YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers were defeated by the Angels, 6-4, in Tempe.....RF Sal Frelick went 2-for-4 with a run and a triple.....SS Willy Adames (RBI-single), 2B Brice Turang (RBI-single), 3B Oliver Dunn (RBI-double) and C Jeferson Quero (RBI-double) each had run-scoring hits.

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders.....there are 18 non-roster invitees: 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder,

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons..... the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs..... the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020).....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.... his only other Major League managerial experience came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54). replacing Bud Black in June of that season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #58 - LHP ROB ZASTRYZNY

LHP Rob Zastryzny, 32, signed with Milwaukee on Dec. 12 and is a non-roster invitee.....he appeared in 21 games (1 start) with Pittsburgh in 2023 and went 1-0 with a 4.79 ERA.....he also had stints in the majors with Chicago-NL (2016-18), New York-NL (2022) and Los Angeles-AL (2022).....born in Edmonton, he represented Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.....he was selected by the Cubs in the second round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Trevor Megill, 30, went 1-0 with a 3.63 ERA in 31 games (2 starts) during five stints with Milwaukee last season after he was acquired from Minnesota on April 30 in exchange for a player to be named and cash....he struck out 52 batters in just 34.2 innings.

RHP JB Bukauskas, 27, went 5-2 with a 2.92 ERA and 6 saves in 32 relief appearances at Triple-A Nashville last season after he was claimed off waivers by Milwaukee from Seattle on April 18....during four stints with the Brewers, he did not surrender a run over 5 relief appearances (6ip, 4h, 0r, 1bb, 6k).....Bukauskas was on the 15-day injured list twice last season: 5/20-6/11 (cervical strain) and 9/27-end of season (right ring finger tendon injury).

RHP Enoli Paredes, 28, signed with Milwaukee on Nov. 17 and is a non-roster invitee.....Paredes spent last season at Triple-A Sugar Land (Astros) and went 3-4 with a 4.80 ERA and 6 saves in 52 relief appearances.....he held opponents to a .198 batting average with 66 strikeouts in 54.1 innings.....he pitched parts of three seasons (2020-22) with Houston, including the 2020 postseason (3g in ALDS and 4g in ALCS).

LHP Jared Koenig, 30, signed with Milwaukee on Nov. 17 and is a non-roster invitee.....he went 6-4 with a 3.81 ERA and 7 saves in 48 games (1 start) last season at Double-A San Antonio (12g) and Triple-A El Paso (36g, 1gs) in the Padres organization.....his only Major League experience came with Oakland in 2022 (10g, 5gs).....from 2017-19, he pitched in independent leagues.
