#### Don't Mess With Bill

William Contreras enters the day on a 9-game hitting streak in which he is batting .353 (12-for-34, 3hr, 11rbi) with a .410 OBP/.676 SLG/1.087 OPS.

#### You Rang?

Brice Turang, who has hit safely in 17 of his 18 games this season, currently ranks among National League leaders in hits (3rd, 24), runs (T3rd, 17) and AVG (T9th, .329)....he enters the day on a 5-game hitting streak, batting .421 (8-for-19, 2rbi) while posting a .476 OBP/.421 SLG/.897 OPS.

#### Nick of Time

Nick Mears has retired all 14 batters he has faced over his first 5 outings of the season....he began the year on the injured list while recovering from an illness from Spring Training.

#### We Went to Jared

Jared Koenig is unscored upon in his last 8 outings (7.2ip 1h, 3bb, 10k) with opponents batting .042 (1-for-24).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is game 3 (1-1) of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Detroit (1-1) and the Athletics (3g)....following this homestand, the team takes a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (4g), St. Louis (3g) and Chicago-AL (3g).

**IT WON'T BE THE SAME:** This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970)....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

**IN THE STANDINGS (29 days):** The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 10\*, **SECOND:** 6, **THIRD:** 7, **FOURTH:** 3, **FIFTH:** 3....the team is in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 2.0 games (\* 9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game).

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers are 3-2-0 in series play.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 6-3 at home, going 2-0-0 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 3-6 on the road, going 1-2-0 in series play.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager....Murphy was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after guiding the team to a 93-69 record and the NL Central division championship....he became the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2024 coaching staff is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season) and third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The team has not made any replay challenges in 2025.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 675 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

## TODAY'S STARTER: #62 - LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (1gs, 1-0, 0.00)

**QUINTANA AT A GLANCE:** José Quintana, 36, will be making his second start of the season....Quintana made his season debut last Friday at Arizona and earned a 7-0 win in his first appearance with the Brewers (7ip, 4h, 0bb, 2k, 1bk, 80 pitches)....with the victory over Arizona, he became the 24th pitcher to earn a win against all of Major League Baseball's current 30 teams and the fifth active pitcher, joining **Gerrit Cole**, **Charlie Morton**, **Max Scherzer** and **Justin Verlander**....Quintana became just the fifth pitcher in franchise history to toss at least 7.0 scoreless innings in his debut with the team, joining **Gary Bell** (1969), **Tom Filer** (1988), **Steve Woodard** (1997) and **Tomo Ohka** (2005).... he signed as a free agent on March 5....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

**LAST SEASON:** Quintana went 10-10 with a 3.75 ERA in 31 starts with New York-NL....the team went 16-15 in his starts....he made 12 quality starts....opponents batted .237 (150-for-634, 22hr)....he was the Mets' Opening Day starter (against the Brewers).

**MR. COLOMBIA:** Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (360), starts (334), wins (103), innings pitched (1976.2) and strikeouts (1,729)....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

**BEEEN THERE, DONE THAT:** Quintana has made 334 starts since 2012 - his first season - which ranks fourth in the Major Leagues behind **Max Scherzer** (357), **Zack Greinke** (344) and **Lance Lynn** (338)....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

**CAREER:** Is 103-103 with a 3.73 ERA in 360 games/334 starts (1976.2ip, 819er)....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025)....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 12 starts (67ip, 29er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 51-55 with a 3.77 ERA in 182 games/170 starts (995.1ip, 417er)....went 5-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 16 starts last season (86.1ip, 37er).

**CAREER vs. TIGERS:** Is 6-6 with a 4.85 ERA in 23 games/22 starts (130ip, 157h, 71r, 70er, 32bb, 98k, 14hr)....has not faced the Tigers since 6/7/22 with the Pirates.
