**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY**  
On this date in 1969, the Orioles clinched the first-ever American League East division title by defeating Cleveland, 7-3, at Memorial Stadium...The Birds went on to sweep Minnesota, the AL West champions, to capture the pennant, but fell in the World Series to the Mets in five games.



**WHAT A LONG STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN:** The Orioles return home from their six-day, six-game road trip that included visits to Citi Field to play the New York Mets and Yankee Stadium to matchup with the New York Yankees.

- ⚾ Tonight marks the beginning of the O's final homestand of the season...The seven-day, eight-game stretch includes visits by the Atlanta Braves (three games) and Tampa Bay Rays (five games)...Thursday will mark the O's fourth doubleheader of the season.
- ⚾ On Sunday, in the final game of the road trip, the Orioles were defeated by the Yankees by the score of 3-1 to fall to 0-16 when scoring three-or-fewer runs.
- ⚾ Prior to the road trip, the O's completed a six-day, six-game homestand against the Mets (two games) and Yankees (four games)...The stretch completed 12 games in a row for the O's against teams from New York City.

**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND:** The O's previous road trip ended with four games against the Toronto Blue Jays (on August 31), who are playing their home games at Sahlen Field in Buffalo, NY...When combined with the recent road trip that included two games at Citi Field against the New York Mets followed by four games at Yankee Stadium against the New York Yankees, the recent stretch accounted for 10 straight road games in the state of New York for the Orioles.

⚾ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the O's became the first team to play at least 10 consecutive road games in the state of New York since the Philadelphia Phillies did so from August 12-September 6, 1949...During that stretch, the 1949 Phillies played three games at the Polo Grounds against the New York Giants, three games at Ebbets Field against the Brooklyn Dodgers, and returned to the Polo Grounds for four games against the Giants to start their next trip.

**WAKE ME UP WHEN SEPTEMBER ENDS:** Three Orioles hitters are batting over .300 during the month (**DJ Stewart**, .367; **Ryan Mountcastle**, .359; **Rio Ruiz**, .300).

- ⚾ During the month of September, O's hitters rank sixth in the AL in OPS (.744), rank seventh in batting average (.253), and rank fifth in home runs (17).
- ⚾ **OF DJ Stewart's** six home runs lead the AL lead in Sept. and **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** is tied for ninth in the AL with 11 RBI, while **INF Rio Ruiz** is tied for 12<sup>th</sup> with 10 RBI during the month.
- ⚾ The O's 4.30 ERA (47 ER/98.1 IP) during September ranks sixth-best in the AL...Orioles pitchers have allowed 47 earned runs during the month to tie for sixth-fewest in the AL.
- ⚾ According to *teamrankings.com* the O's remaining strength of schedule (as of September 14) ranks as the toughest in the AL and fifth-toughest in the majors.

**RACE FOR .400:** **INF José Iglesias** went 1-for-4 on Sunday, and is hitting .348 (40-for-115) through his first 30 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 100 at-bats, Iglesias' .348 average ranks third in the AL and is tied for fifth in the majors...**Tim Anderson** of the Chicago White Sox leads the majors with a .362 average (min. 100 AB)...The last player in the majors to hit over .390 in a season was San Diego's **Tony Gwynn**, who hit .394 during 110 games of the strike-shortened 1994 season.

**IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST:** The O's rank first in the majors in batting average (.424), and lead the AL and ranks third in the majors in OPS (1.144), and rank sixth in the majors in extra-base hits (28) on the first pitch of an at-bat...The O's rank second in the AL and fourth in the majors in doubles (17), and first in the AL and fifth in the majors in hits (70) as a team on the first pitch.

**SMALL BALL FOR ALL:** The O's lead the majors with 14 bunt hits this season...**OF Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with eight bunt hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** is tied for third in the majors with four bunt hits and **INF/OF Andrew Velazquez** is tied for seventh in the majors with two bunt hits.

**THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW:** Since the start of the 2019 season, **INF Hanser Alberto** leads the majors with 101 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .393 (101-for-257) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks 11<sup>th</sup> in the AL with a .299 (52-for-174) average against all pitchers.

**CATCH THIS:** The O's catching corps of **Pedro Severino**, **Chance Sisco**, and **Bryan Holaday** ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

**INTERLEAGUE INFO:** The O's will play a total of 20 games against National League opponents this season, including contests with the Miami Marlins (0-4), Washington Nationals (4-2), Philadelphia Phillies (3-0), New York Mets (2-2), and Atlanta Braves (three games)...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the O's are 206-234...The O's went 7-13 in Interleague Play last season...Baltimore's 14 Interleague victories in 2016 were the most in club history.

**INJURED LIST:** Six players are on the Injured List...**RHP Shawn Armstrong** (left SI joint inflammation), **INF Chris Davis** (left knee patellar tendinitis), and **OF Anthony Santander** (right oblique strain) are on the 10-day Injured List...**LHP Wade LeBlanc** (left elbow stress reaction), **INF/OF Trey Mancini** (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and **INF Richie Martin** (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

**THE SKIPPER:** **Brandon Hyde** was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Most recently, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)...Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

**LAST START:** Made his third start of the season on 9/9 at NYM and took a no-decision after allowing five earned runs on six hits (two home runs), with one walk and a season-high six strikeouts over 4.2 innings...His five runs, six hits, and two home runs allowed were also season-highs...Was his first career start against NYM...This will be his eighth outing (fourth start) with Baltimore after starting the year in Kansas City...Was claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16 vs. WSH.

**CAREER VS. ATLANTA:** Will be his first career start against the Braves...His only previous appearance vs. the Braves came on 7/7/18 at Miller Park (while with MIL), where he tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief (1 H, 3 BB).

**FACING THE NL EAST:** In his career, Lopez has made nine appearances (two starts) against the NL East, and holds a 1-1 record with a 3.21 ERA (10 ER/28.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts...NL East opponents are batting .235 (24-for-102) with two home runs against Lopez in his career.

**FOR STARTERS:** Lopez is 7-13 with a 6.28 ERA (101 ER/144.2 IP) in 30 career starts...Is 2-6 with a 6.68 ERA (46 ER/62.0 IP) in 13 career home starts, compared to his 5-7 record and 5.99 ERA (55 ER/82.2 IP) in 17 career road starts...Made a career-high 18 starts for the Royals last season and recorded a 6.57 ERA (63 ER/86.1 IP) with 71 strikeouts and a .287 opponent's average (98-for-341)...Opened last season in the Royals starting rotation, but went 0-6 with a 7.07 ERA (39 ER/49.2 IP) over his first 10 starts...Went 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP) and .232 opponents' average (22-for-95) during a five-start stretch from 8/19/19-9/17/19, including back-to-back wins on 9/6/19 at MIA and 9/12/19 at CWS...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in the 3-0 win at MIA, marking his first career scoreless start.

**OH, THE RELIEF:** Has pitched in 36 career games as a reliever, working to a 1-2 record with a 5.24 ERA (40 ER/68.2 IP)...As a reliever, opponents have hit .277 (74-for-267) against him...Earned his first career save 8/25/19 at CLE, recording a scoreless bottom of the 10th inning...Collected eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of relief on 5/29/19 vs. CWS, the most strikeouts by a Royals reliever since Bruce Chen (also 8) on 6/28/14 vs. LAA.

**RIGHT OVER LEFT:** Lopez has had greater success against righties than against lefties in his career, holding right-handers to a .266 average (108-for-406), compared to left-handers who are batting .302 (131-for-434) against him...In 2019, Lopez held right-handed batters to a .241 average (59-for-245), including a .118 average (6-for-51) over 15 appearances from 6/21-8/19...Opposing left-handed batters hit .332 (81-for-244) against him in 2019...So far in 2020, lefties are batting .375 (6-for-16) against him, compared to righties who are batting .261 (6-for-23).

**2019 HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the entire season with Kansas City...Made the Opening Day roster for the first time and set career highs in wins (4), appearances (39), starts (18), innings (123.2) and strikeouts (109)...Posted a 4-9 record with a 6.33 ERA (87 ER/123.2 IP) in his 39 appearances (18 starts) with the Royals.
