YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The O's fell to the Astros, 14-11, in the opener of the three-game set...Marked their most runs allowed since September 10, 2022 at Boston (17)...Houston put up a nine-run sixth inning, Baltimore's most runs allowed in a single frame since giving up 10 in the top of the third on September 12, 2021 vs. Toronto...Have scored double-digit runs in back-to-back games for the first time since March 28-30 against the Angels; the club record for consecutive games with 10+ runs is three, done six times and most recently from September 6-9, 2023...Marked Baltimore's first loss when scoring double-digit runs since September 24, 2022 vs. Houston (11-10); had been 24-0 when scoring at least 10 runs since then...Have recorded 18+ hits in consecutive games for just the fourth time in team history and first since July 15-16, 1998; have never tallied 18+ hits in three straight games and an MLB team has not done so since the Rockies from June 14-16, 2019...**Gunnar Henderson** (2), **Jorge Mateo**, and **Anthony Santander** all homered in the loss; the Birds dropped a game when hitting at least four home runs for the first time since September 27, 2022 at Boston (also 4).

- ⚾ Henderson became the 13th Oriole (16th occurrence) with a multi-homer game in which he also stole a base, and first since **Austin Hays** on September 23, 2019 at Toronto.
- ⚾ **Adley Rutschman** picked up his second career five-hit game (3/30/23 at BOS).

RUNNIN' WILD: **Gunnar Henderson** has set a career high with 13 stolen bases this year...He is 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts to open the campaign, tied for the most successful stolen base attempts to start a season in team history with **Cedric Mullins** (2023) and **Corey Patterson** and **Brian Roberts** (2006)...Henderson is one of six players in MLB with at least 10 stolen base attempts and no caught stealing...As a team, the Orioles are 59-for-69 on stolen bases attempts...Their 85.5 stolen base percentage ranks second in the AL and third in MLB behind the Brewers (86.1%) and Blue Jays (86.7%), and would be the best mark in a season in O's history, ahead of an 84.1 percent success rate (69-for-82) in 1994.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won 12 of their last 18, 15 of 22, and 20 of 28...At 49-26 (.653), the Birds are tied with the Phillies for the second-best record in MLB, behind the Yankees (.654, 51-27)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 150-87 (.633), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors...The O's are 233-166 (.584) since the start of 2022, the best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Braves (.622, 247-150) and Dodgers (.642, 258-144).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 123 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (113) and Dodgers (106)...Have homered in 20 consecutive games, the longest streak in MLB this season and tied for the longest such streak in team history with another 20-gamer from July 17 to August 9, 1998.

- ⚾ The Orioles are 42-17 this year when homering, 33-5 when hitting multiple home runs, 17-4 when hitting at least three, and 4-1 when hitting four.
- ⚾ Baltimore has five players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB this season: **Gunnar Henderson** (24), **Anthony Santander** (20), **Adley Rutschman** (14), and **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Jordan Westburg** (11).
- ⚾ Henderson and Santander are the only teammates in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season.
- ⚾ The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** ranks second in MLB with 24 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (27)...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

- ⚾ He owns a career-best 28-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an O's batter since **Ryan Mountcastle** also had a 28-game streak from July 21 to August 23, 2023; the last longer streak by an Oriole was **Nick Markakis**' 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009.
- ⚾ Also has a career-long 14-game hitting streak since June 6, tied for the second-longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest hitting streak by an O's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: **Anthony Santander** leads MLB with 11 home runs this month...He is the first O's batter with double-digit home runs in a single calendar month since he did so in September 2022 (10)...He is the first Oriole to hit 11+ homers in a single month since **Manny Machado** hit 12 in August 2017...The club record for home runs in a month is 15 by **Jim Gentile** in August 1961...The club record for home runs in June is 12 by **Boog Powell** (1964), **Rafael Palmeiro** (1998), **Albert Belle** (2000), and **Chris Davis** (2013).

- ⚾ Santander's 81 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (83) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (126).

O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The Orioles are 2-2 on the current six-game road against the Yankees (2-1) and Astros (0-1)...The Birds are 24-12 (.667) on the road this year, tied with the Yankees (28-14) for the best road winning percentage in MLB...Since the start of 2023, they are 76-41 (.650) on the road, the best road winning percentage and most road wins in MLB; no other team has a road winning percentage over .600 during that span.

AGAINST HOUSTON: The Orioles and Astros continue a seven-game season series with the second of three games in Houston tonight...The O's will host the Astros for four games from August 22-25...Baltimore split the season series against Houston last year, 3-3, going 1-2 at Oriole Park and 2-1 at Minute Maid Park...The Orioles have gone 10-10 (.500) against the Astros since the start of 2021.

ALL-STAR VOTING: Earlier this week, MLB announced the first balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game...The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot, which is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App, will be accessible until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12 p.m. ET on Thursday, June 27...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. on Thursday, June 27, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league...As of the first update, five Orioles were on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right), while two were leading their positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014...The second Phase 1 update will be shared by MLB on Monday, June 24.

- ⚾ **Adley Rutschman** led AL catchers and ranked third in the AL with 792,857 votes; seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
- ⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** led AL shortstops and ranked sixth in the AL with 740,436 votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** in 2018.
- ⚾ **Ryan Mountcastle** ranked second among AL first basemen with 693,594 votes, trailing Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (746,031); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Chris Davis** in 2013.
- ⚾ **Jordan Westburg** ranked second among AL third basemen with 366,670 votes, trailing Cleveland's Jose Ramirez (742,910); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.
- ⚾ **Anthony Santander** ranked fifth among AL outfielders with 321,333 votes; seeking his first All-Star selection and would join **Austin Hays** (2023) and **Cedric Mullins** (2021) as outfielders to represent the O's at the All-Star Game in the last four seasons.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 16th start of the season today against the Astros...Burnes' 2.14 ERA (22 ER/92.2 IP) is tied with Pat Dobson (1972) for the eighth lowest for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 15 starts to begin a season and the lowest since Jim Palmer in 1978 (1.86)...His ERA is the second lowest by an O's starting pitcher through his first 15 starts to begin his O's career in team history (since 1954)...Has not allowed more than three runs in 17 consecutive outings dating back to last season, the longest active streak by a full-time starter and the longest by an Orioles starter since Tyler Wells (17, 4/16-7/15/22)...The Orioles are 11-4 in his starts this year...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the win on June 16 vs. Philadelphia after allowing two runs on seven hits and two walks with seven strikeouts across 6.0 innings...Had pitched 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings against the Phillies, dating back to July 20, 2023 at Citizens Bank Park (w/MIL), before giving up a run in the fifth inning...Allowed three stolen bases for the sixth time in his career and fourth time this season...Became the first Oriole to record 10 consecutive quality starts since Jeremy Guthrie (5/8-6/26/07)...Threw 94 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE ASTROS: Slated to make his third career appearance and second start against Houston...Owns a lifetime 0-1 record with a 7.50 ERA (5 ER/6.0 IP) in his two prior outings against the Astros...Was dealt the loss in his only start against them on May 22, 2023 at American Family Field (w/MIL) after allowing five runs on seven hits (4 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts; the four home runs are a career high.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes has tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, marking the longest active streak in the majors and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 12 quality starts on the season are tied for the most in MLB and his 51 quality starts since the start of 2022 are the second most...His 12 games of at least 6.0 innings are two behind the MLB lead entering today.

NEW BEGINNINGS: Burnes has begun his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings is the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles all-time.

EARLY STRUGGLES: After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo home runs; the four first-inning homers allowed are tied for the ninth most in MLB.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 41 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 655.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (673.1 IP) and San Francisco's Logan Webb (656.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.

Scheduled to make his ninth start and 16th appearance of the season in his first career appearance against the Astros...Was dealt the loss his last start on June 18 at New York-AL after allowing three runs on six hits and a career-high five walks with three strikeouts in 3.2 innings; the 3.2 innings are a career low as a starter...Owns a lifetime 1-0 record with a 4.26 ERA (9 ER/19.0 IP) across five appearances (3 GS) against the AL West.
