Thirty Homers

DH Marcell Ozuna drove a solo home run out to left in yesterday's fourth inning for his 30th home run of the season.

He is the third player in baseball this season (Aaron Judge - 37, Shohei Ohtani - 32) to reach the 30-homer mark.

Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, just four other players have hit 30 homers in as few games in a season. Teammate Matt Olson had 35 homers through 103 games last year, Andres Galarraga had 33 in 1998, Andruw Jones totaled 32 in 2005, and Hall-of-Famer Hank Aaron also had 30 in 1966.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Mets today conclude a four-game weekend series with what is the 10th of 13 total games between the teams this season... The two meet for the final time for a three-game set at Truist Park in Atlanta, September 24-26, in the Braves final homestand of the season.

- A* The Braves blanked the Mets yesterday afternoon for their first win of the series, and are just 4-5 in nine total games versus New York this year...New York was the first team to take a series from Atlanta this season, winning two-of-three games at Truist Park in April.
- A* Atlanta went 10-3 in 13 games with New York last season, a .769 winning percentage...Since the Mets were founded in 1962, the best single-season winning percentage the Braves have logged against New York is .778, going 14-4 in 18 games with the Mets in both 1964 and 1966.
- A* The Braves have won 20 of the last 29 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 176-120 (+56) over the stretch.
- A* The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for six consecutive seasons...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 65-43 (.602) against New York overall.

A The Braves won the first series between the clubs at Citi Field this season, two-games-to-one... Atlanta went 5-2 against New York here last season, including a 21-3 victory in the first game of a doubleheader here, August 12.

A LH David Peterson is set to face Atlanta for the first time this season, and for the 11th time in his career...In 10 games, nine starts, versus the Braves all-time, the 6-foot-6, 240-pound left-hander is 3-4 with a 5.12 ERA (26 ER/45.2 IP), including an 0-1 mark with a 7.45 ERA (8 ER/9.2 IP) in two starts last season...Peterson is undefeated in nine starts for the Mets this season, while the Mets are 8-1 in his turns.

WIN: Atlanta hit three home runs and held New York to just four hits in a 4-0 shutout yesterday afternoon... The win snapped a season-long six-game losing streak for the Braves.

- A* The losing run was the longest for Atlanta since also losing six straight, September 25 to September 30, 2017...The Braves' run of consecutive NL East division titles began the next year...Atlanta has not dropped seven straight games since August of 2016.
- A* RH Spencer Schwellenbach fanned a career-best 11 batters and matched his career high with 7.0 innings pitched...He is the first pitcher in franchise history with at least 7.0 scoreless innings and 11 strikeouts within his first 10 career games, and the third Braves rookie ever with 7.0 or more shutout innings, no walks, and 11 or more strikeouts (Also: Bob Sadowski, 9/5/63 and Spencer Strider, 9/1/22).

REYNALDO LÓPEZ: The right-hander today makes the eighth appearance and fourth start of his career against the Mets, and is 2-2 with a 2.66 ERA (6 ER/20.1 IP) over his first seven outings.

- A* In his only such turn this season, April 9 at Truist Park, López fired 6.0 scoreless innings with three hits, three walks and six strikeouts.
- A* López allowed a season-high four runs over 6.0 innings in his last turn, July 22 vs. Cincinnati, and has combined to surrender 18 hits and seven runs over 12.0 innings in his last two starts.
- A* Despite his last two starts, López leads the majors (min. 100.0 IP) with a 2.12 ERA over 18 turns on the season...With at least three innings today, Atlanta's 104th game, he will once again qualify for the ERA title.
- A* Per Baseball Savant, López ranks in the 99th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (23), including the 98th percentile in fastball run value (13) and 99th percentile in breaking run value (13)...His four-seam fastball has a run value of 13, the seventh-most value four-seamer in baseball.
- A* López is allowing opponents to bat just .104/.242/.143 with runners in scoring position on the season, the lowest average in baseball among pitchers to face at least 75 such batters.

MATT OLSON: Followed Ozuna's home run in yesterday's fourth inning with a solo shot of his own, his 14th of the year...The drive was just his second in July and snapped a 14-game homerless draught.

- A* Olson has hit in four straight games, going 6-for-16 (.375) with a walk...His six hits in this span match his total from his previous 15 games, when he went 6-for-55 (.109).
- A* Olson's homer had an exit velocity of 105.4 miles per hour, and 11 of his last 15 balls in play have qualified as "hard hit" (exit velo above 95 mph).

SHUTOUT: Three Atlanta pitchers - RH Spencer Schwellenbach, RH Joe Jiménez & RH Raisel Iglesias - combined to allow just four hits in a shutout of New York yesterday...The Braves fanned 14 batters and did not issue a walk.

- A* The shutout was Atlanta's 12th of the season, tied with Boston for most in the majors...The Braves are on pace for 18 shutouts on the year, which would tie the 2021 club for fourth most in a season in Atlanta-era franchise history...The 1992 club tossed 24 shutouts to set the single-season record.
- A* The Braves rank third in the majors with a 3.48 ERA (354 ER/914.2 IP) on the season, behind just the Mariners (3.36) and Phillies (3.42)...Atlanta's starting staff ranks 10th in baseball with a 3.83 ERA, while Braves relievers lead the NL and rank second in baseball with a 2.89 mark.
- A* Atlanta has yet to lose a game in which it pitches a shutout this season, going a perfect 12-0.

- 🍷 Set to make his 19th start of the season and second against New York (NL) this year.
 - 🍷 Tossed 6.0 scoreless frames in his last start against the Mets in April.
 - 🍷 Allowed a combined seven runs in 12.0 innings pitched over his last two starts.
- 🍷 Making his eighth start on five-days rest...He is 2-2 with a 2.65 ERA in those games.
- 🍷 His 1.88 ERA was the third lowest ERA prior to the All-Star break in Braves franchise history (live ball era) and lowest since Jair Jurrjens went 12-3 with a with a 1.87 ERA in 16 starts in 2011 (min. 15 starts).
- 🍷 His 2.12 ERA is the lowest in baseball (min. 15 starts).
 - 🍷 His 1.74 ERA at home is also the lowest in MLB among qualifiers.
- 🍷 Snapped a streak of consecutive starts with two runs or allowed after 11 games; the longest streak among starters this season.
 - 🍷 His 15 starts of two earned runs or less allowed are tied for the eighth most in the majors this season.
- 🍷 Has made nine starts with at least six days rest between games; the second most in the majors among starters.
 - 🍷 He is 4-1 with a 1.84 ERA in those outings.
- 🍷 Pitching to a .104 opp. BA with RISP this year; the lowest rate in the majors among starters with at least 10 outings.
 - 🍷 Owns a 33.3% LOB rate with RISP; the highest in MLB (min. 10 starts).
- 🍷 Throwing his fastball for an average of 95.4 MPH.
 - 🍷 Has thrown 16 pitches over 98 MPH this season.
 - 🍷 Throwing his four-seam fastball on 57.0% of pitches; fifth highest rate in the majors (min. 15 starts).

2024 Recap

- 🍷 López's 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP) was the lowest by a Brave through 13 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine pitched to a 1.57 ERA and an 9-2 record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are only other starters in the Atlanta era (since 1966) with lower ERAs through 13 starts.
 - 🍷 His combined 13 earned runs allowed were the fewest by any starter in Atlanta franchise history through 13 games.
 - 🍷 His 1.57 ERA is the lowest through a player's first 13 career games as an Atlanta Brave in franchise history.
- 🍷 His 1.73 ERA through his first 10 games with the Braves is the second lowest in Atlanta franchise history among starters' first 10 outings that have joined from another club.
 - 🍷 Shelby Miller owns the lowest ERA, sporting a 1.48 ERA in his fist 10 starts with the team in 2015.
- 🍷 Struck out a season most eight hitters on May 31 against Oakland.
- 🍷 Opened the season with four consecutive quality starts.
 - 🍷 Became the first Braves pitcher to pitch at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts since LHP Sean Newcomb, spanning May 2-19, 2018
 - 🍷 Is the second hurler in franchise history to match the criteria in their first four starts with the club, joining RHP Aaron Harang, who did so in five straight starts to begin his Braves tenure in April 2014
 - 🍷 Joined Ben Sheets (2012) as the only pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to only allow one earned run over 18.0 innings pitched in their first three starts after joining the club.
- 🍷 Since 2000, there have been seven pitchers, league-wide, to log at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts to begin their tenure with a club: Cliff Lee (Philadelphia, July-August, 2009), Harang (Atlanta, April 2015), Cody Anderson (Cleveland, June-July 2015), Kenta Maeda (Los Angeles-NL, April 2016), Mat Latos (Chicago-AL, April 2016), Justin Verlander (Houston, September 2017) and López (Atlanta, April 2024).
- 🍷 Made his first start since June 10, 2022 against Texas on April 2 earlier this season.
- 🍷 Signed by the Atlanta Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

Career Recap

- 🍷 Has played for four teams over an eight-year career...Started his career in the rotation, before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021.
 - 🍷 Made his major league debut on July 19, 2016 with Washington...Suffered a 8-4 loss to Los Angeles after starting the game and going 4.2 innings.
 - 🍷 Acquired by the White Sox on December 7, 2016 in a four-player trade that sent Adam Eaton to Washington...López, RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Lucas Giolito went to Chicago.
 - 🍷 This season marks the first time he will not be in the same organization as RHP Lucas Giolito.

- 🍷 Both were then traded to Los Angeles (AL) on July 26, 2023.
- 🍷 Cleveland then claimed both players off waivers in August of 2023.
- 🍷 Claimed off waivers by Cleveland from Los Angeles (AL) on July 19, 2022.
- 🍷 Traded by Chicago (AL) to Los Angeles (AL) on July 26, 2023 along with Lucas Giolito in exchange for Edgar Quero and Ky Bush.
- 🍷 Traded by Washington to Chicago (AL) along with Lucas Giolito, and Dane Dunning for Adam Eaton.

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49

Saves/Opp: 0/2 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 36/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 16/6

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...He's the only pitcher in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed.**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 58% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 95th percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 33/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/3

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .068 (3-for-44) off him, which is best in Major League Baseball (min. 40 BF with RISP).**
- Just three of Chavez's 17 inherited runners have scored, the sixth-best percentage (17.6%) in the National League (min. 15 IR).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.80) ranks seventh behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63), Mike Remlinger (2.74) and Luis Avilán (2.77).
- By Run Value, Chavez second most valuable cutter (13 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers... Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 16) is the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 52% of his offerings.
- Among the 32 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older (min. 10 games), Chavez owns the best ERA in the National League and second-best in MLB (1.79)...Texas' Kirby Yates (1.21) is the only player ahead of him.
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,020 strikeouts rank sixth.
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.11 ERA (39 ER/166.2 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).

Jimmy Herget • RHP • 6-3 • 170 • 30 yrs

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Yesterday morning was reinstated off the injured list after missing 41 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- At Triple-A, across 16 games and two organizations, has posted a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP)...Has struck out 14 against only two walks (4.67 K/BB).
- On May 2, was acquired from the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for cash considerations.
- At the major league level, has pitched for Cincinnati (2019), Texas (2020-'21) and the Los Angeles Angels (2021-'23).
- Was drafted by Atlanta in the 40th round of the 2012 draft, but did not sign...Signed with Cincinnati in 2015 after being selected in the sixth round.

Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 10/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)... He joined Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Among International League pitchers, his 2.63 ERA ranked fourth at the time of his call-up (min. 40 IP).
- Signed with the Braves organization as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
- Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 MLB draft...Was traded to the Oakland Athletics on August 1, 2016, along with Frankie Montas and Jharel Cotton in exchange for Rich Hill and Josh Reddick...Holmes was released by Oakland on July 28, 2022.

Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #26

Saves/Opp: 22/24 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 39/30 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/0

- Among pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (122 apps.), Iglesias' 1.94 ERA (26 ER/119.2 IP) is the best in Major League Baseball.
