THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game, eight-day homestand with a record of 1-6 (1-3 vs. Detroit, 0-3 vs. the Athletics), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win against the White Sox at Rate Field last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three at Rate Field...after tomorrow's series finale, Minnesota will fly to Toronto for a three-game series at Rogers Centre, from Monday-Wednesday.
☞ The Twins are 5-3 in their last eight road games.

GRAND NIGHT ON THE SOUTH SIDE: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 9-7, snapping their three-game losing streak...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...Justin Toppa earned his third save with 1.2 scoreless innings...the offense recorded 12 hits, walked seven times and went 5-for-15 with runners in scoring position...Royce Lewis led the offense, going 3-for-5 with a grand slam...Byron Buxton and Luke Keaschall each reached three times, both recording two hits and a walk.

READY, WILLING & ABEL: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Mick Abel from Triple-A St. Paul...Abel, who was acquired in the Johan Duran trade with Philadelphia over the trade deadline, recently made three starts for the Saints, posting a 1.76 ERA (15.1 IP, 3 ER) with seven hits allowed, six walks and 23 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .140 batting average...in his last start for the Saints on August 16 at Omaha, he set a franchise record with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings pitched...he was originally drafted by the Phillies 15th overall in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft and made his major league debut with Philadelphia earlier this season...in six major league starts, from May 18-July 2, he went 2-2 with a 5.04 ERA (25.0 IP, 14 ER), nine walks and 21 strikeouts...the 24-year-old is ranked as the club's sixth-best prospect and top pitching prospect, per MLB.com.
☞ To make room for Abel on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher José Ureña for release or assignment...Ureña appeared in four games (3 starts) for the Twins, going 0-1 with a 4.58 ERA (17.2 IP, 9 ER), eight walks and 10 strikeouts.

NORTH STARS AND SOUTH SIDERS: The Twins are playing the White Sox tonight for the eighth of 13 scheduled games in 2025...after dropping their first game on March 31 at Rate Field, the Twins have gone 5-1 in their last six vs. the Sox, outscoring them 33-19 in those five.
☞ Twins have gone 12-3 in their last 15 here.
☞ Minnesota has gone 24-4 in its last 28 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-72 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.
☞ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 92 home runs (next: Cleveland with 62)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 152 (next is KC with 117).
☞ In his last 15 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .294 (15-for-51) with two doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, 11 walks, a .419 on-base percentage and a .988 OPS.
☞ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .364 (28-for-77) with a .997 OPS in 23 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 19-straight starts against CWS.
☞ Matt Wallner is hitting .319 (23-for-72) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .467 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS in 25 career games against the White Sox...in 14 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .381/.490/.595 (1.085 OPS).
☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with five home runs, 18 RBI, nine walks, a .579 on-base percentage, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.579 OPS in eight career games vs. the White Sox...he is 9-for-19 (.474) lifetime at Rate Field, hitting safely in all five here...in those five, he has homered in three, recorded three hits twice and hit a grand slam twice.
☞ Byron Buxton's 23 career home runs and 53 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...11 home runs and 21 RBI at Rate Field his most in an opposing ballpark.

"IT'S NICE, IT'S TASTY AND IT'S FUN": Royce Lewis hit his sixth career grand slam last night...since 2022, only two other players in baseball have hit as many, Aaron Judge with seven and Max Muncy also with six...below are the Twins all-time grand slam leaders:

TURN KEA TO START: After going 2-for-4 with a walk last night, Luke Keaschall has now reached safely in 21 of 23 games to start his career...he has raised his on-base percentage to .432, reaching base 41 times (28 hits, 11 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch) in 95 plate appearances...in the right margin are Twins all-time OBPs through their first 23 career games.

20/20 VISION: Over their last nine games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.61 ERA (41.1 IP, 12 ER) with two home runs allowed, 19 walks, 34 strikeouts and a .197 opponent batting average...below are the bullpen comparisons 20 games leading up to the trade deadline and 20 games since:

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win tonight and the Twins will earn their 17th series of the season...Minnesota is 16-23-2 in series play, going 10-8-2 at home and 6-15-0 on the road.
☞ Twins are 2-0-0 in series play vs. the White Sox this season...they have gone 8-0-0 in series play vs. Chicago-AL, dating back to July of 2023.

GOTTA BE CENTERFIELD: Byron Buxton scored his 500th career run last night becoming the 18th player in Twins history (since 1961) to reach the mark...he also became the third player in Twins history to reach 500+ runs, 150+ home runs, 100+ stolen bases and 400+ RBI...the others: Kirby Puckett and Torii Hunter.

☞ Since June 17, he has homered nine times in 18 road games, tied for ninth-most in baseball during that span...since that date, he has homered in five of six road series': four homers at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two homers at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one homer at Colorado (July 18-21), one homer at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and one homer at New York-AL (August 11-13).

☞ At 25 home runs and 19 stolen bases, Buck needs one more steal to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hisle (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2009, Michael Cuddyer hit two home runs in the same inning, becoming the first member of the Twins and the 53rd major league player to do so as the Twins defeated Kansas City, 10-3.

LAST TIME OUT (MINORS): Last started for the Saints on August 16, 2025 at Omaha but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 3-4 walkoff defeat...allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR) over 6.0 innings, with no walks and a professional career-high 11 strikeouts...struck out the side in order in the first inning and was perfect through 4.0 innings...both runs came on a two-run homer to Carter Jensen (Kansas City's No. 1 prospect) in the fifth inning...retired the side in order in the sixth, including strikeouts to the final two batters faced

- ⌚ 11 strikeouts set a new franchise record for the Saints...became the fourth pitcher in franchise history to strike out double-digit hitters, joining Griffin Jax (May 28, 2021), David Festa (3x in 2024) and Randy Dobnak (June 15, 2024).
- ⌚ Became the second pitcher in franchise history to not walk a batter while recording 10-or-more strikeouts and the first to not walk or hit a batter while striking out 10-or-more.

LAST TIME OUT (MLB): Last started in the majors opposite Nick Pivetta in Game 1 of a July 2 double-header vs. the Padres at Citizens Bank Park...took the loss in Philadelphia's 6-4 defeat, allowing five runs on two hits over 1.2 innings, with five walks and three strikeouts...in the second inning, loaded the bases on two walks and a single, then walked in two runs and allowed an RBI double to Manny Machado before exiting the game.

- ⌘ Set new professional season highs in walks and runs (has since allowed 5 runs on July 25 with Lehigh Valley)...marked his shortest outing of the season at both the major and minor league levels, with his previous low being 3.0 IP on June 21 vs. the Mets.
- ⌘ Was optioned to Triple-A Lehigh Valley on July 4.

WILLING AND ABEL: Made his major league debut on May 18 at Citizens Bank Park, opposite Paul Skenes and the Pirates in a 1-0 Phillies victory...filled in for Aaron Nola, who was placed on the 15-day Injured List...allowed five hits, all singles, with no walks while striking out nine over six shutout innings...became the first Phillies pitcher to toss six-or-more scoreless innings in his MLB debut since Jerad Eickhoff in 2015...became one of only three pitchers since at least 1901 to pitch six or more scoreless innings with nine-or-more strikeouts and no walks in his MLB debut (also, Shota Imanaga on April 1, 2024 and Nick Kingham on April 29, 2018)...became first Phillies pitcher to make a start before the age of 24 since Aaron Nola in 2016.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In two road starts with Philadelphia this season, went 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and five strikeouts, compared to 1-2 with a 7.36 ERA (14.2 IP, 12 ER), seven home runs allowed, eight walks and 16 strikeouts in four starts at Citizens Bank Park...road batters have gone 6-for-37 (.162) with a .205 on-base percentage and a .270 slugging percentage (2 3B) against Abel.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed batters have slashed .263/.311/.614 with one triple, six home runs, seven RBI and a 3.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio (13 K, 4 BB) in 57 at-bats against Abel... right-handed batters have slashed .244/.340/.390 with one double, one triple, one home run, seven RBI, a hit-by-pitch and a 1.60 strikeout-to-walk ratio (8 K, 5 BB) in 41 at-bats against Abel.

- Ⓢ In 16 starts at Triple-A this season, lefties slashed .198/.276/.322 with eight doubles, one triple, four home runs and a 3.16 strikeout-to-walk ratio (60 K, 19 BB) in 117 at-bats against Abel... righties slashed .182/.285/.266 with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, two hit-by-pitches and a 2.32 strikeout-to-walk ratio (44 K, 19 BB).

THE ARSENAL: Through six MLB starts in 2025, Abel has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
