RAYS REPORT—The Rays open a six-game homestand against the Rangers (three to play) and Marlins (three to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...the sets will wrap up the season series with both clubs...are coming off a brief four-game road trip against the Astros (2-2)... are 9-3 in their last 12 games, 11-6 in their last 17, 14-8 in their last 22, 16-11 in their last 27 and 21-15 in their last 36... are 9-4 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19-June 8).. following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60,8%) will be on the road...are third in the AL in run differential (+41) behind the Tigers and Yankees (both +98)...have been above .500 for a season-high-tying six consecutive days (also: March 30-April 4)...are third in the AL East, 1.0 GB the second-place Blue Jays (31-28) and 6.5 GB the division-leading Yankees (36-22)...have spent two days in first, 10 in second, 19 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

* The Rays were blanked, 1-0, in Sunday's series finale in Houston, settling for a four-game series split...it marked their seventh shutout loss (2nd in AL/T5th in MLB)... 10th one-run loss (T5th in AL/T10th in MLB) and third 1-0 defeat (T2nd in MLB)... 11 three of their last four losses have come by one run.

* The only run of the game was an unearned tally scored in the opening frame following a Junior Caminero fielding error...it marked the 10th time in club history the Rays lost without allowing an earned run, first since April 19, 2024 at NYY (5-3).

* Tampa Bay outscored Houston, 30-9 (+21), in the series, the highest run differential in a series it did not win in franchise history...the previous mark of plus-11 was done twice, most recently earlier this season from April 14-16 vs. BOS (20-9, lost 2-1).

* The Rays have outscored opponents, 74-23 (+51), during their 9-3 stretch, leading MLB in ERA (1.77/106.2IP, 21ER), WHIP (0.95), runs per game (6.2), OPS (.832), extrabase hits (48) and home runs (20, T1st with LAA) in that span (since May 20).

DREW DAY—Drew Rasmussen carries a career-best 18.0 scoreless inning streak into tonight's contest, the longest active streak among major league starters...the righty has thrown 6.0 or more scoreless frames in three straight starts, matching the longest streak in franchise history (5x, last: Taj Bradley from July 12-25, 2024)...since the streak began on May 17. Rasmussen has held opponents to a 150/203/200 (9-for-60) slash line while posting a 0.67 WHIP, third in the majors behind DET Tarik Skubal (0.46) and NYY Ryan Yarbrough (0.59)...the longest scoreless inning streak by a starter in Rays history belongs to Alex Cobb (24-ZIP) from Aprill 1-May 27, 2014.

The Rays rotation has allowed three runs or fewer in 13 straight outings dating back to May 19 vs. HOU, their longest single-season streak since a 17-start run to conclude the 2024 campaign (Sept. 11-29)...during the current streak, the rotation paces the majors in ERA (1.84), WHIP (0.91), opp. on-base pct. (.258) and walk rate (4.7%).

Tampa Bay starters have registered a 1.36 ERA (66.1IP, 10ER) in their last 10 outings, allowing one or zero runs in seven of those starts.

BOOM OR BUST—The Rays scored 30 runs in their four-game series against the Astros, their most in any series since Aug. 18-19, 2023 at LAA (33R), but 29 of them came in two games (13, 16, 0)... the Rays have scored 13 runs or more four times, tied with the Dodgers and Red Sox for second in the majors behind the Cubs (6G), but their 15 games scoring one or zero runs are tied with the Royals for third most in the AL, trailing the Rangers (19G) and White Sox (17G)... the club is averaging 6.7 runs per game in wins (7th in MLB) and 1.9 runs in losses (28th in MLB)... the 4.8-run discrepancy is the second-largest in the majors behind the Cubs (4.86).

**Jonathan Aranda is 11-for-25 (.440) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI in his last eight games.

**Brandon Lowe has slashed .343/395/671 (24-for-70) with 5 2B, 6 HR and 13 RBI over his last 18 games... his career-high 13-game hitting streak was snapped Sunday, but he has still hit safely in nine straight home games (13-for-32/.406, 7XBH, 6RBI).

**Josh Lowe has a hit in eight of his last nine games, going 13-for-35 (.371)...Jose Caballero is 7-for-23 (.304) over his last six games, and Curtis Mead is batting .323 (10-for-31) with 3 HR across his last 11.

LA MÁXIMA—Junior Caminero was named AL Co-Player of the Week for May 26–June 1 alongside SEA Cal Raleigh after hitting .379 (11-for-29) with 4 2B, 4 HR and 13 RBI over seven games...he became the first Ray to earn a weekly award since Isaac Paredes for June 20-26, 2022...Caminero (21.331) surpassed Scott Kazmir (22.116) in May 2006 as the youngest player in franchise history to win a weekly MLB award...he went 7-for-17 with 3 2B, 3 HR and 11 RBI during the Rays four-game series in Houston, matching the club record for single-series extra-base hits (9x) while recording the second-most RBI in a set behind Ben Zobrist's 13 from April 27-29, 2011 at MIN.... in a 16-3 win on Saturday at HOU, Caminero tied single-game club records for extra-base hits (4) and total bases (12) while becoming the first player in Rays history to tally 4 XBH and 5 RBI in a game, and the youngest in the majors to accomplish the feat since PHA Frankie Hayes (21.286) on July 25, 1936 at CLE.

**Caminero is batting .400 (16-for-40) with an MLB-leading 12 XBH (7 2B, 5HR) in his last 10 games since May 23...he also paces the majors in OPS (1.379), slugging pct. (.950), RBI (17), doubles (T1st, 7) and total bases (38) over that stretch.

**He leads AL third basemen in home runs (13) and RBI (37) while ranking third in slugging behind CLE José Ramírez (.555) and BOS Alex Bregman (.553).

**This season, he has reduced his whiff rate from 31.7 pct. to 21.0 pct.. a 10.7 pct. improvement, including a 14.6 pct. decrease against breaking balls (42.5% to 27.9%).

**Caminero, who leads the majors in average bat speed (78.1 mph), joins NYM Pete Alonso (76.2 mph/23.2%) as the only qualified MLB hitters with a sub-25.0 pct. whiff rate and a bat speed of 75 mph or faster.

OFF THE WALLS—Taylor Walls was selected as one of three MLB Defensive Players of the Month for May by Sports Info Solutions alongside TEX Adolis García and STL Pedro Pages...Walls' 87 total chances during the month were the most by any shortstop without committing an error...on the season, he leads the majors in defensive runs saved (13), and his 48 DRS since his 2021 rookie season are the most among shortstops despite his 2,344.0 innings at the position ranking 29th.

**Walls has generated over a third of the Rays 35 DRS, which are tied with the Brayes for second most in the majors behind the Rangers (42).... between Walls and José Caballero (4), Rays shortstops have combined for 17 DRS—the next closest club is the Astros, who have 8 DRS at the position.

LATE BLOOMERS—The Rays plus-30 (95-65) run differential from the 7th inning on ranks fourth in the majors behind the Cubs (+37), Giants (+32) and Yankees (+31)...they have recorded five wins when trailing entering the 7th, tied with the Marlins for the most in MLB...over their last seven games, the Rays are batting .242/305/391 (39-for-161) with 12 XBH vs. opposing starters and .351/431/.667 (40-for-114) with 22 XBH off relievers.

*Yandy Diaz has produced a .328/.353/.531 (21-for-64) line from the 7th frame on, tied for the fourth-best average among AL qualifiers.

LESS IS MORE—Tampa Bay has the most efficient pitching staff in the majors, averaging the fewest pitches per inning at 15.4, which would surpass 2022 (15.8) for the fewest in team history and mark the lowest figure in MLB since the 2015 Mets (15.4)...the Rays have thrown 130 pitches or fewer in nine straight games (127, 123, 103, 126, 124, 130, 123, 117, 119) the longest single-season streak in the majors since pitch counts were first tracked in 1988.

RANGER DANGER—The Rays and Rangers complete a six-game season series this week after Tampa Bay was swept from April 4-6 in Arlington...the Rays have lost a franchise-record-tying seven straight games against the Rangers (also: May 9-July 25, 1999), their second-longest active streak against any opponent, trailing the Phillies (9G)...including the 2023 AL Wild Card Series (0-2), the Rays are 1-13 in the last 14 meetings dating back to July 17, 2023...they have scored three runs or fewer in 12 of those 14 games.

Yandy Diaz is a career .323 (43-for-133) hitter vs. Texas, third-highest among active hitters (min. 100AB) behind CHC Justin Turner (.348) and LAA Mike Trout (.325).

Danny Jansen is batting .348 (24-for-69) in 22 career games against the Rangers, his highest average vs. any opponent in his career.

TONIGHT'S START-Drew Rasmussen will make his 12th start of the **TONIGHT'S START—Drew Rasmussen** will make his 12th start of the year and ninth at Steinbrenner Field in tonight's series opener...marks his 62nd career start (111th appearance) and 30th at home (5th appearance)... has a 18.0 scoreless inning streak...has earned the win in three straight starts for the first time since Aug. 14-25, 2022 and is looking to win four straight starts for the first time in his career...min. 55.0 IP, his 2.33 ERA (58.0IP, 15ER) ranks eighth in the AL and 10th in the majors...has a 1.17 ERA (23.0IP, 3ER) in his last four starts...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his fourth straight win after pitching a season-high six scoreless innings for the third straight outing in a 5-0 victory over the Twins on May 28 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 6.0IP, H, BB, 5SO)... allowed a single to Trevor Larnach to lead off the game, but put away the next three hitters to get out of the opening frame...Ty France was then hit by a pitch to lead off the 2nd inning, but Rasmussen allowed just one other baserunner (Kody Clemens via walk in the 5th inning)...the righty retired 17 of the 20 batters to come to the plate, including nine straight after the hit by pitch in the 2nd...his 74 pitches thrown were his fewest in a win since he tossed 70 in his first start of the season (a 6-1 win over the Pirates on March 31).

**Rasmussen is one of three pitchers in 2025 to tally three straight starts with 6.0 or more scoreless innings joining PHI Zack Wheeler

Rasmussen is one of three pitchers in 2025 to tally three straight starts with 6.0 or more scoreless innings, joining PHI **Zack Wheeler** (19.2IP, May 11-23) and HOU **Hunter Brown** (19.0IP, April 9-21). This was Rasmussen's second career start tossing 6.0 or more scoreless innings with one or zero hits allowed (also: April 9, 2023 vs. OAK - 7.0IP, 1H)...was the 23rd time in Rays history that a pitcher tossed 6.0 IP or more, did not allow a run and surrendered one or zero hits and walks (last: **Zack Littell** Sept. 19, 2024 vs. BOS one or zero hits and walks (last: **Zack Littell**, Sept. 19, 2024 vs. BOS, 7.0IP, H, OBB).
The Rays have won each of his last three starts after going 1-6 in his

previous seven from April 6-May 11.

THIS AIN'T TEXAS—Tonight marks Rasmussen's third career start against the Rangers, his second of the season and first at home...in his first appearance on April 6 at Globe Life Field, he earned a no-decision after hurling 5.0 innings of one-run ball in a 4-3 loss (3H, BB, 4SO)...worked 3.0 innings and took the loss in his first start at Texas on May 30, 2022 after he gave up a career-high five earned runs on five hits (career high 2HR) and three walks with three strikeouts.

He is 7-3 with a 2.70 ERA (66.2IP, 20ER), a 0.95 WHIP and a .199 (49-for-246) opp. average in 16 career appearances (12GS) against AL West opponents...the .199 opp. average is the lowest of any division he has faced...has posted a 2.95 ERA (61.0IP, 20ER) in the 12 starts and a 2.81 ERA (32.0IP, 10ER) in the seven outings (5GS) at home... has allowed just one earned run in his last four appearances vs. the division (10.0IP, 0.90 ERA).

LOCKED IN—Rasmussen's 18.0 scoreless inning streak is the longest active streak among MLB starters...he has recorded three straight scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more for the first time in his career...became the fifth pitcher in Rays history to record three straight scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more, joining Taj Bradley (July 12-25, 2024), Ryan Yarbrough (July 20-Aug. 17, 2019), Jake Odorizzi (July 22-Aug. 3, 2016) and Alex Cobb (April 6-May 22, 2014)...Rasmussen has thrown 81, 76 and 74 pitches in those outings, becoming the only Rays pitcher to record three consecutive scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more on 81 pitches or fewer.

MAY FLOWERS- Rasmussen went 3-2 with a 1.98 ERA (27.1IP, 6ER) across his five starts in May...he ranked highly among qualified AL pitchers in ERA (5th), opp. AVG (5th, 188), WHIP (5th, 0.88), hits per 9.0 innings (5th, 5.93) and opp. OBP (10th, .250)...in his 19 career appearances (13GS) in the month of May, he has pitched to an 8-3 record and a 2.12 ERA (76.1IP, 18ER) with a .184 (50-for-272) opp. average, the lowest over any calendar month in his career (min. 6.0IP)...his eight wins are his most in any month. in any month.

HEAT CHECK—In 21 appearances (13GS) since the beginning of the 2024 season, Rasmussen has thrown fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 90.3 pct. of the time...min. 500 pitches, only PHI José Alvarado (98.6%), NYY Tim Hill (95.1%), TOR Jacob Barnes (94.9%) and BOS Kenley Jansen (91.7%) have higher fastball usage rates over that span.

**Opponents are hitting .188 (36-for-191) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .148 (9-for-61) clip against his cutter.

BEST OF THE BEST-Min. 250.0 IP. Rasmussen's 2.65 ERA (336.1IP. 99ER) BEST OF THE BEST—Min. 250.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.65 ERA (336.1IP, 99ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks fourth in the majors behind CLE Emmanuel Clase (1.89), ATL Raisel Iglesias (2.51) and NYY Max Fried (2.63)...over that timeframe, he also ranks second in the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.319) and opp. OPS (.582), third in home runs per 9.0 IP (0.64), third in opp. on-base pct. (.263) and fourth in WHIP (1.01).

**Rasmussen (2.86 ERA) is one of 14 active major league pitchers with 300.0 IP or more and an ERA of 3.00 or better in his career...he is one of four to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances, joining LAD Clayton Kershaw (2.51), TEX Jacob DeGrom (2.51) and NYY Max Fried (2.98).

POWER OUTAGE—With a home run allowed to Tim Tawa in the 5th inning in his start on April 24 at AZ, Rasmussen snapped a homerless streak of 66.0 IP dating back to May 6, 2023...it marked the sixth-longest streak in franchise history, trailing runs by Alex Cobb (82.1IP, 2014), Jake McGee (76.0IP, 2013-14), Alex Colomé (69.0IP, 2015-16), Scott Kazmir (68.0IP, 2007-08) and Roberto Hernandez (68.0IP, 1999-2000).

**Rasmussen did not yield an extra-base hit in 21.2IP from March 31—April 24...per Stats Perform, his streak with 0 XBH was the longest by a starting pitcher to begin a season in Rays history, and tied for second longest by any Rays pitcher with Kyle Farnsworth (21.2IP) in 2012...it trails only J.P. Feyereisen (24.1IP) in 2016...it marks the fourth-longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in a season.
