THE CHIPPER JONES TRAIL: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip through New York (0-3) and Atlanta (Apr. 21-23) into the Easter holiday weekend, arguably two cities Braves' Hall of Famer **Chipper Jones** loved to play. The Cardinals play the final game of a four-game series with the National League East Division leaders, the New York Mets. The Cardinals were shutout for the second time this season, coming at the hands of the Mets 2-0 yesterday afternoon. St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the N.L. Central, 4.0 games back of first place Chicago. The Mets will visit Busch Stadium in two weeks (May 2-4) for three games to conclude the season series.

RESURRECTING THE SQUAD ON EASTER SUNDAY: In 59 all-time games which have landed on the Easter Sunday holiday, the Cardinals are 31-28 and 17-15 on the road. Fortunately, the Cardinals are 3-0 all-time against the Mets on Easter, winning in 2019 (6-4), 2018 (5-1) and 1987 (4-2). The lone win at Citi Field was in 2018 as Cardinals Public Enemies 1 & 1A to the Mets, **Paul DeJong** (2 HR) and **Yadier Molina** (HR), each went yard in the game.

BROOM-BUSTERS: New York has won the last seven straight games between the two clubs dating back to April 28, 2024. The last time the Mets swept the Cardinals was April 1-4, 2007 at Busch Stadium III. The Cardinals last lost eight straight to the Mets, Apr. 14, 2006-Aug. 14, 1986, their longest losing streak ever to the Metropolitanans, which included a four-game and three-game sweep at Busch Memorial Stadium. The Cardinals have never been swept in a four-game series in New York. The Mets have swept three four-game series in St. Louis in the history of their all-time series. -Elias Sports Bureau

PICK FOUR: The last time the Cardinals were swept in a four-game series was June 3-6, 2021 vs. Cincinnati at Busch Stadium. The last time on the road was also to the Reds, June 5-8, 2017 at Great American Ballpark.

IT'S ALWAYS SONNY: Starting pitcher **Sonny Gray** can stop the Mets streak and sweep attempt with a win today. The Cardinals ace is a career 4-0 against the Mets in four starts with two of those at Citi Field. Gray last faced the Mets on April 27, 2024, and struck out nine batters en route to a 7-4 Cardinals win. In his last eight starts dating back to Aug. 29, 2024, Gray is 5-0 and the Cardinals are 8-0 in his starts.

LAYING EGGS: The Cardinals were shutout for the second time this season yesterday (also: 4/15 vs. HOU). This marked the first time St. Louis was shutout at Citi Field since May 21, 2015 when **Jacob deGrom** (8.0) and **Jeurys Familia** (1.0) spun a two-hit shutout. The Cardinals had scored at least once in each of their previous 29 games in Queens dating back to July 26, 2016. The 29 games was the longest active such streak by a visiting team and the eighth-longest such streak by a visiting ball club since the ballpark opened in 2009. -Thanks to Mets' Josh Lederman, Kenny Burgess and Samantha Levin for their info

SHOW-ME...SOMETHING: This week, the state of Missouri sent its two teams to the Big Apple, but have yet to record a win as the Kansas City Royals were swept in a three-game series by the New York Yankees Monday through Wednesday, while the Cardinals have started this series 0-3 to the New York Mets.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: St. Louis has struggled out of the gate on the road this season. The barnstorming birdies are 1-8 and have lost four straight games. Both of their road trips have begun the same with a four-run loss in their first game followed by a walk-off loss, then a third loss. It's the 9th time in franchise history the Cardinals have started 1-8 on the road and first since 1997. St. Louis has been out-scored 61-35 through their first nine road games. Their -26 run differential on the road is the sixth-worst run differential through the team's first nine road games of the season with the last time the Cardinals had a worse run differential through their first nine road games of the season was in 1919 (-31).

WINN BREAKS IT IN: Injured shortstop **Masyn Winn** played in his second injury rehabilitation assignment game with Memphis (AAA) yesterday afternoon and was 2-for-5 with two home runs while playing as the designated hitter. Winn was placed on the 10-day Injured List with lower back spasms on April 12. St. Louis is 3-4 in his absence and he would be eligible to return to the active roster on Tuesday in Atlanta. Cardinals who have played shortstop (**Brendan Donovan** & **Thomas Saggese**) have batted .433 (13-30) with six doubles and three RBI in his absence.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Ryne Stanek was born in St. Louis

Phil Maton was traded to the Mets last season (July 9, 2024) and pitched in 31 games.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

FanDuel broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jerome Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

TODAY'S GAME:

- Leads the team's starting rotation's 5th turn thru as he is set to make his 5th start of the season today; It's his 2nd start on the road.
- The Cardinals are 4-0 in his four starts to begin the 2025 season; and Sonny has won 4-straight decisions dating to last season, with last loss coming on 8/24/24 at MIN.
- The Cardinals have won each of his last eight games started dating back to last season.**
- Is trying to begin a season 4-0 for the 1st time since 2023 when he did so with Minnesota.
- Four of his 15 hits allowed have been HR's; ***Leads the NL in WHIP (0.78)*** and 3rd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.67).
- Was matched up against MLB All-Stars Pablo Lopez (MIN), Yusei Kikuchi (LAA), Paul Skenes (PIT) & Framber Valdez (HOU) in each of his first four starts.**
- Is 20-12 with a 2.99 ERA in 44 career starts in April and had a 3-1 mark with a 1.16 ERA last April in four starts for St. Louis; **stands at 5-1, 1.96 ERA (41.1 IP/9 ER) in his 7 April starts as a member of the Cardinals (2024-present).**
- St. Louis is 21-11 in his 32 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 16-9 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 100th career start as a National Leaguer last Mon. (4/14) vs. HOU (and of course it was in an Interleague game) and worked a season-high 7.0 scoreless IP (92 pitches), allowing just 3 hits, in an 8-3 win to improve to 3-0.

2025/CAREER NOTES:

- Improved to 2-0 with a 5-3 win over the Pirates on 4/8 at PIT in a match-up vs. Paul Skenes; Game time temperature was 38 degrees and snow flurries. Passed 1,750 career innings pitched in that start, becoming the 10th active Major Leaguer to hit that mark (*Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer, Clayton Kershaw, Charlie Morton, Jose Quintana, Chris Sale, Gerrit Cole, Patrick Corbin* and *Kyle Gibson*).
- Made his 300th career start on 4/2 vs. LAA. Threw 6.0 innings for a no decision, exiting after a grand slam by Logan O'Hoppe, before the Cardinals retaliated with nine unanswered runs for a 12-5 win.
- Drew the Cardinals Opening Day start on 3/27 vs. MIN, the 4th Opening Day start of his career and his 1st for St. Louis; improved to 3-0 with a 1.07 ERA (25.1 IP/3 ER) in his four career Opening Day starts.
- Struck out 203 batters in his first season in St. Louis in 2024, 19th-most in Cardinals single-season history. Became the 9th pitcher in Cardinals single-season history (20th instance) to reach 200 strikeouts and first since **Jack Flaherty** (231 in 2019).
- His 203 strikeouts were 2nd-most by a pitcher in their first season with St. Louis behind only **José DeLeón's** 208 strikeouts in 1988.
- Established new single-season Cardinals records in strikeouts/9 IP (10.98) and strikeout percentage (30.3%) in 2024, surpassing **Jack Flaherty** (10.59, 29.9%) in 2019.
- Finished two strikeouts shy of tying his single-season career high of 205 with the Reds in 2019. Recorded a 57.1 strikeout pct. on his Sweeper (fanning 112 in 196 plate appearances), MLB's best strikeout pct. of any pitch (minimum 150 plate appearances).
- Yielded a career high 21 home runs in 2024, but only five at Busch Stadium.
- His team-leading 13 wins in 2024 were his most since a career-high 14 victories in back-to-back seasons with Oakland (2014-15)
- Signed a three-year (2024-26) free agent contract with St. Louis following the 2023 Thanksgiving holiday, with a fourth year club option for the 2027 season.
- The Cardinals are his fifth Major League team, after the Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), and Twins (2022-23).
- Finished 2nd in the 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting behind Yankees **Gerrit Cole**, who received 30 unanimous 1st place votes. Gray received 20 2nd place votes and six 3rd place. Also ranked 18th in AL MVP voting.
- Three-time Major League Baseball All-Star, earning selections in 2015 (American), 2019 (National) and 2023 (American).
- Graduated from Smyrna (Tenn.) High School. A two-sport athlete, lettered all four years in baseball and three years in football. Played quarterback and led Smyrna to back-to-back Tennessee High School state championships. Was also Homecoming King.
- Originally selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft out of Smyrna High School, but did not sign. Drafted by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.

GRAY vs. NEW YORK (N.L.)

- Is making his 5th career start vs. the Mets; twice with the Yankees (2017-18) and once with the Reds (2021) and Cardinals (2024).
- Has won all four starts against the Mets in his career, one of two teams that he has earned the win in every start against (is 3-0 vs. SD Padres in three career games started).**
- Has a 4-0 career mark with a 2.31 ERA over his previous four starts vs. the Mets.
- Oddly, despite being a perfect 4-0 vs. the Mets, Sonny has 2-1 career mark while pitching at Citi Field; while pitching for NY Yankees, suffered a 2-1 CG loss to the Tampa Bay Rays on Sept. 12, 2017 at Citi Field as the Rays home series was moved to Citi Field due to Hurricane Irma.**
- He's 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA (20.0 IP/4 ER) in three career starts at Citi Field.
- Is a career 12-6 with a 3.64 ERA in his 33 career starts against National League East opponents.
