RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude the regular season by opening their final homestand with the first of a three-game series vs. the division-rival Cincinnati Reds as the club honors and celebrates **Adam Wainwright's** career this weekend at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals wrapped up their road slate yesterday by going 2-4 over a six-game trip through San Diego (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-2).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals will finish in last place in the National League Central for the first time in Wild Card Era and first time since finishing 6th in the National League East in 1990 ... St. Louis has spent 143 of 177 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 69-90 record is their lowest at the 159-game mark since 1978 when they were 68-91 (.428) ... St. Louis has recorded its first 90-loss season since going 70-92 in 1990.

COMEBACK CARDS: Since 1913, the Cardinals have lost 90 or more games only five times (1913, 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990), but finished above .500 the year after each of those seasons: 81-72 in 1914; 82-70 in 1917; 83-79 in 1977; 86-76 in 1979; and 84-78 in 1991.

FRESHMAN FINISHES: Rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 20-of-24 games played in September (.292/.360/.472, 26-89), and with four more hits this weekend, would become just the 4th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 30+ hits in Sept./Oct ... The 21-year-old recently became the only Major Leaguer this season with three hitting streaks of 12 games or longer (12, 17, 12), and just the 15th Cardinal overall (5th rookie) with three or more different double-digit hitting streaks in the same season. - *Elias*

RED ALERT: The Cardinals have won 10 of their last 15 over the Reds at Busch Stadium (Sept. 11, 2021-present), however nine of those 15 games have been decided by two runs or fewer ... St. Louis has finished with a .500 record or better vs. the Reds at home in each of the last 16 seasons (2007-22) and beaten Cincinnati at home (94-55 record) more than any opponent at Busch III.

WAINO'S WORLD: Of the 10,343 total players who have made Major League debuts in the Divisional Era (since 1969), 2,398 players have hit 10 or more career home runs, while 36 pitchers have won 200 or more games in that timespan ... The only player to achieve both milestones is **Adam Wainwright** (10 HR and 200 wins). - *Stats Perform*

BOOKEND BOMBERS: Only three players in Major League history have homered in their first and final career regular season game: **Eric Soderholm** (9/3/1971 with Twins and 10/5/1980 with Yankees), **Dave McKay** (8/22/1975 with Twins and 10/3/1982 with A's), and **Will "The Thrill" Clark** (4/08/1986 with Giants and 10/1/2000 with Cardinals) ... 2017 Silver Slugger Award winner **Adam Wainwright**, (and **Willson Contreras**) are members of the exclusive club of players who have homered on the first pitch of their MLB careers (May 24, 2006 at San Francisco off **Noah Lowry**, a game started by **Brad Thompson**). - *Elias*

TGIF?: The Cardinals are the only ones who do not look forward to Friday ... This season, St. Louis is an MLB-worst 4-19 on the final day of the work week (2-8 at home) with home wins vs. Pittsburgh (April 14) and vs. Cincinnati (June 9) ... Since Divisional play began in 1969, the Cardinals previous worst Friday mark was 8-18 (.307) in 1978 ... Relatedly, St. Louis is 16-35 in series openers this season.

DECK OF 52 CARDS: **Irving Lopez** recently became the 52nd different player to appear for the Cardinals in 2023, breaking the franchise single-season record of 51 shared by the 1997, 2021, and 2022 Redbirds ... Only two Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): **Miles Mikolas** and reigning NL MVP **Paul Goldschmidt** ... Prior to his MLB debut, Lopez and **Chase Pinder** were the longest-tenured minor league position players in the Cardinals organizations (both drafted in 2017).

BUSCH STADIUM III SINGLE-SEASON RECORDS: The Cardinals and their opponents have combined to potentially break single-season Busch Stadium III (2006-23) records this season in home runs, extra-base hits, runs scored, and stolen bases. (*chart left*)

CARDINALS MILESTONE WATCH: With three games remaining, the Cardinals can establish a new record for fewest errors committed (64), two fewer than 66 made in the 2019 and 2022 seasons ... St. Louis is also in danger of becoming the final team in MLB history without a pitcher throwing a complete game in a 162-game season (the Cubs, Mariners, and Royals all last season recorded their first campaign in franchise history without a complete game).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 29, 1963): **Stan Musial** goes 2-for-3 in the final game of his Hall of Fame career in a 3-2 win over the Reds in 14 innings at Busch Stadium I ... With those two hits, Musial finishes with 3,630 in his career, with exactly half at home (1,815) and half (1,815) on the road.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiser** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Turner Ward served as hitting coach for Cincinnati during the 2019 season.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97).

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Nick Martini was selected by St. Louis in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons in the Cards organization (2011-17).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over the last two seasons (2022-23).
Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals... his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his eighth start of the season, second straight and 18th career start.
- His last start was a spot start at San Diego last Saturday with Adam Wainwright removed from the rotation. Threw 3.2 innings in a no decision allowing one run on a two-out RBI single by Manny Machado in the 1st inning.
- Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances vs. CIN covering 9.2 innings, all in relief and all prior to 2023.
- Showcases a six-pitch arsenal with over half his pitches (50.3%) arriving as sinkers.
- Opponents have hit his fastball at a .524 clip, 3rd-highest in MLB of pitchers who have thrown 100 or more four-seam fastballs (Evan Justice, .560 & Gavin Stone .533).
- Has received two runs or fewer of support in five of seven starts (1 run or fewer in four starts).
- Tied for the team and MLB lead with a career-high six starts during the month of April with then teammates Jack Flaherty and Jordan Montgomery.
- His six starts in April were a single-season monthly career high.
- Allowed nine of 26 earned runs this season in the 2nd inning (11.57 ERA).
- Limiting the opposition to bat .192 (10-52, 2 HR) with runners in scoring position (.313, 31-99, 4 HR) with no runners on base).
- As a starter, is career 4-5 with 4.42 ERA (77.1 IP/38 ER) in 17 career starts, with the Cardinals going 9-8 in those games. Is 6-1 with a 3.66 ERA (105.2 IP/43 ER) in 62 relief appearances.
- Eight of his 17 career starts have come against NL Central opponents, posting a 3-3 record with a 2.83 ERA. Has not allowed more than three runs in any of those eight starts.

LAST TIME OUT

- Made a spot start and hurled 78 pitches, his most in an MLB game since April 30, completing 3.2 innings allowing one run on four hits in a no decision. Manny Machado hit a two-out RBI single in the 1st inning for the only damage.
- Was his 7th start of the season after making a monthly career-high of six starts in the month of April tied with Jack Flaherty and Jordan Montgomery for the team lead.

CAREER

- Former 1st round selection out of high school made his Major League debut in 2020 in the second game of a doubleheader after the Cardinals returned from a 17-day absence from playing due to a COVID breakout. Has pitched as both a starter and out of the bullpen.
- Switched uniform number from No. 40 to No. 44 prior to the 2023 season to allow Willson Contreras to wear the same number he had since the start of his career with the Chicago Cubs in 2016.
- Finished the 2022 season on an 11.1-inning scoreless streak, winning each of his last four decisions.
- As a starter, is career 4-5 with 4.42 ERA (77.1 IP/38 ER) in 17 career starts, with the Cardinals going 9-8 in those games. Is 6-1 with a 3.66 ERA (105.2 IP/43 ER) in 62 relief appearances.
- Ranked in the Top 15 among MLB pitchers in average of vertical movement on his curveball each of the last three seasons at 14th in 2020 (6.3 inches), 11th in 2021 (7.2 inches) and 10th in 2022 (8.0 inches). - *Baseball Savant*.

- Earned his 1st win of the season, and 3rd career vs. ARI, in a 14-5 win 4/19, as the Cardinals prevented a series sweep by the D-Backs.

- His five consecutive scoreless appearances vs. CIN is the longest active streak by a Cardinals pitcher since Russ Springer ran off 16 from 2007-08 (12.1 IP) to end his career.
