vs. Relievers

Atlanta plated exactly two runs off of all three Cleveland relievers last night, collecting eight hits, two walks and six total runs off of the Guardians' bullpen.

The Braves are batting .298/.361/.502 off of opponents' relievers this season, and their .864 OPS trails just the Dodgers (.980) in the majors. Atlanta has 103 total bases against the opposing bullpen, and its 43 runs versus these units rank third in the majors. Only Los Angeles-NL (49) and Houston (47) have scored more.

Seven different Braves have an OPS over .800 versus relievers, led by Jorge Mateo's 2.500 mark. Mauricio Dubón (1.364), Drake Baldwin (.982), Ozzie Albies (.925), Matt Olson (.875), Kyle Farmer (.833) and Dominic Smith (.808) are also over .800.

For context, the Braves have hit .241/.315/.401 with a .716 OPS against the opposing starter.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Guardians tonight continue a three-game weekend series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the two teams this season...Cleveland is making just its second ever visit to Truist Park.

A The Braves scored 10 runs over their final three at-bats last night to power a win, 11-5, in the series opener...Atlanta has won five straight games versus Cleveland dating to the 2024 season, tied for the longest active winning streak against the Guardians in baseball.

A The Braves and Guardians have played just 25 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with Atlanta playing to a 16-9 record (.640) all-time versus Cleveland...The two franchises have met twice in the World Series, with the then-Indians beating the Boston Braves in six games in 1948, before Atlanta bested Cleveland in six games in 1995 for the championship.

A Cleveland is making just its fifth-ever trip to the city of Atlanta, and just its second to Truist Park since the stadium opened in 2017...The Guardians dropped two-of-three here back in 2024, and are 6-7 (.462) in the city all time...Cleveland's four games here at Truist Park are the fewest by any visiting team in baseball.

A LH Martín Pérez is set tonight to make the eighth start and 12th total appearance against Cleveland in his career, and enters play 1-3 with a 6.86 ERA (32 ER/42.0 IP) all-time against the club...The 5-foot-10, 210-pound Venezuelan native last faced the Guardians last September at Progressive Field while with the White Sox, and allowed four hits and three runs over 6.2 innings to take the loss.

A LH Parker Messick makes just the 10th start of his major league career tonight, and his first versus Atlanta...The 6-foot-0, 225-pound native of Plant City, FL, has allowed just one earned run over his first 11.0 innings this season, and owns a 2.31 ERA over his first nine career starts...He ended last season rated at Cleveland's No. 14 prospect.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: Atlanta and Cleveland entered play this weekend as the only two teams in baseball who have yet to lose a series this season...The Braves beat the Angels, 8-2, in a rubber game on Wednesday to win that series and keep the streak alive.

A Atlanta has won all three of its three-game sets this year, and split four games in Arizona.

A Cleveland has gone to a rubber game in all three of its own three-game series and won them all, beating Los Angeles-NL, Chicago-NL and Kansas City...The Guardians split four games with the Mariners to open the season.

A The Braves enter play tonight with the second-best winning percentage in baseball (9-5, .643), while the Guardians' 8-6 (.571) record is tied for seventh...The Dodgers, with a 10-3 (.769) mark, are the only team to better the Braves this year.

VERSUS LEFTIES: Atlanta is set tonight to face left-hander Parker Messick from the Guardians...The Braves have seen five left-handed starting pitchers this season, and are a perfect 5-0 in these games...They are the only team in baseball with five victories versus left-handers on the season.

A Dating to the start of the 2019 season, no team in baseball has a better winning percentage versus left-handed starters than Atlanta...The Braves have gone 171-99 (.633) against lefties in that span; the Astros' .624 (201-121) mark ranks second.

GREEN LIGHT: Matt Olson drove a 3-0 pitch in last night's sixth inning out to right field for a home run, and Austin Riley lined a 3-0 pitch one batter later 109.3 mph in to left field...Atlanta is the only team in baseball this season with multiple hits in a 3-0 count, and they came in consecutive plate appearances last night.

A Dating to the 2023 season, the Braves have swung 121 times in 3-0 counts, by far the most in baseball...The club has hit .511/.931/1.311 with a 2.242 OPS in such counts, and lead the majors in hits (23), homers (10), runs (28), RBI (28), extra-base hits (15) and total bases (59).

A Dating to his first full, 162-game season in 2018, Olson has batted .600/.946/1.550 in 147 plate appearances to reach a 3-0 count, and his six homers in such counts are tied for the most in baseball...He is 12-for-20 when swinging 3-0, with seven extra-base hits.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Collected two more hits and an RBI last night, and is currently tied for the major league lead in both homers (5) and RBI (16).

A Since RBI became official in 1920, Baldwin is just the fifth primary catcher to amass five home runs, 16 RBI and 14 runs in his first 14 games...Gabby Harnett (CHC, 1925; HOF), Darren Daulton (PHI, 1994), Mike Piazza (LAD, 1995; HOF) and Dave Nilsson (MIL, 1996) were the others to do so.

IGGY APPROACHING HISTORY: Raisel Iglesias converted his second save of the season on Tuesday night at Los Angeles, and his next save will be his 100th with Atlanta...He has converted 99 of 113 total save opportunities with the club.

A Since Major League Baseball first recognized saves as an official statistic in 1969, just four pitchers in franchise history have recorded at least 100 saves with the club...Craig Kimbrel (186), John Smoltz (154), Gene Garber (141) and Mark Wholers (112) are the only others to do so.

A Iglesias' 255 career saves rank 39th in MLB history and fifth among all active pitchers.

A Since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022, Iglesias is 15-12 with a 2.29 ERA (57 ER/224.1 IP) over 227 total appearances...His ERA in that span is best in the National League among pitchers with at least 200 appearances, and his 87.6% save percentage ranks third.

Today's Game

⚡ Makes his second start as a Brave and 281st career start tonight in Game 2 of a three-game weekend series against Cleveland at Truist Park...It will be his 328th career major league appearance.

⚡ Is 1-3 with a 6.86 ERA (32 ER/42.0 IP) in 11 career appearances, seven starts, against the Guardians...His most recent outing against Cleveland came on September 12, 2025, when he suffered the loss with Chicago (AL) after allowing three runs and four hits over 6.2 innings.

⚡ Has not won a start against the Guardians, going 0-3 with a 7.71 ERA (30 ER/35.0 IP) in seven career starts...His lone career victory against Cleveland came in relief on March 31, 2019 with Minnesota (3.2 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 6 SO).

⚡ The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander has not earned a win since his Chicago (AL) debut on March 31, 2025 vs. Minnesota...Is winless in his last 12 appearances (0-6) dating to April 6, 2025.

⚡ Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a Brave on April 5 at Arizona, walking one without recording a strikeout on 79 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.

⚡ Made his first appearance with Atlanta on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief behind José Suárez...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the Braves' 5-2 loss.

⚡ Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on March 30...Signed a minor league deal with the Braves on January 30.

⚡ Went 0-0 with a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) with 10 strikeouts in four Grapefruit League appearances (one start) this spring...Allowed one earned run over 3.0 innings in his spring debut on February 28 at Baltimore.

⚡ Was limited to 11 appearances (10 starts) with Chicago (AL) in 2025 due to left elbow inflammation and a left shoulder strain, going 1-6 with a 3.54 ERA (22 ER/56.0 IP)...Made one relief appearance with the White Sox upon returning from injury on August 13 before making nine additional starts.

⚡ Earned the win in his White Sox debut on March 31 vs. Minnesota, throwing 6.0 hitless innings with a career-high-tying nine strikeouts...Joined Hideo Nomo (2001 with Boston) as the only pitchers since 1901 to throw 6.0-plus hitless innings with nine-or-more strikeouts in a debut with a new team (STATS).

⚡ Was the 12th pitcher since 1901 to throw 6.0-plus hitless innings in his debut with a new club, and the second in White Sox history, joining Wilson Álvarez (no-hitter) on August 11, 1991 at Baltimore.

⚡ Became the fourth pitcher in White Sox history to strike out nine-or-more batters in his debut with the club, joining Freddy García (nine) on June 30, 2004 at Minnesota, Bump Hadley (10) on April 15, 1932 vs. St. Louis and Bob Weiland (nine) on September 30, 1928 vs. Philadelphia.

⚡ Posted a no-decision in his second start on April 6 at Detroit despite allowing one run on four hits over 6.0 innings...Left with a 3-1 lead before the Tigers rallied for three runs in the ninth.

⚡ Left his start on April 18 at Boston with discomfort in his left elbow after giving up four runs on five hits over 3.0 innings...Was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 19 with left elbow inflammation and transferred to the 60-day injured list on April 21.

⚡ Made one start each at Triple-A Charlotte (August 2) and Double-A Birmingham (August 8) before being reinstated from the injured list on August 13.

⚡ Made his first appearance in nearly four months on August 13 vs. Detroit, allowing one run on three hits with four strikeouts over 3.1 innings in relief.

⚡ Suffered the loss on August 20 at Atlanta despite holding the Braves to one unearned run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings.

⚡ Threw 7.0 scoreless innings on August 26 vs. Kansas City, allowing just one hit with no walks and five strikeouts, but did not factor in the decision...Became the first pitcher in the modern era to throw 7.0-plus scoreless innings with one or no hits allowed, leave with a four-plus run lead and not earn the victory (STATS).

⚡ Made his fifth quality start in a loss on September 12 at Cleveland, allowing three runs on four hits over 6.2 innings, his second-longest start of the season.

⚡ Left his last start on September 17 vs. Baltimore after 3.2 innings with left shoulder soreness...Was placed on the 15-day injured list on September 19 with a left shoulder strain and missed the rest of the season.

- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season...Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- Picked up the 41st multi-inning save of his career, his second as a Brave (also: 9/22/24 at MIA, 2.0 IP), on April 7 at Los Angeles-AL...Despite having just two since 2022, Iglesias' 41 saves of 1.1-plus innings are the most in MLB since he became a primary reliever in 2016.
- Is one save away from 100 with the Braves, which would make him the fourth Braves pitcher to reach the feat... He would become one of 19 pitchers since saves became an official stat in 1969 to record 100-plus saves with multiple teams (also: 106 with CIN) and the fourth active reliever to do so.
- Has not allowed a run in 47 of his last 50 appearances since June 9 of last season...He leads major league relievers with at least 45.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.10, 6 ER/49.0 IP), ranks second in WHIP (0.67) and batting average against (.139) and third in fWAR (1.7) in that span...Is the first Braves pitcher to allow six runs or less across 50 appearances since Craig Kimbrel from June 8, 2013-April 12, 2014.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (227 apps.), Iglesias owns the best ERA (2.29, 57 ER/224.1 IP), WHIP (0.93) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.98, 244 K/49 BB).
- Ranks second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (183), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio, fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.4) and fifth in ERA and saves (99).

- Has thrown his slider 72.2% of the time this season, the most of any pitcher with at least 10 batters faced, and is tied the fourth-best run value (3) on the pitch...Opponents are hitting .083 against it without an extra base hit and are whiffing 40.0% of the time.
- Since his Braves debut on July 31, 2025, Kinley ranks among major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA (2nd, 0.59, 2 ER/30.2 IP), WHIP (2nd, 0.65), opponent's OPS (3rd, .344), and batting average against (4th, .123).
- Is tied with Raisel Iglesias for the fewest runs allowed (2) in a pitcher's first 30 outings with Atlanta in the live-ball era.
- Allowed a run in his third appearance with the Braves, August 5, and then allowed one additional tally over his final 21 games...Strung together a career-high scoreless streak of 19.1 innings between runs.
