RAY REPORT-The Rays conclude a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-3),
Kansas City (1-2) and Oakland (1-1, 1 to play) today at Tropicana Field, going 2-6 thus far
they have dropped seven of their last nine games after posting an 11-4 mark in their
previous 15 contestsfollowing today's game, Tampa Bay will meet AL East-leading
Baltimore seven times in 11 days from May 31-June 10, traveling to Camden Yards for a
three-game set (May 31-June 2) before a four-game series at Tropicana Field from June
7-10sandwiched between the seven games are two off days (May 3 and 6) and a two-
game set at Miami (May 4-5).

Tampa Bay recorded its 14th comeback victory in last night's walk-off win, tied with Cleveland for fourth most in the AL behind Baltimore (16) and Detroit/New York (15).

York (15).

The Rays have allowed three runs or fewer in a season-high three straight games after yielding 5+ runs in each of their previous six contests.

Tampa Bay's five doubles last night were its most since Sept. 10, 2023 vs. Seattle (also 5 2B)...its 6 XBH matched a season high (also May 11 vs. NYY).

The Rays earned their 11th win of the season without the assistance of a home run...the 11 such victories are tied for the MLB lead with San Diego and San Francisco...Tampa Bay had 14 wins with 0 HR a season ago.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Improve to 8-8-2 in series play, including a 4-5-2 mark at home. Earn their fourth rubber match win of the season, including the second at home, joining April 18 vs. Los Angeles-AL

Ímprove to 5-4-2 in series play vs. Oakland at Tropicana Field since 2013.

OPENING ACT-RHP Shawn Armstrong will make his fifth start of the season as an OPENING ACT—RHP Shawn Armstrong will make his fifth start of the season as an opener for bulk reliever LHP Tyler Alexander...the Rays are 2-2 in his previous starts this season (March 31 vs. TOR; April 14 vs. SF; April 24 vs. DET; May 24 vs. KC), all opening for Alexander...Armstrong has been the Rays opener each of the last six times the club has utilized one dating back to July 15 (G2), 2023 at KC.

Alexander served as a bulk reliever on May 24 vs. KC and allowed career highs in runs (8) and hits (11) across 5.0 innings...this, following his May 17 start at Toronto in which he retired 22 consecutive Blue Jays to open the game.

Since introducing the concept of an opener on May 19, 2018 at Angel Stadium, the Rays are 104-68 (.605) when using one, including 2-2 this season and a 12-9 mark in 2023...they are 413-298 (.581) in all other contests over that timeframe

Last season, the Rays used an opener 19 times in the first half of the season compared to only twice after the All-Star break (July 15-G2 at KC; Sept. 30 at TOR).

ALL ABOUT ISAAC—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 games since April 28, hitting .330/.436/.505 (30-for-91) with 7 2B, 3 HR, 14 RBI, 15 BB and 15 SO...he ranks third in the AL in both batting average and on-base pct. during that span... Paredes has reached safely in 35 of his last 38 games overall since April 14, posting the AL's third-best average over that timeframe (.319/44-for-138) behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.333) and KC Salvador Perez (.322).

Min. 60 AB, his .352 (25-for-71) AVG against relief pitchers is tied with teammate Amed Rosario for the best mark in the AL and is tied with LAD Mookie Betts for the third-best clip in the majors, trailing MIL William Contreras (.419) and CHC Mike Tauchman (.356).

Paredes is batting .277 (31-for-112) with 5 2B, 5 HR and 14 RBI with two strikes...min 75 AB, his .277 two-strike average leads the AL and is fourth highest in the majors behind STL Masyn Winn (.311) and LAD Mookie Betts/SD Luis Arraez (both .284).

Paredes' 31 hits with two strikes are tied with Betts and KC Bobby Witt Jr. for second most in the majors, trailing only HOU Jose Altuve (33H).

DAWGS GOTTA EAT—Brandon Lowe has reached base safely in 12 straight games against Oakland dating to May 8, 2021, batting .372 (16-for-43) with 2 2B, 5 HR, 15 RBI, 7 BB and 13 runs...it marks the longest on-base streak by a Tampa Bay batter vs. Oakland since James Loney's 12-game run from April 21, 2013–May 22, 2015...the last Ray to reach base safely in 13 straight games vs. the A's was Evan Longoria (13G: July 27, 2011–Aug. 31, 2013).

Lowe's eight career home runs and 24 RBI against Oakland are both his highest totals against any non-divisional opponent...his 1.071 OPS against the Athletics is tied with the Red Sox for his highest against any club.

START ME UP—Tampa Bay starters have posted a 2.36 ERA (34.1IP, 9ER) over their last seven games, the fifth-best mark in the majors during that stretch behind St. Louis (1.15), New York-AL (1.16), Baltimore (1.88) and Miami (2.25)...despite this, the starting staff has a collective 0-1 record during that time, with Tyler Alexander (May 17 at TOR) earning the lone win from a Rays starter.

Overall, Tampa Bay pitching owns a 1.00 ERA (27.0IP, 3ER) over the last three games.

POWER OUTAGE—The Rays 43 home runs are second fewest in the majors behind Chicago-AL (39HR)...they have hit 2 HR in their last eight games, their fewest in any eight-game stretch since hitting 2 HR from Sept. 24–Oct. 2, 2022.

Tampa Bay has gone 13 straight games without a multi-homer game, its longest streak since a 13-game stretch from Sept. 19–Oct. 2, 2022...the last time the Rays went 14 straight games without a 2+ HR game was June 9-23, 2018 (14G).

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—With last night's 4-3 win, the Rays improved to 10-4 (.714) in one-run games, the second-best winning pct. in the majors behind Seattle (11-4/.733)... Tampa Bay's 19-8 (.704) winning pct. in games decided by two runs or fewer leads MLB, ahead of Baltimore (18-9/.667) and Philadelphia (14-7/.667).

MAY FLOWERS—Since taking over in 2015, Kevin Cash has guided Tampa Bay to a 141-110 (.562) record in the month of May, the fourth-best May winning pct. in MLB during that stretch behind Los Angeles-NL/New York-AL (both 155-93/.625) and Houston (158-95/.625)...with a win today, the Rays, who are 13-12 this month, can clinch a winning May for the seventh straight season (excluding 2020)...the 2016 Rays were the last to have a sub-500 record in May (11-16).

BATTLE OF THE BAYS—Tampa Bay and Oakland finish a three-game set this afternoon at Tropicana Field...the Rays and A's will meet in Oakland for a four-game set from Aug. 19-22.

Tampa Bay took five of seven games from Oakland in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field from April 7-9 as part of its modern era-record-tying 13-game winning streak to open the season.

From Sept. 5, 1998–Sept. 5, 2003, Tampa Bay went 7-39 (.152) against Oakland...in 153 games since, the Rays have posted a 76-77 (.497) mark against the Athletics.

Armstrong will serve as the Rays opener for **LHP Tyler Alexander**... he owns a 1.50 ERA (6.0IP, 1ER) and 0.33 WHIP in his last five outings. The right-hander owns a 6.00 ERA (9.0IP, 6ER) in 8G vs. Oakland. This marks his fifth start of the season, all opening for Alexander. the Rays are 3-1 in his previous starts...in his last appearance as an opener on May 24 vs. KC, tossed 2.0 scoreless innings (2.0IP, 3SO). He made six starts last season, including four as an opener (June 7, July 15, Aug. 12, Sept. 30)...did not allow an ER in those games (12.0IP). In his career, Armstrong is 0-2 with a 1.40 ERA (25.2IP, 4ER) over 13 starts, all with Tampa Bay...the Rays are 9-4 in those games.

TODAY'S START—Alexander will make his 11th appearance and seventh start of the season this afternoon...marks his seventh game/third start at home...over his last two outings, he has allowed career highs in hits and runs May 24 vs. KC) and carried a perfect game into the 8th inning (May 17 at TOR)...is seeking his first home win since April 14 vs. SF...has recorded 5.0+ IP in three straight games for the first time since Sept. 11–Oct. 5, 2022 (5G).

In his last outing on May 24 vs. KC, he took the loss while working behind opener RHP Shawn Armstrong (L, 5.0IP, 11H, 8ER, BB, 4SO, 21LB, 21 LB).

ALEXANDER AND THE A'S—In two career relief appearances against the Athletics, both at Oakland Coliseum, Alexander has turned in a 1.59 ERA (5.2IP, 1ER)...his most recent outing came on April 15, 2021, when he worked the final 2.2 IP of an 8-4 Detroit loss (2.2IP, 4H, ER, 2BB, 2SO)...this marks his first appearance opposite an AL West club this season after pitching to a 3.72 ERA (9.2IP, 4ER) in five relief appearances against the division in 2023.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Alexander owns a career-high 73.2 pct. first-pitch strike rate, the second-highest mark in the majors behind DET Tarik Skubal (74.2%)...he has thrown 55.3 pct. of his pitches in the strike zone overall, seventh highest in the majors/fifth in the AL behind Zach Eflin (56.6%), Skubal (55.7%), BAL Cole Irvin (55.7%) and MIN Joe Ryan (55.7%).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Alexander has yielded 12 HR, tied for second most in the majors behind SD Michael King (13)...in Rays history, only Doug Waechter (16, 2004), Esteban Yan (13, 2000) and Dennis Springer (13, 1998) have allowed more home runs through their first 10 appearances in a season...Alexander has been tagged for 7 HR over four outings (3GS) in the month of May, tied for the most over any four-game span in his career (3x, last: Aug. 20–Sept. 5, 2022)...it also ties the most homers he has permitted in a calendar month, matching Sept./Oct. 2022...of the 35 total runs he has allowed, 20 (57.1%) have come via the 12 HR.

**BOTTOMS UP**—The 7-9 spots in the opposing order are hitting .348/.375/.580 (24-for-69) with a .955 OPS against Alexander...min. 50 AB, only WSH **Patrick Corbin** (.384) has allowed a higher such opp. average... nine-hole hitters are a combined 12-for-23 (.522) against him with a 1.281

OPS...min. 20 BF, both marks are the highest in the majors.

He has held 1-6 hitters to a .234 (32-for-137) average and .747 OPS...
opposing lead-off hitters are 3-for-26 (.115) against him with 7 SO.

SWINGMAN—Of his 130 career appearances, 49 (37.7%) have come as a starter while 81 were in relief...his 42 relief appearances of 2.0+ IP since 2020 are tied for fourth most in the majors, trailing Brent Suter (49), Erasmo Ramírez (45) and Nabil Crismatt (44)—he has gone 7-4 with a 3.98 ERA (115.1IP, 51ER) in those outings.

In his six starts this season, Alexander has produced a 5.06 ERA (32.0IP, 18ER)...in four outings working behind an opener, he has recorded a 7.65 ERA (20.0IP, 17ER), but eight of those runs came in his last outing on May 24 vs. KC.

**NEARLY PERFECT**—On May 17 at TOR, Alexander carried a perfect game in the 8th inning, retiring 22 consecutive Blue Jays before **Danny Jansen's** bloop single...the 7.1 IP effort marked the second-longest individual perfect game bid in Rays history behind **Drew Rasmussen**, who sat down 24 BF (8.0 IP) on Aug. 14, 2022 vs. BAL before allowing a **Jorge Mateo** double on the first pitch of the 9th inning.
