RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-2, 1 to play), Kansas City (3 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...Tampa Bay concludes its 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents tonight (6-6 thus far)...tonight's contest bookends seven matchups between the Rays and Red Sox over the last 10 days...starting tomorrow, Tampa Bay will enjoy four off-days gives the part 15 days.

and Red Sox over the last 10 days...starting tomorrow, Tampa Bay will enjoy four off-days over the next 15 days.

Last night's loss ensured Tampa Bay's first series defeat vs. Boston at Tropicana Field since July 22-24, 2019.

Over the last three games, Tampa Bay has scored a total of four runs while batting .154 (14-for-91)...they scored 4+runs in each of their previous eight contests, batting .245 (69-for-282) while averaging 5.3 runs/game.

Tampa Bay has been held to two runs or fewer in three straight games for the second time this season (4G, April 28-May 1).

After drawing multiple walks in 16 straight games from May 1-18 (70BB overall), the Rays have drawn one walk in each of their last three games...Tampa Bay drew one walk or fewer in a season-high four straight games from April 17-20.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win tonight, the Rays would:

Avoid being swept for the second time this season (April 26-28 at CWS)...it would mark their first time being swept at home since July 4-6, 2023 vs. Philadelphia.

Avoid their first sweep at the hands of Boston since Oct. 3-5, 2022 and the first at Tropicana Field since April 19-21, 2019.

Prevent a season-high fourth consecutive loss, which would be their longest skid since July 16-20, 2023 (5G).

Move back above the .500 mark, avoiding their first sub-.500 record since entering play on May 13 (21-22).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR—Josh Lowe is 7-for-14 (.500) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI in his career vs. Boston starter Brayan Bello.

** Isaac Paredes, who is 2-for-5 with 1 HR, 2 RBI and 1 BB career vs. Bello, has reached base safely in 23 of his last 25 games since April 22, slashing .355/.430/.559 (33-for-93) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 14 RBI and 11 BB in that time...he ranks among AL leaders during that stretch in AVG (2nd), OBP (3rd), hits (5th) and OPS (6th, .989)...his 10 multi-hit games since April 28 are tied for second in MLB behind OAK Abraham Toro (12G).

Yandy Diaz is a career .325 (87-for-268) hitter in 74 games vs. Boston, adding 19 2B, 2 3B, 8 HR and 37 RBI...in six games this season, however, he is 5-for-24 (.208) with 1 2B, including 2-for-19 (.105) in his last five games.

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen has turned in an MLB-best 1.92 ERA (65.2IP, 13ER) since May 3...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA through their first 32 games, dropping that mark to 4.29 entering tonight's game.

Riding a 12.0 scoreless inning streak, LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run in 18 straight outings since April 6, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind CLE Emmanuel Clase and PHI Matt Strahm (both 19G)...the 18-game streak is the longest by a Rays pitcher since Kevin Kelly (21G, May 14–July 15, 2023).

RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 12 BF across four scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day II. on May 11 recording 6 SO.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Rays pitching has permitted an MLB-worst 66 HR, with the next closest club being Chicago-AL (65HR)...it marks the most long balls the Rays have allowed through 50 games since 2016 (68HR).

Tampa Bay has allowed 41 HR at Tropicana Field, the most by any team in their home ballpark, with the next closest being San Diego (35)...the Rays 1.44 HR/9.0 IP at home is also the highest mark in MLB, ahead of the Padres (1.35 HR/9.0IP)... the 41 HR are the second most Tampa Bay has allowed through its first 28 home games in club history, trailing the 2000 Devil Rays (49HR).

Rays batters have hit only 41 HR, fourth fewest in the AL, ahead of Chicago-AL (34HR) and Detroit/Toronto (both 39HR).

RUNNING WILD—Tampa Bay pitching has allowed 44 SB, tied for fifth most in MLB behind New York-NL (59SB), San Francisco (50SB), Washington (47SB) and Miami (46SB).

Of the 44 SB, 29 have come against Rays relievers, the second-highest mark in the majors behind New York-NL (31SB)...Jason Adam has allowed 11 SB, the most by any MLB reliever and tied with SF Logan Webb for second most among all pitchers behind BAL Corbin Burnes (13SB).

Rays batters have swiped an AL-best 54 bases and rank fifth in the majors behind Cincinnati (79SB), Washington (77SB), Milwaukee (64SB) and Philadelphia (59SB).

SMALL BALL—Tampa Bay has recorded 66 infield hits, tied with Milwaukee for the MLB lead...Amed Rosario ranks second in the majors with 14 infield hits, while José Caballero (11) and Harold Ramírez (10) are tied for sixth and tied for eighth, respectively.

MAY FLOWERS—Since taking over in 2015, Kevin Cash has guided Tampa Bay to a 139-106 (.567) record in the month of May, the fourth-best May winning. pct in MLB during that stretch behind Houston (156-90/.634), Los Angeles-NL (152-89/.631) and New York-AL (150-91/.622).

<u>UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY</u>—The Rays own a -37 run differential through 50 games, their worst mark since 2007 (-76)...Tampa Bay has suffered eight losses by 6+ runs, tied for third most in MLB behind Chicago-AL and Oakland (both 10G).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays have played in 26 games decided by two runs or fewer, second most in the AL behind New York-AL (27G) and sixth most in the majors... Tampa Bay is 18-8 (.692) in those contests, the second-best winning pct. in the majors behind Philadelphia (14-5/.737).

SOX IN ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Boston complete a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the two clubs met last week in Boston, with Tampa Bay taking three of four...the Red Sox return to Tropicana Field for a three-game series from Sept. 17-19 before the clubs close out the 2024 campaign with a three-game set in Boston from Sept. 27-29.

The Rays are 22-6 vs. the Red Sox at Tropicana Field since June 23, 2021, outscoring Boston, 132-88 (+44), during that stretch...Tampa Bay won a franchise-best 13 straight home games vs. Boston from April 23, 2022–April 13, 2023, tied for the fifth-longest home winning streak by any club vs. Boston since 1901: Minnesota Twins (17G, Aug. 4, 1964–May 7, 1966), Cleveland Indians (16G, June 21, 1920–July 13, 1921), Washington Senators (15G, April 26, 1926–May 30-G2, 1927) and St. Louis Browns (14G, Sept. 12, 1926–G2–June 11, 1928).

TONIGHT'S START—After being reinstated from the 15-day IL (lower left leg contusion) earlier today, Pepiot will make his eighth start of the season tonight, including his sixth at home...will mark his first start since May 5 vs. NYM...in his last four starts prior to the IL placement, he went 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (20.0IP, 5ER) and 0.85 WHIP...tossed three consecutive quality starts from April 18-29.

LAST TIME OUT—Tossed 2.0 frames in an abbreviated start on May 5 vs. NYM, exiting the contest after a 107.5 mph comebacker off the bat of **Starling Marte** struck him in the left leg in the 3rd inning (2.0IP, 3H, 3ER, BB, 3SO, HR)...allowed a two-run homer to **Francisco Lindor** in the opening frame, but struck out the side in order in the 2nd...RHP Manuel Rodríguez relieved him, stranding two of three inherited baserunners. MEET THE EAST—Pepiot will be making his first career start against an AL East opponent this evening...in his career, he is 1-1 with a 3.94 ERA (32.0IP, 14ER) in six outings (4GS) against AL opponents compared to 7-2 with a 2.71 ERA (83.0IP, 25ER) in 18 games (13GS) vs. NL clubs.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Pepiot's 32.7 pct. whiff rate ranks third in the AL behind DET Jack Flaherty (35.9%) and DET Alex Faedo (33.6%) and seventh in the majors...before being limited to 2.0 IP due to injury in his last start, Pepiot's 38 SO were tied with Tyler Glasnow for third most through a Rays pitcher's first six outings with the club, trailing Taj Bradley (42SO) and Charlie Morton (39SO).

TRAFFIC CONTROL—Pepiot has allowed 35 baserunners over 36.2 IP through his first seven outings with Tampa Bay...it marks the fewest baserunners allowed by a Rays pitcher in his first seven starts with the club (min. 35.0IP).

HEAT CHECK—Pepiot's four-seam fastball is one of the most dominant pitches in the majors...opponents are just 4-for-58 (.069) against his four-seamer, and he has recorded 25 of his 38 SO on the pitch...the .069 average is the second-lowest mark on any individual pitch in the majors (min. 35AB ending with pitch)...only CIN Fernando Cruz's split-finger (3-for-44/.067) has produced a lower opp. average.

Pepiot has produced a 40.7 pct. whiff rate on his four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 50 swings), trailing only OAK Mason Miller's four-seamer (50.0%).

The pitch has also generated a 38.0 pct. whiff rate in the strike zone...min. 50 in-zone swings, it signals the fourth-highest mark on any pitch behind Miller's four-seamer (42.0%), DET Tarik Skubal's changeup (40.8%) and TB Shawn Armstrong's four-seamer (38.5%).

HUNG OUT TO DRY—The Rays have been outscored, 33-20 (-13), in Pepiot's starts...they have provided him with only 2.95 runs of support per 9.0 IP, 11th lowest among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP)...he has yet to receive mroe than three runs of support in an outing with the Rays.

In his career as a starter, Pepiot is 6-0 with a 2.56 ERA (56.1IP, 16ER)

when receiving just two or more runs of support (11GS) and 1-3 with a 5.16 ERA (29.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs (6GS)...in the three starts in which he received multiple runs of support this season, Pepiot is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (20.0IP, 5ER)...this, compared to 1-2 with an 5.40 ERA (16.2IP, 10ER) in his other three starts

LOCKED IN—From April 18-29, Pepiot recorded 6.0 IP and yielded three hits or fewer in three consecutive starts, turning in a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, and 0.72 WHIP in those games...became the seventh pitcher in franchise history to turn the trick in three straight starts, joining Tyler Glasnow (2023), Shane McClanahan (4GS, 2022), Rich Hill (2021), Ryan Yarbrough (2019), Chris Archer (2014) and Jeremy Hellickson (2010).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.42 ERA (19.0IP, 3ER) and 0.68 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 6.11 ERA (17.2IP, 12ER) and 1.19 WHIP in all other frames...six of the 15 runs he's allowed have come in the 1st inning.

ROAD DOG—While Pepiot has turned in a 3.21 ERA (14.0IP, 5ER) in his last three home starts, he has been even more impressive on the road... he has won both of his road starts, holding opponents scoreless across a combined 12.0 IP...he has retired 35 of 40 BF across those outings, posting a 0.42 WHIP while striking out 18 against zero walks.
