

# San Francisco Giants (66-66) at Milwaukee Brewers (75-55) RHP Logan Webb (11-8, 3.13) vs. RHP Tobias Myers (6-5, 2.87)

**TODAY'S GAME:** After an off day yesterday, the Giants will face the Brewers for the first game of a three-game set...SF is 1-2 so far on this road trip after a stressful series at Seattle where each game was decided by one run.

- ▶ The series marked the first time SF played a three-game set with all three games decided by one run since taking two-of-three against Boston at Oracle Park on July 28-30, 2023.
- ▶ Despite dropping eight of their last 13 games, the Giants are still 17-11 (.607) since July 26, which is tied with the Cubs for the fifth-best record in the Majors during that span, trailing Arizona (22-6, .786), San Diego (20-8, .714), New York-AL (18-10, .643) and Kansas City (18-11, .621).
- ▶ Entering today, SF is 5.5 games back of the Braves for the final Wild Card spot in the NL, tied with the Cubs and also behind the Mets (68-63, -3.0 GB)...according to Fangraphs, SF's playoff chances have dropped to just 2.7%.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ RHP Landen Roupp (#65) and RHP Austin Warren (#57) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Robbie Ray** placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to 8/26) with a left hamstring strain.
- ▶ RHP Jordan Hicks placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to 8/25) with right shoulder inflammation.
- ▶ C Jakson Reetz cleared waivers and was outrighted to Triple-A Sacramento.

**SOMETHING'S BREWING:** The Giants are facing the Brewers for the first time this season, playing a three-game set here in Milwaukee this week (today-Thursday) and hosting the Brewers on September 10-12 at Oracle Park.

- ▶ SF has a 9-5 (.643) record against the Brewers since 2022, the second-best record against Milwaukee over that span only behind the Dodgers 13-7 (.650) (min. 10 games played).
- Here at American Family Field, the Giants have won eight of their last 13 games dating to 2019 and six of their last nine.

**WORKHORSE: RHP Logan Webb** gets the nod for SF in what is his 28th start of the season...over his last five starts (since July 31), Webb is 4-0 with a 0.96 ERA (4er, 37.1ip) and a .167 opposing average...his 0.96 ERA since July 31 is best in MLB and his best mark over a five-game span in his career.

- ► The NL All-Star leads the Majors in innings pitched (172.2) and home runs-per-nine innings (0.36HR/9.0ip) this season.
- In fact, Webb has thrown 43.1 consecutive innings without giving up a homer entering play today, marking the longest active streak by any starting pitcher across MLB.

**CAUGHT IN THE WEBB:** Webb is 2-0 with a 1.73 ERA (5er, 26.0ip), .169 opposing average and 35 strikeouts (12.12 SO/9ip) in four career starts vs. Milwaukee.

▶ The right-hander is even better here at American Family Field, where he is 1-0 in two starts, allowing just two runs (1.38 ERA) on five hits with 20 strikeouts (13.85 SO/9.0ip) over 13.0 innings of work.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Giants have a .338 on-base percentage when leading off an inning this season, second-highest in MLB and trailing only the Diamondbacks (.340).

**STEALING THE SHOW: IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** leads the Giants with 16 stolen bases this year and became the first Giants rookie with 16 steals was **Rajai Davis**, who had 17 steals with SF in 2007...Fitzgerald's nine stolen bases this month are the most by any Giants player in August since Davis had 11 in 2007.

With OF Grant McCray stealing his first base over the weekend, 20 of SF's 54 total steals this year were by rookies...the 20 stolen bases by rookies are sevent-most in MLB and most by a Giants team since also recording 20 rookie stolen bases in 2015.

**STRAP IN:** 24 of the Giants' final 30 games are against opponents who are currently .500 or better, with the only exceptions being the Marlins (47-84) and Cardinals (65-66)... all of the 24 games are against teams that are currently in a Postseason push...the Giants have gone 33-42 (.440) this year against opponents who are currently at or above .500, ranking 17th of 30 teams.

▶ SF has the most difficult remaining schedule in the Majors, with their remaining opponents totaling a .542 winning %.

I'LL TAKE A VENTI: OF Heliot Ramos lined his 20th homer of the season on Sunday to put SF on the board in the 1st inning... Ramos became the the youngest Giants hitter with 20 homers in a season since **Pablo Sandoval** hit 23 homers in 2011 (also at 24).


- ▶ Paired with 20 homers by IF Matt Chapman, it marks the first time SF has a pair of teammates with at least 20 homers since 2021, when Brandon Belt (29), OF Mike Yastrzemski (25) and Brandon Crawford (24) all reached the mark.
- Also having eight eight homers at Triple-A this season, Ramos has hit 28 this year across both MLB and MiLB.
- ▶ Ramos is batting .346/.400/.769 with two doubles, three homers, and eight RBI in his last seven games.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** Earned his first career All-Star selection, joining **OF Heliot Ramos** as the two Giants in the Midsummer Classic...Webb became the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision last Wednesday in SF's 6-2 late loss to the White Sox...worked 8.0 innings and held Chicago batters to two runs on five hits with six strikeouts.

HIGH-FIVE!: Has won four of his last five outings dating to July 31 and has two runs or fewer in all of them...has a 0.96 ERA (4er, 37.1ip) with 31 strikeouts, a .167 opposing average (22x132) and just five extra-base hits (three doubles, two triples) to go with his 4-0 record in that stretch...Webb's 0.96 ERA since July 31 is best in MLB.

**VS. MILWAUKEE:** Will be facing the Brewers for the fifth time in his career...is 2-0 with a 1.73 ERA (5er, 26.0ip), a .169 opposing average and 35 strikeouts (12.12 SO/9ip) in the four starts...here at American Family Field, Webb is 1-0 in two starts, allowing just two runs (1.38 ERA) on five hits (.152 average) with 20 strikeouts (13.85 SO/9.0ip) over 13.0 innings of work.

**ON THE LEADERBOARDS:** Webb leads all Major League pitchers in innings this season at 172.2...the right-hander also ranks among the top of MLB leaderboards in ERA (3.13, 6th), FIP (2.76, 3rd) and quality starts (18, T-5th).

**DADDY LONG LEGS:** Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 15 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only three other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Blake Snell** (3x), **Jordan Hicks** on April 5 vs. SD and **Kyle Harrison** on May 7 at COL).

**KEEP 'EM IN THE YARD:** Webb enters today with having not allowed a homer in 43.1 consecutive innings, the longest active streak by any starting pitcher across MLB...he's allowed just seven homers this season and has surrendered a total of two homers over his past 11 starts (73.1ip)...Webb's 0.36 HR/9ip this season is currently a career-best and leads all active pitchers, just ahead of PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.36).

**BOOTS ON THE GROUND:** Through 27 starts this year Webb owns a 56.5% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (60.1%), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (59.9%) and ATL's Max Fried (58.0%)...he leads the Majors with 290 produced ground balls this season.

**THE LONG GAME:** Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 581.0 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (558.0), Corbin Burnes (555.0) and Miles Mikolas (547.2).

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Webb's changeup has a +7 run value in 2024 after having +28 run value last season (the second-most valuable pitch in the league behind AL Cy Young Award winner Gerrit Cole's fastball)...his most valuable pitch this year thus far (in terms of run value) has turned out to be his sinker, which has a +13 run value...in terms of his changeup, opponents have a .256 average against it with a .289 xBA and a .348 SLG...over his past five starts, batters are just 7-for-57 (.123) with 14 strikeouts off his changeup.

SHUT THE FRONT DOOR: Threw his second career shutout on July 31 in SF's 1-0 victory against the A's...limited Oakland batters to just five hits with a walk and six strikeouts, achieving the feat in just one hour & 55 minutes (106 pitches)...the outing marked his third career complete game and first since September 25, 2023 vs. San Diego...Webb's previous career shutout came on July 9, 2023 vs. Colorado, when SF also won the game 1-0 in one hour and 56 minutes...the right-hander joined **Greg Maddux** as the only MLB players to toss multiple 9+ inning 1-0 shutouts in under two hours in the Wild Card era (since 1995) (*Stats, LLC*).
