JUNE 25
2022 - In the Bronx, 3 Astros hitters combine for a masterful, 3-0 no-hitter over the Yankees. **RHP Cristian Javier** is the main cog, punching out 13 batters with just 1 walk in 7.0 innings of work. **RHP Hector Neris** hurls and hitless 8th inning and **RHP Ryan Pressly** hurls a hitless 9th to preserve the no-hitter. **Jose Altuve** and **J.J. Matijevic** each hit solo HR to provide the offense.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros begin a 4-game series vs. the Tigers at Comerica Park tonight... **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (4-3) will start for the Astros vs. Tigers RHP Troy Melton (4-0)...tonight will be Imai's 1st career appearance vs. the Tigers.

ROAD TRIPPIN: Tonight is the 4th game (2-1 thus far) of a 7-game road trip for the Astros...they were 2-1 at TOR on the 1st stop of the trip...**Road Recovery:** The Astros are 12-7 in their last 3 road trips combined...they have have posted an 18-13 record on the road since going 1-9 on their 1st road trip of the 2026 season...**Road Bats:** The Astros are T-1st in the AL in road batting avg. at .251...they also rank 2nd in road HR (56), SLG (.417) and OPS (.740) and 3rd in OBP (.326).

ASTROS-TIGERS: The Astros took 2 of 3 games from the Tigers last week at Daikin Park (June 15-17)...the 2 clubs will play all 7 of their scheduled games between June 15-28...in 2025, the Astros and Tigers finished with identical 87-75 records, with the Tigers earning the final AL Wild Card spot due to winning the season series vs. HOU...**Recent Success:** Since 2022, the Astros are 18-10 vs. DET with a 7-4 record here at Comerica Park.

ABOUT IMAI: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** will make his 11th start of the season tonight and the 1st of his career vs. DET...in his last start on June 19, Imai tallied a career-high 11 K's en route to a 9-3 win vs. CLE (6 IP, 3 H, 3 ER)...**Solid Stretch:** Since May 25, Imai is 3-1 in his 5 starts with a 4.56 ERA (12 ER/23.2IP) with 27 K's in 23.2 IP...**The No-No:** Imai was the starting pitcher in the Astros combined no-hitter on May 25 at TEX, hurling 6.0 hitless innings on that historic night...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: In a pitcher's duel, the Astros defeated the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre last night, 3-1...with the win, HOU took 2 of 3 from TOR in the series...starting **RHP Mike Burrows** had ND, but was solid, allowing just 1 run on 2 hits in 6.0 innings of work...with the score tied 1-1 in the 8th inning, **Joey Loperfido** tripled and later scored on an error to give the Astros a 2-1 lead...**LHP Steven Okert** (1-0) earned the win in relief while **LHP Josh Hader** earned his 6th save in as many chances.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Astros have now won 4 cons. series for the 1st time in 2026, posting an 8-4 record in that span...the last time that the Astros won that many series in a row was when they won 5 straight, from June 20-July 6 of last season (went 12-3 in that stretch)...adding to that note from last season, the Astros did not lose a series between May 22-July 6, going 13 consecutive series without losing one (11-0-2 in series during that stretch).

THREE TIMES A CHARM! When **Yainer Diaz**, **Cam Smith** and **Taylor Trammell** went back-to-back-to-back in Tuesday's 9-7 win at TOR, it marked the 8th time in franchise history that the Astros have homered in 3 cons. PA's...last time: July 19, 2019 (**Jose Altuve**, **Alex Bregman**, **Yordan Alvarez**).

CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are now 16-10 in 2-run games, 8-4 in 1-run games and 4-4 in extra innings.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, over the last month or so (May 21-June 24), the Astros are 19-12 (.613), which is the 2nd-best record in the AL in that span.

RECENT STROS: The Astros have won 3 of 4, 6 of 8 and 8 of their last 12 games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid 1st half to his season, currently leading all of baseball with a 1.069 OPS...additionally, he leads the AL in SLG (.634), OBP (.435), TB (185), is T-1st in HR (25), 2nd in batting avg. (.322) and T-2nd in RBI (56)...Alvarez, who was the AL Player of the Month for May, is hitting .382 (29x76) in June with 5 HR and 17 RBI with a 1.121 OPS (.489 OBP/.632 SLG).

ALL-STAR VOTING: **Yordan Alvarez** leads all AL DH's in All-Star voting, per MLB's update on Monday...his 1,974,459 votes rank 2nd in the AL and 3rd overall in the Majors.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has been one of the best in the AL, posting a 2.75 clip (41ER/134IP) in that span...the Astros are 22-15 since May 15.

OKERT'S 0's: **LHP Steven Okert** has not allowed a run in his last 17.0 innings, which is the longest scoreless streak by an Astros hurler this season and the 3rd-longest by a reliever in the Majors this season...in his current streak, which spans 14 appearances, and began on May 23 at CHC, Okert has allowed just 8 hits in those 17.0 innings pitched.

HADERADE: In his 10 appearances since coming of the IL on June 3, opponents are just 2x32 off **LHP Josh Hader**...Hader has posted a 0.90 ERA (1ER/10IP) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities (.063 opp. avg., .040 WHIP).

THE LAMMA!: **RHP Peter Lambert's** 4 wins since May 24 are tied for tops in the AL in that span...in his 6 starts in the time frame, he is 4-0 with a 2.97 ERA (Astros are 5-1 in those starts)

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters have won an MLB-best 56 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (60%)...**Isaac Paredes** (9-for-9) has the most successful challenges in the Majors without losing one...**Jose Altuve** has been successful on 14-of-19 challenges (74%), ranking 2nd in the Majors in successful challenges.

ROSTER MOVE: Effective today, the Astros reinstated **RHP Bryan Abreu** from the Restricted List...**LHP Colton Gordon** was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land following last night's game.

LAST START, JUNE 19 vs. CLE: Picked up a win in his last start after working 6.0 innings of 3-run ball last Friday vs. the Guardians...struck out a career-high 11 hitters, a season high for any Astro, and did not surrender a walk...marked the first time an Astros pitcher struck out 11+ batters without surrendering a walk since **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** struck out 12 batters without a walk on Aug. 31, 2024 vs. KC

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 10 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...the Astros are 6-4 in his 10 starts...has flashed brilliance at times this season, including his 11-strikeout performance his last time out, and his 6.0 innings of no-hit ball on May 25 at TEX (0ER/6IP)

HARD TO HIT: Has proven to be tough to hit at the Major League level, as he's held opponents to a .230 (35x152) average with 48 strikeouts in 41.0 innings...is averaging 10.54 strikeouts per 9.0, which leads the Astros and ranks 7th in the AL (min. 40IP)...has held right-handed hitters to a .194 average (12x62) and a .612 OPS.

IMAI'S ARSENAL: Has thrown 44.5% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (41.8%) and sinkers (7.9%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 6 starts, throwing the pitch 231 times compared to just 11 sinkers...has also worked in select changeups (3.4%), split fingers (1.7%), and curveballs (0.8%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 4.3 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

KEEP IT 100: Tossed a career-high 110 pitches on May 31 vs. MIL, which ties as the 3rd most pitches thrown by any MLB starter in a game this season...are the most pitches thrown by an Astro since **LHP Framber Valdez** threw 114 pitches on Aug. 25, 2023 at DET.

A NO-HITTER! On May 25 at TEX, Imai tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, the 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing...marked the Astros first combined no-hitter since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

NO HITTER HISTORY: Imai became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts...the Astros no-hitter ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.

2025 RECAP: Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

JAPANESE CAREER: Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

JAPAN CONNECTION: Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

ACTIVATED: Was activated from the Restricted List today...missed the entire 3-game series against the Blue Jays.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.81 ERA (5ER/16IP) in his last 18 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (active 14-game streak).
