.
- Averaging 8.00 RSA on the road and 2.32 at home. Has yet to receive more than 3 runs in a home start or less than 3 runs in a road start.
- His 181st career appearance tonight passes **Chris Carpenter** (180) for 69th all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 181 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 70 or more starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (72), wins (29), innings pitched (518.0) and strikeouts (367).**
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar (60-day IL)** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, May 29 vs. Chicago N.L.): ND, W, 6-5; 3.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 75 pitches.

- Had his 2nd shortest career start (3.0 IP) with both coming against the Cubs at Busch Stadium (1.2 IP start on 8/9/25).
- Allowed a 3-run HR by Ian Happ in opening inning, but the Cardinals rebounded for a 6-5 win, hitting three HR's of their own.

2026 NOTES:

ROAD HOUSE: Posted the lone Cardinals win on CIN/MIL road trip, winning the opening game of DH on 5/23 at CIN to improve to 4-0 on the road.

3 TURNS: Pitched into the 7th inning vs. KC (5/17) with a season-high 6.2 innings and 27 batters faced in a 2-0 loss.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (5/12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .189 BA (14-74) with his slider, and 25 of his 46 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 10 of his 11 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in five of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a 1.006 OPS, 13 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning; batters are hitting .435 (10-23) when contacting the 1st pitch of an 0-0 at-bat.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched a then season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-16 in his 36 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 17-19 in those games.
- **Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (62.6%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.**
- As a starting pitcher (386.1 IP), Pallante's 59.2 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 370.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. TEXAS:

- Is making his 3rd career appearance and 2nd start against the Rangers - his 1st since 2024.
- Worked 1.1 IP in relief on 6/5/23, striking out three in the Cardinals first-ever series visit to Globe Life Field.
- Made his lone start against the Rangers on 7/29/24 at Busch Stadium, taking the loss in a 6-3 decision
- Owns a 8-9, 4.65 career mark in Interleague games and is 6-9, 4.75 in 21 career Interleague starts
- Has gone 2-1 with a 4.11 ERA in his three starts vs. AL West clubs this year, beating HOU & ATH and losing to SEA.
