**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners begin their first road trip of the 2026 season with the first of 3 contests against the Los Angeles Angels...Seattle will also visit the Texas Rangers for a 3-game series on the trip...the Mariners went 3-4 on their opening homestand against the Cleveland Guardians (2-2) and New York Yankees (1-2)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners dropped the series finale to the Yankees by a 5-3 score on Wednesday, before enjoying their first off day of the 2026 campaign yesterday.

- **Woo Makes Start Number Two** - **Bryan Woo** tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs with 9 strikeouts and 1 walk in a no-decision on March 28 vs. Cleveland...Woo tallied his 400th career strikeout.
- **On The Road Again** - Last year, the Mariners fared better in front of their home fans at T-Mobile Park (51-30) versus road games (39-42), but the Mariners finished strong on the road, going 7-1 over their final 8 road contests of the 2025 regular season.
- **Ouchy!** - **Randy Arozarena** has recorded 99 hit-by-pitches in his career, 1 away from becoming the ninth active player with 100+ career HBP at the plate.

**J.P. CRAWFORD IS BACK**...yesterday the Mariners reinstated infielder **J.P. Crawford** from the 10-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation), optioned infielder **Ryan Bliss** to Triple-A Tacoma, and placed right-handed pitcher **Ryan Loutos** on unconditional release waivers...Crawford appeared in one game on rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma and had a productive 2025 season, batting .265 (151x570) with 69 runs scored, 24 doubles, 12 home runs, 58 RBI, 8 stolen bases and 74 walks, getting on base at a .352 clip, slugging .370 with a .722 OPS...on July 9 at New York-AL, he played his 787th career game at shortstop for the Mariners, passing **Alex Rodriguez** for the most games played at shortstop in franchise history.

**500TH GAME FOR DONOVAN**...**Brendan Donovan** appears in his 500th career Major League game tonight...he recorded his 500th career hit on Opening Day, a 5th inning double off Cleveland starter **Tanner Bibee**...through 499 career games, Donovan has a 120 OPS+ and has appeared at 6 different defensive positions (2B, LF, 3B, 1B, RF, SS in that order)...he's batting .284 (508x1789) with 245 runs, 99 doubles, 5 triples, 42 homers, 206 RBI, 186 walks and 16 stolen bases, getting on base at a .364 clip, slugging .415 with a .779 OPS in 2,036 plate appearances, compiling 11.8 wins above replacement (*Baseball-Reference*).

**MAKING A STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION**...**Brendan Donovan** is batting .417 (10x24) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 4 walks through his first 7 games with Seattle...in the Majors, he ranks 4th in on-base percentage (.533), 7th in OPS (1.283) and T-9th in slugging (.750) in the early going, also ranking T-5th in total bases (18).

**"THE CAL RALEIGH SHOW" RETURNS**...the second season of "**The Cal Raleigh Show**" presented by the Puyallup Tribe debuted last night on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)**...the show, hosted by Mariners insider **Shannon Drayer**, will feature in-depth conversations with Mariners star catcher, **Cal Raleigh**...the program is set to air every Thursday, usually at 5:00 p.m. PT, moving into an earlier slot when the Mariners play in different timezones...'catch' all of the episodes on [SeattleSports.com](http://SeattleSports.com) or on the Seattle Sports app.

**COLE WORLD**...**Cole Young** has gotten off to a nice start in his sophomore season, batting .320 (8x25) with 4 runs, 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and a .520 slugging percentage, posting an .866 OPS and 161 OPS+...the 22-year-old second baseman has hit safely in 6 consecutive contests (3/27-c), one game shy of matching his career-best, 7-game hitting streak from July 8-19, 2025.

**T-MOBILE PARK IS THE PLACE TO BE**...during the Mariners opening homestand, they drew 239,504 total fans as of the morning of April 3, 3rd-highest total in the big leagues so far behind only the Dodgers and Padres...an average of 34,214 fans watched the Mariners at T-Mobile Park through 7 games.

**EXCITEMENT AROUND MARINERS BASEBALL**...approximately 450 interviews and media sessions with Mariners players, coaches, and front office personnel were facilitated at 2026 Spring Training, in over 50 unique local, national, and international media outlets that visited Mariners camp in Peoria, Arizona.

**MARINERS SIGN COLT EMERSON TO CONTRACT EXTENSION**...the Mariners signed top prospect **Colt Emerson** to a contract extension through the 2033 season, with a club option through 2034...Emerson was selected to the 40-man roster and optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...Emerson, 20, is ranked as the Mariners #1 prospect, and the #7 overall prospect in the Major Leagues, according to both *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...the infielder joins a list of homegrown Mariners players who have signed contract extensions with the team in recent years, which includes **Cal Raleigh** and **Julio Rodríguez**...the left-handed hitting infielder was selected by the Mariners in the 1st round (22nd overall) of the 2023 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of John Glenn High School in New Concord, Ohio.

**MARINERS TV**...the Mariners announced that Mariners TV will bring Mariners Baseball to fans across television and streaming services throughout the region...in-market streaming will be available on Mariners TV for \$99.99/season or \$19.99/month...Mariners TV is available across major providers including Xfinity, DIRECTV, Fubo, Spectrum and more...fans can use the channel finder tool on [Mariners.com/Watch](http://Mariners.com/Watch) to find providers in their area.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Andrés Muñoz** has been one of the game's premier relief pitchers since he made his Mariners debut against the Angels on Oct. 3, 2021, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Muñoz has been historically good in particular against the Halos?...in 25 career appearances against the Angels, the right-hander has 8 saves and a 0.71 ERA (2 ER, 25.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 12 walks, allowing just one home run...Muñoz's 16.34 strikeouts-per-9 mark ranks first among all pitchers to face the Angels (min. 20 IP), while his 0.71 ERA ranks 6th.

## ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - APRIL 3

- **1989** - **Ken Griffey Jr.** makes his Major League debut. The future Hall of Famer and baseball icon goes 1-for-3 with a walk, batting second and starting in center field. He records his first career MLB hit on the first pitch he sees, against Athletics star pitcher **Dave Stewart**. The Mariners drop the game, 3-2, at the Oakland Coliseum.
- **2002** - The Mariners, trailing Chicago 6-3 going into the bottom of the 9th, score four runs in the inning to win 7-6. **Bret Boone's** single scored **Carlos Guillen** with the game winner.
- **2006** - **Kenji Johjima** becomes the first Japanese catcher to start a major league game. In Seattle's 5-3 loss to the Angels, the Mariners' 30-year old backstop homers for his first career hit.

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 2nd start of the season and 1st against the Angels...marks his 72nd Major League start, and 9th career start against the Angels.

LAST TIME OUT...ND on March 28 vs. Cleveland, tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 4 hits and 1 walk with 9 strikeouts...he threw 83 pitches (59 strikes) in his first start of the season...he has thrown a quality start in three consecutive season debuts (2024-c).

400...recorded his 400th career strikeout on March 28 vs. Cleveland, becoming the 2nd fastest starter to reach 400 strikeouts in franchise history (71 GS), behind only Felix Hernández (70 GS, 405 K).

THE WILD WEST...across 30 career starts against AL West teams, is 13-5 with a 3.08 ERA (56 ER, 163.2 IP) and 174 strikeouts to just 34 walks allowed...went 6-3 with a 2.81 ERA (23 ER and 73.2 IP) and 85 strikeouts across 12 starts against AL West teams in 2025.

REMEMBER WHEN...in his last appearance against the Angels on Sept. 13, 2025, he struck out a career-high 13 batters and induced a career-high 23 swings-and-misses.

CALIFORNIA LOVIN'...is 3-2 with a 3.94 ERA (35 ER, 80.0 IP) and 76 strikeouts across 14 career strikeouts in California ballparks (LAA, LAD, SD, SF, ATH)...is looking for his first decision at Angel Stadium across 5 career starts.

2025 TOTALS...went 15-7 with a 2.94 ERA (61 ER, 186.2 IP), 36 walks, 198 strikeouts and a 0.93 WHIP in 30 starts...held opponents to a .200/.243/.353 slashline last season...finished 5th in 2025 BBWAA Cy Young Award voting.

END OF THE ROAD...finished the 2025 regular season on Sept. 19, 2025 at Houston, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings and allowing 1 hit and 1 walk while striking out 7 batters before exiting with right pectoral inflammation...returned 27 days later to make Postseason debut in ALCS Game 5 vs. Toronto, allowing 1 run (1 ER) in 2.0 innings of relief.

WOO-NDERFUL STREAK...began the 2025 season with 25 consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings and 2-or-fewer walks, the 2nd-longest such streak in MLB history (Cy Young, 30 G, 1905)...his run of 6.0+ inning starts was also the longest to begin a season in Mariners history.

FIRST HALF WARRIOR...threw 6.0+ innings in all 18 starts before the All-Star break, while posting a 2.75 ERA (35 ER, 114.2 IP) with 109 strikeouts and 21 walks...his 2.75 ERA is the 6th-best by a starting pitcher in the first half (min. 15 GS) in franchise history, while his 0.93 WHIP ranks 3rd-best (1st: Logan Gilbert, 0.87 in 2024)...is 12-6 with a career 2.84 (61 ER, 193.1 IP) and 181 strikeouts across 34 starts pre All-Star Break.

AMONG THE BEST...is 1 of 4 pitchers in MLB to have a sub-3.00 ERA and a sub-1.00 WHIP since 2024, joining Zack Wheeler-PHI, Tarik Skubal-DET and Paul Skenes-PIT (min. 300.0 IP)...his 2.92 ERA over that span is 7th best in MLB.

QUALITY STUFF...threw a quality start in 21 of his 30 starts last season, tied for 4th-most in the Majors, trailing only Logan Webb-SF (22), Cristopher Sánchez-PHI (22) and Garrett Crochet-BOS (22).

EXCLUSIVE COMPANY...was 1 of 6 pitchers in the Majors last season with 175+ strikeouts and 40-or-fewer walks, joining Tarik Skubal-DET, Sonny Gray-STL, Zack Wheeler-PHI, Joe Ryan-MIN, Jacob deGrom-TEX.

WOO TANG FOREVER...recorded back-to-back seasons of a sub-3.00 ERA and a sub-1.00 WHIP (2024-25)...is the only starting pitcher in Mariners history with multiple such seasons.

PART OF HISTORY...Woo (13 K, 1 BB on 9/13/25) and George Kirby (14 K, 0 BB on 9/14/25) are the first pair of teammates in Major League history to record back-to-back starts with 13+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks...was also 1 of 3 starters (also: Luis Castillo and George Kirby) in the 3-game series sweep against the Pirates (7/4-7/6/25) to throw 3 consecutive shutouts, marking the first time in team history recording 3 consecutive shutouts.
