APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: After going 11-15 (.423) in April, the Giants have gone 13-9 (.591) over 22 games in May, which is the third-best winning percentage in the National League behind the Dodgers (15-7, .682) and Diamondbacks (13-8, .619).

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants struggled with runners in scoring position yesterday going 2-for-16 and left a season high 15 men on base...it marked the most men they have left on base in a game since leaving 17 runners on base on September 3, 2021 vs. Los Angeles-NL...according to SIS, yesterday marked the first time in 38 years that the Giants left 15 men on base and scored only 1 run in a 9-inning game...the last time it happened was against the Astros in 1985 with Joe Niekro beating Bill Laskey.

BE LIKE MIKE: **OF Michael Conforto** became one of four Giants players in the modern era (since 1901) to have at least 10 HR and 20 walks in his first 44 games with the team joining **Moises Alou** (11 HR, 28 BB in 2005), **Barry Bonds** (11 HR, 39 BB in 1993) and **Willie Mays** (10 HR, 24 BB in 1951) (Stats, LLC)...the homer was Conforto's sixth in his last 13 games, tied for the third-most homers in MLB since May 10 behind NY Yankees' Aaron Judge (8) and CHC's Christopher Morel (8)...in this run, Conforto is slashing .320/.364/.720 with 14 RBI.

TOO MANY MISCS: The Giants committed a season-high three errors yesterday and now have 35 overall this season, which ranks as the most in the Majors.

FEW RUNS ALLOWED: San Francisco's pitching staff has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 10 straight games entering today, the second-longest active streak in MLB (see chart below)...during that 10-game stretch the Giants have posted a 7-3 record with the starting staff posting a 4.02 ERA...it marks the Giants' longest such streak since April 9-20 of last season when they had 11 straight contests (*Stats, LLC*).

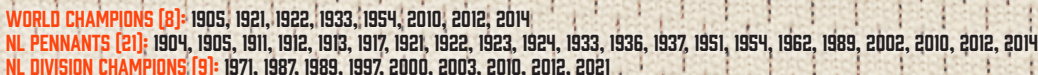
BULLIES: The Giants have won seven of their last nine games, a stretch that comes after dropping six of their previous eight contests...this excellent stretch is in part due to SF's bullpen, who's sporting a 1.13 ERA, the third-best figure in the Majors, and holding opposing teams to a .180 average during the run...since May 15, the 'pens 52 strikeouts are second-most of any bullpen in the Majors behind the Dodgers' 53 while their 40.0 innings pitched are fifth-most.

ALL ABOUT THAIRO: IF **Thairo Estrada** is the first Giants player since **Barry Bonds** in 1995 to have at least 55 hits, 30 runs scored and 10 stolen bases in the team's first 50 games of a season...**Bobby Bonds** and **Willie Mays** are the only other Giants to do so over the past 100 years (Stats. LLC).

IT'S ALL ABOUT BALANCE: Overall, SF's pitching staff has posted a 2.81 ERA since May 15, the second-best figure in the Majors behind the White Sox (1.58)...the Giants' offense averaged 4.1 runs-per-game despite homering just five times over the nine-game span...after slugging an NL-leading 46 home runs in April, SF hitters have just 21 homers this month, tied for 19th in MLB.

#54 SCOTT ALEXANDER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/23 at MIN; 1.0 (11 pitches)

- ▶ Will serve as the opener in SF's bullpen game today, making his sixth career start and first this year...in the five starts, (one w/ LAD in 2018, four w/ SF in 2022), Alexander has a 1.59 ERA (1er, 5.2ip) with a .217 average and a 0.88 WHIP...his teams are 3-2 when he opens.
- ▶ Has pitched in seven of SF's last 12 games...had appeared in just one of their previous 10 games (May 3 at Houston) before that.
- ▶ Over those last seven outings, he is 2-0-1 with a 1.29 ERA (1er, 7.0ip) and .095 opposing average (2x21).
- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in 16 of his 21 outings.
- ▶ Stranded 13 of his 16 inherited runners this season (81.3%) and 21-of-24 (87.5%) since joining SF late last year.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-28 (.179) off him with three XBH while righties are 9-for-39 (.231) with one XBH.
- ▶ Opponents are 4-for-27 (.148) off him with runners in scoring position...however, they are 4-for-their-last-19 (.211).

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

Last Game: 5/22 at MIN; 2.2ip, h, r, er, 4k, hr, hb (39 pitches)

- ▶ His 97.5 MPH fastball to strike out IF Joey Gallo Monday was his fastest pitch of the season.
- ▶ Monday marked his first outing in 10 days (May 13 at Arizona).
- ▶ Pitched at least 5.0 innings out of the bullpen in two of his eight games...has allowed five HRs over his eight outings (20.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .296 off him...lefties are 14-for-36 (.389).
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento April 19...made his MLB debut in relief the next day and struck out five in his 5.1 frames, the most innings by a Giant in their MLB debut since LHP Andrew Suárez on April 11, 2018.
- ▶ Acquired by SF in the Mark Melancon trade back in 2019 at the Trade Deadline...was originally a fourth-round pick of the Braves in 2018 out of Stanford...RHP Daniel Winkler also came to SF in that trade.

#59 JOHN BREBBIA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/22 at MIN; 1.0ip, 2k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third start of the season on Monday, throwing a scoreless inning...dating back to last season, he has a 0.63 ERA (1er, 14.1ip) with 13 strikeouts and a 0.98 WHIP in 13 appearances as an opener, with SF going 9-5.
- ▶ Is currently saddled with a 4.05 ERA but his xERA is 2.20.
- ▶ Has a 37.0% strikeout rate, the highest of his career and ranking in the top 3% of the league.
- ▶ Batters have gone 8-for-46 (.174) vs. his slider this year after hitting .299 off it last season...batters are 7-for-26 (.269) off his fastball early on in 2023 and they were 22-for-101 (.218) off it last year.
- ▶ Has appeared in 22 of SF's 49 games.
- ▶ Allowed six of his 11 inherited runners to score so far in '23...only allowed seven of his 24 inherited runners to score last season.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/23 at MIN; S, 1.0ip, hb, 3k (19 pitches)

- ▶ Has saved 10 and finished 11 of SF's 13 victories this month...his 13 saves overall this year are most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (16).
- ▶ Batters have a 91.9 mph average exit velo off Doval this year, which is in the bottom 6% of the league...last season's batters exit velocity was 85.9 mph off him, which ranked in the top 6% of the league.
- ▶ Opposing hitters have a 53.2% hard hit rate off Doval this year, which is also in the bottom 1% of the league...they had a 33.9% hard hit rate in his rookie 2021 season and a 36.4% rate last season.
- ▶ Has struck out 34 batters over 22.2 innings of work...his 36.6% strikeout rate ranks in the top 3% of the league.
- ▶ Batters have two hits in 21 at-bats (.095) that end with his cutter with 12 strikeouts.
- ▶ Leads the team with 23 appearances this year.
- ▶ Allowed four of his 13 inherited runners to score so far this year...stranded 14 of his 19 inherited runners last season.
- ▶ Has limited batters to three hits in 51 at-bats with two strikes (.059).

#34 JAKOB JUNIS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Two-Seam FB, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/21 vs. MIA; 2.0ip, 1h, 1k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 13 appearances out of SF's bullpen...seven of his 13 outings have been as a long reliever with his season-high being 4.0ip.
- ▶ Has a 1.86 ERA (2er, 9.2ip) in six games this month after a 6.06 ERA in seven games in April (11er, 16.1ip).
- ▶ Is walking 4.15 batters per 9.0 innings, more than double his BB/9ip ratio last year (2.01) and almost double his career rate (2.50).
- ▶ Has a 6.61 ERA in six games on the road.
- ▶ Batters have a 41.9% hard hit rate off him, up from 38.2% in 2022.
- ▶ Has used his slider 63.3% of the time so far this year.

#52 SEAN MANAEA ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/22 at MIN; W, 3.2ip, 3h, 3bb, 8k (83 pitches)

- ▶ Tied a season-high eight strikeouts in just 3.2 innings of relief on Monday...matched RHP Sean Hjelle for the second-most strikeouts as a SF reliever since RHP Scott Garrelts (9) on May 13, 1984.
- ▶ Became the first MLB left-hander to throw at least 80 pitches and strike out 8+ batters in a scoreless relief outing since Randy Johnson struck out 16 in 7.0 innings on July 19, 2001 (OptaSTATS).
- ▶ Allowed 25 runs (19 earned) in 22.2 innings in six starts (7.54 ERA)...has given up five runs in 8.2ip in his three relief apps (5.19 ERA).
- ▶ Given up eight homers in 31.1 innings this season for a 2.3 HR/9ip rate...his previous career-high HR/9ip ratio was last year (1.7).
- ▶ Has also had issues with walks this year, walking 12.8% of his batters this year which is almost double his career rate (6.5%).

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 5/24 at MIN; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed an earned run last Friday for first time since April 12...snapped streak of 12 straight appearances (10.0ip) without an ER.
- ▶ The HR he allowed Friday was first he'd allowed since April 7 vs. KC.
- ▶ Has a 1.42 ERA in seven games on the road, compared to a 7.27 figure in 11 outings here at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Pitched 24 games for MIL last season after being dealt to the Brewers in the trade that brought LHP Josh Hader to SD...was 3-3-3 with a 5.48 ERA (14er, 23.0ip) with three saves and a 1.30 WHIP.
- ▶ Twin brother Tyler is also on Giants...according to Elias, Taylor and Tyler Rogers are the fourth set of twins to play on same team in MLB history...others being Jose and Ozzie Canseco (Oakland in 1990), Eddie and Johnny O'Brien (Pittsburgh in 1953, 1955-58) and Joe and Red Shannon (Boston in 1915).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 5/22 at MIN; 0.2ip, bb, 2k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 0.63 ERA and .184 opposing average in 10 outings at Oracle Park this season, compared to a 4.22 ERA in 11 road games.
- ▶ Owns a 0.93 ERA (1er, 9.2ip) in seven games this month.
- ▶ Has held teams scoreless in 16 of his 21 outings this season.
- ▶ Opponents are 17-for-86 off him (.198) with lefties going 2-for-31 off him...right-handed batters are 15-for-57 (.263) with five XBH.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (215g).
- ▶ Batters had an average exit velo of 84.2 mph off Rogers in '22, second-lowest in MLB...batters have a 87.1 average exit velo in '23.
- ▶ Has allowed 12 homers in 227.1 career innings (0.48 HR/9ip).

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 5/24 at MIN; 2.0ip, 4k (29 pitches)

- ▶ Struck out four of the six batters faced in 2.0 shutout innings yesterday.
- ▶ Had contract selected last Friday and made his Major League debut Sunday...earned the win as he tossed 1.0-scoreless inning.
- ▶ Had a 0.89 ERA (2er, 20.1ip) with Triple-A Sacramento early this season, tops in the Giants organization (min. 20.0ip).
- ▶ Selected in the 31st round by SF out of Washington State in 2018...would be fourth member of that draft to debut (others: C Joey Bart, RHP Sean Hjelle and IF David Villar).

#14 PATRICK BAILEY ▶ C

Yesterday: DNP

Hit Streak: 1 (1x3)

Last HR: 5/21 vs. MIA (J. Luzardo)

- ▶ Had his contract selected last Friday...made his MLB debut as a defensive replacement that night and slugged his first career HR on Sunday.
- ▶ Selected by SF in the first round (13th overall) of the 2020 draft out of NC State...is the second Giant from that draft class to debut, joining second-round pick **IF Casey Schmitt**.
- ▶ Began the year at Richmond and earned his promotion after just 14 games at the Double-A level...hit .333 with two HRs and 10 RBI with the Squirrels.
- ▶ Was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on April 26 and hit two more homers with six RBI in 14 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Threw out 69 of 225 basestealers in the minors (31%).
- ▶ Won an MiLB Gold Glove as a catcher last season...led all minor league catchers last year with 22 defensive runs saved (SIS).

#8 MICHAEL CONFORTO ▶ OF

Yesterday: 1x5, 2k

Hit Streak: 3 (3x10)

Last HR: 5/23 at MIN (J. López)

- ▶ Has six homers and 14 RBI over his last 13 games...his six homers since May 10 are tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ▶ Slashing .341/.362/.727 with two doubles, five homers, 12 RBI, seven runs scored and two walks in his last 11 games.
- ▶ Six of Conforto's 10 homers this year have given SF the lead.
- ▶ Through 21 games this month he has a 21.4% strikeout rate, compared to a 33% strikeout rate during the season's first month.
- ▶ The Giants are 11-3 this year in games when Conforto drives in a run and 7-3 when he homers.

#35 BRANDON CRAWFORD ▶ IF

Yesterday: 1x2, 2b, 2bb, k

Hit Streak: 2 (2x6)

Last HR: 4/29 at SD (J. Musgrove)

- ▶ His hard-hit rate is 33.9%...was 35.1% in 2022 and 43.3% in 2021...his barrel rate is 10.2%, up from 6.7% last year.
- ▶ Has just three hits in 30 at-bats against lefties (.100).
- ▶ His 43.7% first pitch swing rate is the second highest of his career (was 49.7% in 2020).
- ▶ Is 8-for-27 (.296) with two HRs and 10 RBI with RISP.

#7 J.D. DAVIS ▶ IF

Yesterday: DNP

Hit Streak: -1 (0x4)

Last HR: 5/21 vs. MIA (J. Luzardo)

- ▶ Is hitting .281 with six extra-base hits and a .368 OBP over his last 18 contests.
- ▶ Leads team with 26 RBI and is second with eight home runs.
