WEDNESDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Angels, 6-5, in the rubber match of the three-game set in Anaheim...Climbed their third consecutive season series victory over the Halos (4-2)...**Dean Kremer** earned his first win of the year after allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) with one walk and a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts in 5.1 innings...**Gunnar Henderson** slugged his eighth home run of the year, the second-most in the AL and third-most in MLB...**Craig Kimbrel** picked up his seventh save of the campaign.

KIMBREL COUNT: **Craig Kimbrel** recorded the 424th save of his career Wednesday afternoon in Anaheim, tying John Franco for sixth in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,209 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225).

HOMER HAPPY: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with 37 home runs, the second-most homers through the first 24 games in O's history, behind 39 by the 2005 team; the most homers through Baltimore's first 25 games of a season is also 39 by the 2005 team.

♫ The Orioles have an MLB-best four players with at least five home runs: **Gunnar Henderson** (8), **Colton Cowser** (6), and **Cedric Mullins** and **Jordan Westburg** (5).

♫ Henderson has homered in two straight games for the first time since going yard in three straight from April 15-17 this year.

THEY'VE GOT POP: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and are tied with the Braves for first in MLB with a 90.4 mph average exit velocity, per Statcast (see box at right)...The O's also lead MLB with 65 barrels and rank fourth with 291 hard-hit balls...**Gunnar Henderson** ranks second among all hitters with a 96.0 mph average exit velo (see box at right).

RUN IT UP: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank fifth in MLB with 136 runs scored...Their +29 run differential is third in the AL and sixth in MLB, while their 5.67 runs per game leads the AL and ranks third in MLB.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT: The Orioles are slashing .195/.249/.353 (84-for-431) in two-strike counts...Entering today's games, they lead MLB in slugging, OPS (.602), and extra-base hits (37) with two strikes, and are second in home runs (14)...**Jordan Westburg** has hit .341/.400/.683 (14-for-41) in two-strike counts, with three doubles, one triple, and three home runs...He leads MLB in two-strike average, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.083), and ranks tied for second in two-strike extra-base hits (7), trailing teammate **Gunnar Henderson** (8).

WESTY AND HIS BESTY: **Colton Cowser** and **Jordan Westburg** have been named AL Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks, with Cowser winning for the period of April 8-14 and Westburg for the period of April 15-21...The O's are the first team to win consecutive Player of the Week honors since the Braves for the weeks of August 14 and 21, 2023 (Olson/Rosario), and the first AL team since the Astros for the weeks of August 7 and 14, 2023 (Valdez/Altuve)...The last time the Orioles earned back-to-back Player of the Week honors was 1981, when Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** won two straight for the weeks of September 13 and 20...Overall, it is the third time Baltimore earned back-to-back weekly honors after **Don Baylor** won on August 10, 1975, followed by Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Jim Palmer** and **Ken Singleton** winning co-honors on August 17.

ELECTRIC AVENUE: **Cedric Mullins** earned his MLB-leading seventh career Electric Play of the Week award for his **diving catch** on April 15 vs. Minnesota...Mullins went full extension in center field to rob Kyle Farmer for the last out of the top of the first inning...The Orioles have an MLB-best 13 Play of the Week awards since 2019.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: Tonight, the Orioles begin a seven-game homestand against the A's (3 G) and Yankees (4 G)...The O's are 8-4 at home to start the year...Last year, the Orioles went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617) at Camden Yards...Marked the third-best home record in the AL in 2023 behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

WAR OF THE VOWELS: The O's and A's are meeting for the first of two regular-season series with this weekend's three-game set in Baltimore...The Orioles will travel to Oakland for a three-game set from July 5-7...The Birds went 6-1 against the Athletics last year, taking three out of four in Baltimore from April 10-13 before completing a three-game sweep in Oakland from August 18-20.

O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: The Birds went 4-2 on their six-game road trip against the Royals (2-1) and Angels (2-1) from April 19-24...The O's are off to an 8-4 road start this year...Last year, the Orioles went 52-29 (.642) away from Camden Yards, tied with the Braves for the best road record in MLB and tied with the 1997 O's squad for the best road record in club history (since 1954); marked the third time an O's team reached 50 road wins, joining 1997 (52) and 1980 (50).

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 99 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

♫ The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today selected the contract of outfielder **Ryan McKenna** from Triple-A Norfolk and optioned second baseman/shortstop **Jackson Holliday** to the Tides...To make room for McKenna on the 40-man roster, catcher **David Bañuelos** has been designated for assignment.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20th manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 331 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

♫ Tomorrow, the first 20,000 fans ages 15 and over will receive a **Brandon Hyde 2023 AL Manager of the Year Bobblehead**.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his sixth start of the season tonight against the Athletics...Oakland is one of three teams that he has never faced in his career (also Tampa Bay and Texas)...The O's are 5-0 in Burnes' starts this season...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on April 20 at Kansas City...Allowed three runs on four hits(1 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts...Did not allow a run in the first inning for the first time in his five starts to begin the season... Faced two batters over the minimum through the first 5.0 innings...Threw 98 pitches, 62 strikes.

AGAINST OAKLAND AND THE AL WEST: Making his first career appearance against the Athletics...Owns a lifetime 3-1 record and a 3.47 ERA (9 ER/23.1 IP) across five appearances(4 GS) against the division.

HOME SWEET HOME: Through three starts at Oriole Park this season, Burnes owns a 1-0 record with a 2.70 ERA (5 ER/16.2 IP)...Opponents are slashing .246/.269/.385(16-for-65) off him in Baltimore.

NIGHT OWL: Scheduled to make his second night start of the season...In 2023, he went 8-7 with a 3.23 ERA (48 ER/133.2 IP) in 22 evening starts.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 101 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 592.0 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank fourth in MLB(Sandy Alcántara – 619.0, Aaron Nola – 610.2, Gerrit Cole – 591.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.

Scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and his third career start against his former team...Secured the win in his last time out on Sunday at Kansas City after allowing four hits and two walks with two strikeouts in a scoreless 6.2 innings; marked his longest outing as an Oriole and his first win since June 10, 2023 vs. Kansas City...Allowed seven runs in 9.0 IP across two career starts against Oakland...Appeared in 24 games (12 GS) across four separate stints with the O's in 2023, posting a 4.42 ERA (38 ER/77.1 IP), allowing 78 hits (11 HR) with 21 walks and 68 strikeouts...Did not appear on Baltimore's Postseason roster.
