**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners welcome the Padres to T-Mobile Park tonight for the first of a 3-game series...Seattle is coming off a winning road trip (4-3) against the Chicago White Sox (1-2) and Houston Astros (3-1)...Seattle will see the White Sox (3 G, 5/18-5/20) again on the homestand...tonight's tilt will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** and **KING 5 (NBC)** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call, along with **Angie Mentink** as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners beat the Astros in yesterday's road trip finale by an 8-3 score at Daikin Park...Seattle is 7-1 against the Astros this year, already clinching the season series...overall, the Mariners are 12-8 over their last 20 games since April 22.

- **Salute To Armed Forces** - The Mariners are set to wear their home white uniforms tonight and tomorrow with the "Salute To Armed Forces" caps.
- **Young and Spry** - Second baseman **Cole Young's** 10 defensive runs saved lead MLB infielders, tied for 3rd-most in the big leagues among all positions.
- **Brash Decisions** - Right-handed reliever **Matt Brash** (right lat inflammation) struck out all 3 batters he faced in his rehab outing last night with Triple-A Tacoma...Brash recorded the win for the Rainiers.
- **Number 18** - **Mitch Garver** launched his first home run of the season yesterday...over his last 14 games (4/21-c), Garver has a .405 on-base percentage.

**UPCOMING TV SCHEDULE AND GAME TIMES**...the Mariners will be featured on nationally televised games on both Saturday and Sunday...Saturday's game will be televised exclusively on **FOX** and begins at **4:15 p.m. PT**...on Sunday, the game will be televised exclusively on **Peacock** and be broadcast live on both **ESPN Radio** and **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with the matchup beginning at **4:20 p.m. PT**...the Mariners have already been televised on 7 exclusive or co-existing national broadcasts so far this season.

**YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES**...on Thursday, May 14, catcher **Jhonny Pereda** was recalled from Triple-A Tacoma, left-handed pitcher **José A. Ferrer** was reinstated from the Paternity List, catcher **Cal Raleigh** was placed on 10-day Injured List (right oblique strain), and left-handed pitcher **Josh Simpson** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...additionally, the Mariners traded left-handed pitcher José Suarez to the Athletics in exchange for cash considerations...for Raleigh, it marks the first Injured List stint in his Major League career (2021-c)...he battled soreness in his right side earlier in the season, which forced him to miss 3 consecutive games in early May.

**VEDDER CUP RETURNS TO SEATTLE**...in the event the Mariners sweep the Padres and outscore them by 7+ runs this series, the **Vedder Cup** would stay in Seattle and go to the Mariners, who won the Vedder Cup in its inaugural season in 2025...as part of the annual series, the Mariners and Padres are supporting the Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) Research Partnership, a charity co-founded by Eddie and Jill Vedder dedicated to funding research to discover treatments and cures for EB...learn more at [ebresearch.org](http://ebresearch.org).

**COOL HAND LUKE**...**Luke Raley** launched his team-leading 10th home run of the season in yesterday's win...in 39 games this season, the outfielder is batting .268 (30x112) with 19 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 10 homers, 27 RBI and 8 walks, getting on base at a .333 clip, slugging .589 with a .923 OPS and 163 OPS+...over his last 8 games (5/4-c), Raley is hitting .348 (8x23) with 8 runs, 5 homers and 14 RBI...Raley's 7 RBI on May 8 at the White Sox marks the most RBI by a player in a game this season.

**SOLID ON THE MOUND**...the Mariners pitching staff has been among the best in the Majors this season, combining for a 3.62 ERA (161 ER, 400.1 IP), 113 walks and 384 strikeouts...among MLB pitching staffs they rank 1st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.40), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.54), T-3rd in quality starts (20), 6th in ERA and 7th in WHIP (1.23)...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 257.0 innings.

**THIS IS RANDY'S WORLD**...over his last 8 games (5/6-c), **Randy Arozarena** is batting .452 (14x31) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 2 walks, 3 stolen bases and 3 hit-by-pitches, getting on base at a .528 clip, slugging .613 with a 1.141 OPS in 36 plate appearances...he snapped his 7-game hitting streak yesterday, but still managed to reach base twice via walk...overall this season, the Mariners left fielder's .301 batting average ranks 9th among qualified American Leaguers.

**NAYLOR LOCKED IN**...over his last 23 games since April 17, **Josh Naylor** is batting .356 (32x90) with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 9 walks, 8 stolen bases, a .410 OBP while slugging .511 for a .921 OPS...during that span, he ranks T-6th in the Majors in average and T-3rd in SB...Naylor is 27-for-29 (93.1%) in stolen base attempts since joining Seattle, ranking 2nd in stolen base percentage trailing only James Jones (93.3%) and ranking just ahead of teammate **Victor Robles** (92.5%) among players with at least 25 attempts in franchise history.

**HOT (J)-ROD**...over his last 22 contests (4/20-c), **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .309 (29x94) with 13 runs, 6 doubles, 6 home runs, 13 RBI, 4 walks and 2 steals, getting on base at a .337 clip, slugging .564 with a .901 OPS...Julio's 6 homers since that date are tied for 9th-most in the Majors.

**BIG TEX IS BACK**...**Bryce Miller** made his season debut on Wednesday night in Houston, tossing 5.1 innings and allowing 2 runs (2 ER) on 8 hits (1 HR) and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts...he was activated off the Injured List prior to the game after missing the start of the season with a left oblique strain...he made 4 rehab starts between High-A Everett and Triple-A Tacoma before being reinstated, where he posted a 1.98 ERA (3 ER, 13.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...right-hander **Emerson Hancock** toes the rubber for the Mariners tonight, starting against the Padres, the team he made his big league debut against on Aug. 9, 2023 at T-Mobile Park, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Hancock goes into tonight's start as 1 of 4 pitchers across the Majors with 50+ strikeouts and fewer than 10 walks?...Hancock (50 SO, 9 BB) is joined by Paul Skenes-PIT (56 SO, 7 BB), Jacob deGrom-TEX (57 SO, 8 BB), and Cam Schlichter-NYY (59 SO, 9 BB).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 15

- **1977** - "Boeing Weekend" with the Mariners sets a Major League group sales record as 65,432 Boeing Employees and their families watched two games against the Boston Red Sox.
- **2023** - **Cal Raleigh's** multi-homer game against the Boston Red Sox marks the first time in his career that he homered from both sides of the plate in the same game...it also marked the first time in the history of Fenway Park that a catcher homered from the left and right side of the plate in a game.

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 9th start of the season and the 40th start of his career...this will be his 46th career appearance including the 6 relief appearances he made throughout the 2025 regular season...it will mark his 2nd start against the Padres this season, 4th career appearance and 4th career start against San Diego.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Scott Hunter on June 25, 2020.
- Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20...in 2020, was named Vince Dooley Athlete of the Year as the top male student-athlete at the University of Georgia.
- Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT**...W#3 on May 8 at Chicago-AL...recorded his sixth 6.0+ inning start of the season, allowing 5 runs (5 ER) on 5 hits (1 HR), and 3 walks while striking out 4 batters...threw 94 pitches and 55 strikes...gave the team 6.0+ innings in his 3rd consecutive start, matching his career-best streak of such games (3x, last: 4/23-5/6/25).

**FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS**...will make the 5th Friday night start of his career...the Mariners are 5-0 when Hancock starts on a Friday night...he has pitched 5+ innings in all 5 starts, allowing 3-or-fewer runs and 2-or-fewer walks in 4-of-5 outings...has had 2 Friday night outings this season, earning a win in each (last: 5/8 at CWS).

**LET'S PLAY TWO**...will face the Padres for the second time this season...in his last outing in San Diego, Hancock recorded his 3rd quality start of the season, allowing only 2 runs (2 ER) on 4 hits and 1 walk while striking out 6 batters...over 3 starts against the Padres, owns a 2.30 ERA (4 ER, 15.2 IP) with a 6.9 K/9 and a .203 opponent batting average...has not faced the Padres in T-Mobile park since he did so in his MLB debut on August 9, 2023, allowing 1 run on 2 hits and 3 walks while striking out 3 batters through 5.0 frames.

**HOME TURE**...across his last 7 appearances at home (9/10/25-5/2/26) he is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER, 30.2 IP), 3 walks and 40 strikeouts for a 13.33 K/BB and a 0.761 WHIP...in 4 home starts in 2026, he is 2-0 with 3-or-fewer runs allowed over 5.0+ IP in all 4 appearances...has had 2 starts with 1-or-fewer runs and 9+ strikeouts over 6.0+ IP...ranks 5th in WHIP (.87), 3rd in SO/BB (10.33) and 10th in opponent OBP (.247) in home games in the AL this season (min. 20 IP).

**CAREER STRETCH**...over his last 8 starts he has struck out 50 batters and thrown 47.2 IP, both career best marks over an 8-game span in a single season...is 1-of-3 pitchers this season to have 50+ strikeouts and 9-or-fewer walks through their first 8 starts along with Cam Schittler-NYY and Jacob DeGrom-TEX...through his first 8 starts owns a 5.56 K/BB and a 27.0 K%, both marks outpacing his 2.06 K/BB and 16.6 K% recorded in 2025, both career-highs...his 5 quality starts this season already tie his career high in such games set in 2025.

**SWING BATTER BATTER SWING**...recorded a career high 21 swings and misses in his May 2 start, the most by a Mariners pitcher this season...has 51 whiffs on his 4-seamer, ranking T-3rd in the AL, matching Cole Ragans-KC and Bryan Woo-SEA, just trailing Luis Castillo-SEA (52).

**TRAFFIC CONTROL**...his 50 base runners allowed over 47.2 innings in his first 8 starts, are the 7th fewest among pitchers in 2026 through their first 8 games (min. 47.0 IP)...owns a baserunners-per-9 of 9.44, ranking T-6th in AL in 2026, trailing Bryan Woo-SEA with 9.34 (min. 45.0 IP)...ranks 9th in WHIP (0.87) with runners on base in the AL in 2026 and T-10th in opponent OBP (min. 15.0 IP).

**QUALITY CONTROL**...has recorded a quality start in 5 of his 8 starts this season...is 1-of-5 pitchers in 2026 to have 4 quality starts with 1-or-fewer walks and 5+ strikeouts through 8 games (also: Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD and Drew Rasmussen-TB)...the Mariners are 9-5 when Hancock logs a quality start since 2023 and are 7-3 since the start of 2025.

**NO FREE PASSES**...is 1-of-7 pitchers this season to have allowed 3-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP in each of their starts...his 4.9 BB% is tied with Logan Gilbert-SEA for 7th best in the AL (min. 40.0 IP)...has contributed 5 starts with 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks to a Mariners pitching staff that leads the league in such games (24) in 2026.

**UP TO BIG UNIT STANDARDS**...in his last home start on May 2, followed up Mariners legend Randy Johnson's number retirement ceremony with a performance of his own, becoming the 4th player with 14+ strikeouts and no walks allowed in Mariners franchise history, joining Randy Johnson (done 2x), George Kirby (done 2x) and Mark Langston...is 1-of-5 pitchers in MLB to have 14+ strikeouts and no walks since the start of 2023, along with George Kirby (2x, last: 9/14/25), Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25), Tyler Glasnow-LAD (4/9/24), and Pablo López-MIN (9/10/23)...is the most recent pitcher to record 13+ strikeouts in a game, joining George Kirby (14, 9/14/25 vs. LAA), Bryan Woo (13, 9/13/25 vs. LAA) and Logan Gilbert (13, 8/24/25 vs. ATH) as 4 of the last 5 pitchers in MLB to record 13+ strikeouts in an outing...Max Fried-NYY (13, 9/18/25 at BAL) is the last non-Mariner with 13+ SO in a game.
