**TODAY'S GAME:** Winners of three of their last four games, the Giants play the second game of this four-game series and this 10-game road trip tonight here at Chavez Ravine.

- ▶ Coupled with the win Sunday afternoon at home, the Giants have now won consecutive games for the first time since April 25-26 vs. Miami...they'll look to win three straight for the first time since April 16-18 at Cincinnati and Washington.
- ▶ Last night's win snapped a seven-game road losing streak for SF that ran from the last game of their series in DC on April 19 through May 3.
- ▶ The Giants will be trying to win on consecutive days here at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium for the first time since sweeping a three-game series here June 16-18, 2023.
- ▶ SF's 17-24 (.415) record entering play today is the third-worst in the National League, ahead of the Rockies (16-25, .390) and Mets (15-25, .375).

**TODAY'S STARTER:** RHP Adrian Houser starts tonight for his eighth start of the year and is coming off his most consistent start of the season last time out.

- ▶ Against the Padres again at home last Wednesday, Houser allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits while striking out three in the Giants' 5-1 loss...in two starts against San Diego this year, he's 0-2, but owns a 1.59 ERA (2er, 11.1ip) in those games...in his other five starts against everyone else, he's 0-2 with an 8.28 ERA (23er, 25.0ip) with six homers allowed...overall, SF is 1-6 as a team in Houser's first seven starts this year.
- ▶ Tonight's start is his fourth career start against the Dodgers with all of them coming here in LA...in the three prior starts, he's 0-3 with a 12.34 ERA (16er, 11.2ip) with 17 hits allowed, eight walks and 13 strikeouts...he last faced LA as a member of the Mets back in 2024.

**CALL RAFI!: IF/DH Rafael Devers** is 13-for-36 (.361) with four doubles, three homers, eight RBI, eight runs scored and six walks in his last 11 games dating to the second game of a twinbill in Philadelphia on April 30...prior to this run, Devers had two homers and 10 RBI in his first 30 games of the year.

- ▶ This month, Devers is 12-for-33 (.364) with seven XBH, seven RBI, eight runs scored, five walks and a 1.193 OPS in 10 games...for his career, Devers has a .945 OPS in the month of May, his second-best in any full month behind only August (.965).
- ▶ Devers' .945 May OPS is third-best among active players (min. 300 PA) behind Aaron Judge (1.147) and Mike Trout (.972)...the 29-year-old Devers has a .579 SLG in May, second among active players to only Judge (.716) (Stats, LLC).

**MAY FLOWERS: IF Willy Adames** might be turning a corner at the dish, going 7-for-19 (.368) with a double and five RBI in his last four games.

- ▶ He drove in a season-best three runs in yesterday's win and has five RBI in his last two contests...Adames totalled six RBI through his first 38 games.

**THAT'S A RELIEF?:** Six of the Giants' nine runs in last night's win came off Dodger relievers...that piggybacked SF scoring five runs in Sunday's walk-off win off the Pirates bullpen.

- ▶ For the season, the Giants have plated only 65 runs off opposing relievers, second-lowest in the NL ahead of only the Mets (56) and third-lowest in the Majors overall.
- ▶ Prior to this 11-run outburst off the bullpens, the Giants had scored the fewest runs off opposing relievers in baseball entering play on Saturday (54).

**TRENDING UP?:** The Giants walked a season-high six times last night...since going three straight games without a walk last Tuesday-Friday, the Giants have drawn 14 walks in their last three games...the 14 walks over a three-game span are the most by the Giants in any three-game stretch this year.

**LEAVING THE YARD:** The Giants have homered in seven straight games, their longest streak of the season and the second-longest active streak in MLB (Phillies, eight)...the Giants are 14-6 (.700) when they homer this season.

- ▶ The Giants' 27 home runs overall this season are 29th of 30 MLB teams just ahead of Milwaukee (26)...they've hit just 12 of their 27 homers on the road with last night's homer by **IF/DH Rafael Devers** breaking a seven-game homerless drought on the road.

# ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

**2026 RECORD: 0-4, 6.19 ERA**

**Height/Weight:** 6-4/227 **Bats/Throws:** R/R  
**Hometown:** Locust Grove, OK **Signed Through:** 2027  
**Age:** 33 (February 2, 1993)

**YO ADRIAN:** Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Had his best start as a Giant despite receiving the loss...allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits (one homer) and a walk while striking out three in 6.0 innings vs. the Padres on May 6 at Oracle Park...Houser held right-handed batters to a 1-for-14 (.071) mark in the start.

**AGAINST THE DODGERS:** Tonight will be Houser's fourth career start vs. the Dodgers...he is 0-3 with a 12.34 ERA (16er, 11.2ip), 13 strikeouts and a 2.14 WHIP in the three outings, last facing them in April of 2024 when he was a member of the Mets.

**SINK OR SWIM:** A big difference from last year's solid season to this year's rough start is Houser's sinker...the pitch had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...so far in 2026, the pitch has a run value of -5...in his last start, however, the sinker was on point, with Houser throwing the pitch a season-high 48 times while limiting Padres hitters to a 2-for-12 showing vs. the pitch.

**LEFT ON READ:** Lefties have been a thorn in Houser's side this season...they are slashing .386/.447/.747 with 13 doubles, a triple, five homers and a 1.194 OPS in 83 at-bats compared to righties slashing .191/.214/.294 with a double, two homers and a .508 OPS in 68 at-bats...among pitchers with 35.0+ innings pitched this season, Houser's 1.194 OPS vs. left-handed batters is second-highest, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (1.259).

**CONTACT:** Houser has an 11.4% strikeout rate this season, which is the third-lowest strikeout rate in the Majors (min. 35.0ip), ahead of only Minnesota's Simeon Woods Richardson (10.6%) and Washington's Zack Littel (10.1%).

**BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL:** Houser has allowed at least one earned run in four of his seven 1st innings thus far in 2026...opponents are batting .300 (9x30) with three doubles, five home runs and a 1.264 OPS in the 1st inning vs. Houser...the Dodgers have a 1st-inning OPS of .693, which ranks 24th in MLB while their 20 1st inning runs rank 18th.

**2026 RECORD: 3-4, 2.76 ERA**

- ▶ Earned the win in his last start on May 8 against the Pirates...threw 6.0 innings and allowed on earned run on four hits and four walks with seven strikeouts in the Giants 5-2 victory over Pittsburgh.
- ▶ Will make his 26th career start against the Dodgers, the most against any team in his career...has posted a 9-8 record with a 3.74 ERA, 189 strikeouts and a .205 opponents average over his 25 career starts...has thrown very well at Dodgers Stadium over his career, going 4-3 with a 2.67 ERA with a .160 opponents average.

### #43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 5/9 vs. RNO; 2.1ip, 2k (23 pitches) (w/AAA)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday...made 13 appearances with the River Cats out of the 'pen and had a 5.40 ERA (10er, 16.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks.
- ▶ In his last two games with the River Cats last week, Beck combined to throw 4.0 scoreless with one hit, no walks and four strikeouts.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; W, 2.0ip, 2bb, 1bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings with a strikeout to get his first win as a Giant on Sunday vs. Pittsburgh.
- ▶ Has a 5.06 ERA (3er, 5.1ip) and .316 BAA over his last five games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-29 (.172) with four walks and eight strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (72-for-398) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-26 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/11 at LAD; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ In his last five outings, he has a 6.14 ERA (5er, 7.1ip) and .333 BAA (10x30)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 9.1 scoreless innings in seven appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 14 contests (5.30 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-42 (.310) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 5/11 at LAD; W, 1.2ip, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two ER) in 17.2ip this year (1.02 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 11g (9.1ip, 4h, 1r, 6bb, 4k).
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-21 (.095) against him this season, and 19-for-104 in his career (.183).
- ▶ His 26.5% hard hit rate ranks in the top 5% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 0.1ip, bb (9 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first appearance with SF Sunday, throwing 0.1 innings...the outing marked his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, 2bb (19 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first career save on May 4 vs. SD.
- ▶ Has allowed a run in three of his last four outings after allowing just one run in his first 14 games.
- ▶ Owns a 24.0% strikeout rate and .148 BAA (9x61) this season.
- ▶ Has a 6.00 BB/9ip...his 16% walk rate ranks in the bottom 4% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-37 (.135) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/10 vs. PIT; 1.1ip, h, 2r, er, bb, hb (30 pitches)

- ▶ Activated last Tuesday after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 3.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in three games so far.
- ▶ Had a 4.82 ERA (5er, 9.1ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the 10 rehab outings.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP
