TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 9-game road trip (2-4) with the first of 3 games against the Tampa Bay Rays...Seattle has also faced the Cleveland Guardians (1-2) and Miami Marlins (1-2) on the current trip...following the current series with the Rays, Seattle returns home for a 9-game, 11-day homestand against the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners lost yesterday's rubber game to the Miami Marlins by a 6-4 final...despite the loss, the Mariners are 14-8 (.636) over their last 22 games (5/31-c) and 18-9 (.667) over their last 27 games (5/26-c), best record in the Majors during that span...Seattle is 35-3 when out-hitting its opponent.

- **#TexasVoteEm** - MLB All-Star Voting is live, with the first phase of voting ending this Thursday...you can vote for Mariners at Mariners.com/Vote...the 2024 All-Star Game is set for July 16 in Arlington, Texas.
- **Series-ly Sensational** - The Mariners own a 13-6-1 series record over their last 20 series (4/15-c).
- **Taking Care of Business** - Seattle is 31-16 (.660) against below-.500 teams, 6th-best in MLB.
- **No Fly Zone** - **Julio Rodríguez** has recorded 25 outs above average since the start of the 2022 season, tied for 3rd-best among MLB outfielders, trailing only Daulton Varsho (38 OAA) and Jose Siri (30 OAA).
- **The Juice Box** - 4 Mariners hitters own career OPS of at least .800 at Tropicana Field: **Mitch Haniger** (.954 OPS), **Dylan Moore** (.930), **J.P. Crawford** (.907) and **Jorge Polanco** (.861).

BEST IN THE WEST...the Mariners (45-35) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by 6.0 games over the 2nd place Houston Astros (38-40) and 6.5 games over the 3rd place Texas Rangers (37-40)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 43 consecutive days (5/12-c).

STEP INTO THE CANZONE...**Dominic Canzone** went 1-for-3 with 1 walk in yesterday's game...over his last 13 games, Canzone is batting .378 (14x37) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 4 walks and 1 stolen base, getting on base at a .439 clip and slugging .595 (1.034 OPS)...Canzone leads Mariners hitters with a .464 slugging percentage this season (min. 100 PA).

PURE BLISS...**Ryan Bliss** is batting .296 (13x44) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 7 RBI, 3 walks and 4 stolen bases, getting on base at a .354 clip and slugging .477 (.832 OPS) in 18 June games...among primary second basemen with at least 50 plate appearances in June, Bliss ranks 7th in average, 7th in on-base percentage, 6th in OPS and 5th in wRC+ (.141)...among all rookies with at least 50 plate appearance since the start of June, Bliss' .831 OPS ranks 6th.

ROSTER MOVES...INF **Jorge Polanco** was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List today, while INF **Tyler Locklear** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma to clear room on the active roster...Polanco has been out since May 27 with a right hamstring strain...Polanco appeared in 6 games with Triple-A Tacoma and High-A Everett on a rehab assignment, batting .300 (6x20) with 6 runs, 1 double, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 6 walks...he homered from both sides of the plate on June 21 vs. Las Vegas.

WOO!...**Bryan Woo** is 3-1 with a 1.67 ERA (7 ER, 37.2 IP), 3 walks, 25 strikeouts and a 0.61 WHIP in 7 starts this season...opponents are slashing just .153/.176/.221 (.398 OPS) against the right-hander...among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings, Woo leads the Majors in opponent on-base percentage, opponent OPS and WHIP while ranking 3rd in opponent slugging percentage and 5th in opponent average...Woo's 1.67 ERA is the 8th-best mark through a pitchers first 7 starts of a season in franchise history.

KINGS OF QUALITY...the Mariners pitching staff leads the Majors in quality starts (48), with Seattle going 37-11 (.771) when its starter goes 6.0+ innings while allowing 3-or-fewer earned runs...the Mariners have 4 starters with 8+ quality starts this season: **Logan Gilbert** (13 QS), **Luis Castillo** (10), **George Kirby** (9) and **Bryce Miller** (8), they are joined by The Philadelphia Phillies (Aarong Nola, Christopher Sánchez, Ranger Suárez and Zack Wheeler) as the only teams in the Majors with 4 pitchers recording 8+ QS this season.

ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: WORTHY OF BEING AN AL ALL-STAR...right-hander **Andrés Muñoz** has 13 saves and a 1.42 ERA (5 ER, 31.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and 10 walks in 30 appearances this season...Muñoz has posted a 0.95 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .179 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 2 American League pitchers with 13+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA this season, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE...Muñoz has recorded 5 saves of 4+ outs, most in the Majors this season.

MUÑOZ CHASING HISTORY...**Andrés Muñoz** is approaching 150 appearances with Seattle, entering today's action with 147 outings in a Mariners uniform...he holds a 2.40 ERA (39 ER, 146.1 IP) with 49 walks and 206 strikeouts in his Mariners career...Andrés has a chance to become the 7th reliever in MLB history age 25-or-younger to post a sub-2.50 ERA with 200+ strikeouts over his first 150 appearances with a club...he would join Josh Hader-MIL (2.39 ERA, 347 K), Aroldis Chapman-CIN (2.20 ERA, 233 K), Kenley Jansen-LAD (2.21 ERA, 248 K), Craig Kimbrel-ATL (2.36 ERA, 258 K), Francisco Rodríguez-LAA (2.36 ERA, 259 K) and Bruce Sutter-CHC (1.87 ERA, 268 K)...of that group Muñoz would be the **first in MLB history** to eclipse those numbers (sub-2.50 ERA/200+ K), while also allowing fewer than 60 walks.

LOGAN GILBERT: AL-ALL STAR?...**Logan Gilbert** is 5-4 with a 2.71 ERA (32 ER, 106.1 IP), 21 walks, 99 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...Gilbert ranks among the AL leaders in innings pitched (1st), WHIP (1st), Opp. AVG (4th, .196), strikeouts (T-6th) and ERA (7th)...Gilbert is the only pitcher in the Majors with 3 starts of 8.0+ scoreless inning this season.

THE NEXT HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners will return home for 9-game homestand from June 28-July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...upcoming promotions on the homestand include **J.P. Crawford "City Connect"** **Bobblehead Night** on June 28, **Aloha Shirt Night** on June 29, **Bark at the Park** on July 2, **Patriotic Fireworks** on July 3 and **Patriotic Cap** on July 4.

AS YOU KNOW...**Luke Raley** went 3-for-4 with 2 runs, 1 home run and 2 RBI in yesterday's game and is batting .271 (16x59) with 12 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 10 RBI, 4 walks and 2 hit-by-pitch, getting on base at a .339 clip and slugging .610 (.949 OPS) in 21 June games, and...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...**that since April 15, Raley is batting .281 (47x167) with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 9 home runs, 21 RBI and 5 stolen bases with a .836 OPS, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...among AL outfielders with at least 180 plate appearances since April 15, Raley ranks 9th in OPS and 7th in wRC+ (.141)?

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 24-year-old right-handed pitcher is making his 8th start of the season tonight and his 1st against Tampa Bay...marks his 26th Major League start and 1st career start against the Rays.
- Selected by Seattle in the 6th round (174th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Cal Poly University...signed by Mariners scout Chris Hom.
- Spent 3 seasons at Cal Poly before being drafted, making 31 appearances (6 GS) for the Mustangs.
- Did not pitch in 2021 while recovering from right elbow surgery.

LAST TIME OUT...L#1 on 6/19 at Cleveland...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed 3 runs on 4 hits (1 home run) with 1 walk and 1 strikeout...marked Mariners first loss in a game started by Woo.

WOO THE GREAT...when pitching 6.0+ innings he is 4-for-4 in quality starts...in 4 of his 7 starts he has allowed 0 runs...he is also the 2nd pitcher in MLB history with a sub-1.67 ERA and 8.33+ strikeout-to-walk ratio thru his first 7 starts of a season, joining Cliff Lee-CLE in 2008.

MAKING HIS WAY... his 1.07 ERA through 6 starts this season is the best mark in franchise history...he is in front of Erik Hanson (1.29) and Randy Johnson (1.21)...his 1.67 ERA through 7 starts this season is the 3rd best mark in franchise history...trailing behind Félix Hernández (1.59) and Mike Montgomery (1.62).

PITCHING POWERHOUSE...is averaging 13.4 pitches-per-inning, which is the 2nd-best mark in the Majors this season (Tyler Holton-DET, 12.7).

HIT LIMITER...in 13 of his 25 career starts he has allowed 3-or-less hits...Woo allowed 3-or-less hits with 4.0+ innings pitched in each of his first 3 starts to begin the year...he has had 3-or-less hits in 5 out of 7 games this season.

LIKE HE NEVER LEFT...has begun the year with only 24 baserunners allowed (20 hits, 4 BB) across his 7 starts (37.2 IP)...in his first 3 starts he is the only pitcher this season to allow 8 baserunners.

MAKING UP FOR MISSED TIME...among pitchers with at least 30 IP, he leads MLB in WHIP (0.61), on-base percentage against (.177), OPS against (.398), 3rd in opponent slugging percentage (.221) and ranks 5th in batting average against (.152).

EMPTY BASES...through 24 career starts, he has allowed the fewest baserunners in franchise history (134)...Woo is 1-of-9 pitchers in MLB history to allow 134-or-less baserunners through their first 24 starts.

WHAT A WOO-DERFUL TIME...the right-hander is the 4th pitcher in franchise history to allow no more than 1 run across his first 3 starts of a season...**Bryce Miller** in 2023 (1 ER, 19.0 IP), **Logan Gilbert** in 2022 (1 ER, 16.2 IP) and James Paxton in 2017 (0 ER, 21.0 IP) are the previous Mariners to do so.

TWENTY WOO...recorded 101 strikeouts through his first 20 career starts...became the 8th player in franchise history with at least 100 strikeouts in his first 20 career starts, joining Félix Hernández (124), Michael Pineda (123), **George Kirby** (109), **Logan Gilbert** (106), Mark Langston (105), Roenis Elías (104) and **Bryce Miller** (100).

FIRST THINGS FIRST...in his first time through the order this season, opposing hitters are hitting .094 (5x53) with 1 walks and 13 strikeouts.

MAKING A MARK...in his start against the New York Yankees on 5/21 he pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with 2 hits and 7 strikeouts...marked the first game in his career where he pitched 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed 2 or fewer hits...he became the first pitcher in the Majors this season to toss 6.0+ scoreless innings while allowing 2-or-fewer hits against the Yankees this season.

REHAB RECAP...began the 2024 season on the 15-day Injured List with right medial elbow inflammation...in 3 games with the Rainiers during his rehab assignment, had a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 11.1 IP), with 0 walks and 17 strikeouts...opponents hit just .128 (5x39) with 2 extra-base hits (2 doubles).

ABOUT LAST YEAR...started in 18 games and had a 4.21 ERA (41 ER, 87.2 IP) with 31 walks and 93 strikeouts...among rookie pitchers with at least 80.0 innings pitched in 2023, he ranked 6th in SO/9 (9.55), 7th in WHIP (1.21) and 7th in Opp. AVG (.225).

IN THE WIN COLUMN...Woo earned his 1st career win on 6/22/23 against New York-AL...he carried a no-hitter into the 6th inning before giving up a 1-out single to Gleyber Torres...he became the 5th Mariners pitcher last season to carry a no-hitter into the 6th inning (also: **Bryce Miller**, **Logan Gilbert**, **Luis Castillo** and Easton McGee).

FINDING THE RHYTHM...From 8/3/23-9/24/23 the right-hander made 6 starts and went 3-1 with a 2.27 ERA (8 ER, 31.2 IP), 11 walks, 1 home run allowed and 28 strikeouts...over that span, opponents were batting just .186 (21x113) against him and he gave up just 4 extra-base hits...in these 6 games Woo made 2 starts of 6.0 innings and recorded 3 scoreless outings...his 2.27 ERA over this span was the 2nd best in a 6-game span in his career (6/10/23-7/8/23, 2.20 ERA).
