AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: On March 9, the D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated earning a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations, in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' 7-3 road record (.700) since April 8 is the NL's third-best winning pct., behind the Cardinals (.800, 8-2) and Braves (.875, 7-1).

• The D-backs have won 4 of their last 6 series (4 straight between April 7-19) and won/split 7 of their last 8 (6 straight from March 30-April 19).

• **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 25-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is MLB's longest active streak and tied for the second-longest streak since 2022 (3 others), behind Justin Turner's 26-gamer (May 9-June 3, 2022).

• **Nolan Arenado** has reached base 17 times in his last 7 games, hitting .545 (12-for-22)/1.492 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks (2 K).

• In his last 14 games, is hitting .404 (19-for-47)/1.198 OPS with 1 double, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 5 walks (6 K).

• **Jose Fernandez** has an 11-game on-base streak as a starter, hitting .357 (15-for-42)/.876 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks (8 K).

• In his last 17 starts, is hitting .348 (23-for-66)/.816 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 6-2 @ Brewers last night with a season-high-tying 4 homers.

• **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his career-best 25-game hitting streak with a second-inning single.

• **Nolan Arenado** hit a go-ahead 3-run homer (5) in the fourth inning.

• **Adrian Del Castillo** hit a solo homer (2) to get the D-backs on the board in the fourth inning.

• **Ketel Marte** (5) and **Corbin Carroll** (4) extended the lead to 4 with the team's first back-to-back homers this season.

• **Kevin Ginkel** (W, 1.1 IP), **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) combined for (4.1 IP) scoreless innings (H, 0 BB, 6 K).

A BAKER'S DOZEN: The D-backs' 13 comeback victories lead the Majors, ahead of the Braves (11) and Dodgers (11) [source: MLB Research].

• They are a MLB-best 12-6 in games when they allow the first run.

PRODUCING AT THE BOTTOM: Since April 13, the D-backs' 7-9 hitters in the lineup lead MLB in combined AVG (1st, .294), OPS (1st, .888), SLG (1st, .552), RBI (1st, 33), homers (T-1st, 9) and extra-base hits (T-1st, 19).

ROAD SNAKES: **Ildemaro Vargas'** 18-game road hitting streak is MLB's longest active streak and is tied for the franchise record (also: Junior Spivey from May 31-July 18, 2002 and Stephen Drew from Aug. 11-Sept. 17, 2010).

• **Vargas** is batting .338 (24-for-71)/.801 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 3 walks during the span.

• **Adrian Del Castillo** has reached base in 8 straight road games, hitting .300 (9-for-30)/.877 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, RBI and 2 walks.

• **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 10 of his last 12 road games (13 H, 3 BB)/.879 OPS with 5 homers and 8 RBI.

• **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 12 of his last 13 road games (10 H, 11 BB)/.707 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer and 3 RBI.

• **Jose Fernandez** in his last 10 road games, is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

DAY SNAKE BITES: The D-backs' .583 (7-5) day-game win pct. ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Brewers (.667, 8-4), Padres (.667, 8-4) and Dodgers (.600, 6-4).

• **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 10 straight day games at a .366 clip (15-for-41)/.991 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 1 walk.

• **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 10 of his 12 day games, hitting .333 (14-for-42)/1.059 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 7 walks.

• **Adrian Del Castillo** has hit safely in 6 of his 8 day games, batting .333 (9-for-27) with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. BREWERS: The D-backs look to take their fifth straight season series since 2022 (18-12)...are 9-5 in the last 14 games @ Brewers and 7-1 in their last 8 day games overall.

- His 34 strikeouts through his first 5 starts are the fifth most to begin a D-backs tenure behind Randy Johnson (55 from April 5-April 25, 1999), Daniel Hudson (36 from August 1-August 22, 2010), Max Scherzer (36 from May 5-September 14, 2008) and Orlando Hernández (35 from April 5-April 26, 2006)...Zac Gallen's 39 in his first 6 starts ranks fifth most.

LAST START: Did not factor in the 4-1 loss on April 23 vs. White Sox after exiting with a 1-1 tie (1 ER in 5.0 IP, 7 H, 1 BB, 6 K).

VS. BREWERS: Second start, third appearance.

- Made his lone start on July 21, 2023 with the Braves (4 ER in 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 4 K).
- In his last 3 starts vs. NL Central, is 0-2 with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER in 11.2 IP), opponent .171 AVG, 6 walks and 13 strikeouts.
