THE GIANTS: Face the Diamondbacks for game two of this three game set tonight at Chase Field.

- ▶ The Giants are 7-6 over their past 13 games having won two straight series, and three of their last four series.
- ▶ Giants pitching over their last 13 games has a 2.87 ERA (36r, 113.0ip), the third-best in the Majors since June 14.

BEAT THE HEAT: With last night's loss, the Giants have now dropped each of their first seven games against the Diamondbacks...this marks the first time they have dropped the first seven games in a single season vs. one opponent since the Giants also lost their first seven games vs. the Padres in 2010.

- ▶ It marks the longest winning streak by either team in the series since the Giants won nine games in a row from September 5, 2020-June 17, 2021.
- ▶ The Giants are looking for a win tonight to avoid going 0-8 against a single opponent to start the season since they dropped eight straight to start the year against the Chicago Cubs in 1977 (June 9-August 22, 1977)...the Giants dropped seven of those eight games by two-runs-or-less.
- ▶ SF has been outscored by the Diamondbacks 44-21 (-23) and been out-hit 66-53 (-13) through the first seven games of this season series vs. Arizona.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Landen Roupp has tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two earned runs in each of his last two starts and has combined to post a 3.63 ERA (9er, 22.1ip) over his last four outings.

- ▶ Since May 2, Roupp is 0-6 with a 5.12 ERA (29er, 51.0ip) in 10 starts (SF is 0-10 in those games)...the last time the Giants lost 11 straight games started by a single pitcher was with **Pat Misch** from 2007-2008 (11 starts).
- ▶ He will face the Diamondbacks for the third time this year...over his first two outings he posted a 0-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Roupp has 44 strikeouts on his curveball this year...only Braxton Ashcraft has more (49).
- ▶ Batters are 2-for-18 (.111) with RISP against him in his last four starts.

SUMMER SURGE: IF Bryce Eldridge went 2-for-4 last night and now has a .410 on-base percentage in June...the only Giants' rookie to post a .400+ OBP in a single month in the last 10 years (min. 75 PA) was **Luis Gonzalez** in May of 2022 (.410 OBP) (STATS, LLC).

- ▶ Overall this year, Eldridge ranks among qualified rookies in average (.285, 4th), SLG (.486, 3rd), OPS (.863, 2nd) and OBP (.377, 5th).

THE STARTING LINE: Giants starters have been a bright spot for San Francisco as of late...after a rocky start, SF's rotation has a 3.40 ERA in June that is fifth-best in the Majors behind the Marlins (3.24), Tigers (3.24), Brewers (3.34) and Red Sox (3.34).

- ▶ Since June 14 (13 games), San Francisco starters have posted a 2.39 ERA (20er, 75.1ip), which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors behind only the Brewers (1.98 ERA).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH INCOMING?: RHP Logan Webb fired 7.0 scoreless innings in Saturday's win to lower his June ERA to 0.71 (3er, 38.0ip)...in his five starts this month, he's limited opposing hitters to a .148 clip with a 0.61 WHIP and an opponent's OPS of .370.

- ▶ Webb's 0.71 ERA is the lowest in a calendar month (min. five games started and 35.0 innings pitched) by a Giants starter since **Noah Lowry** logged a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...overall Webb's 0.71 ERA this month is sixth-lowest by a Giants starter since 1913...chart courtesy of *Elias* via Sarah Langs.
- ▶ His 0.71 ERA is the lowest figure in the Majors this month, while his .148 opponents average ranks as the fifth-lowest in MLB.

- ▶ Webb became the first Giants pitcher to have a stretch of five games in which he pitched 38.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs since Matt Cain in 2010...the only other Giants in the last 50 years to do so are Vida Blue and Noah Lowry.

ROUPPER: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

LAST TIME OUT: For the second straight start, he received a no decision despite exiting in line for a win...allowed two runs on six hits and a walk while striking out six over 6.0 innings on June 25 vs. the A's...SF led 6-2 when Roupp exited, but ultimately lost 9-6.

VS. ARIZONA: Will be making his third start vs. the Diamondbacks this season...is 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) with 10 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP in those outings...Ketel Marte is 4-for-10 with a double in his career vs. Roupp while Nolan Arenado is 4-for-9 with three doubles.

MAY DAY: Roupp has struggled since the start of May after finishing April as one of MLB's best pitchers (5-1 with a 2.55 ERA in six starts)...since May 2, Roupp is 0-6 with a 5.12 ERA (29er, 51.0ip) in 10 starts (SF is 0-10 in those games)...the last time the Giants lost 11 straight games started by a single pitcher was with **Pat Misch** from 2007-2008 (11 starts)...when limiting the streak to a single season, Roupp's 10-straight starts with a team loss is the longest for a Giants starter since **Jeff Robinson** had a 10-game streak in 1984.

SO WHAT CHANGED?: The big difference for Roupp are the results vs. his sinker...since May 2, opponents are slashing .338/.420/.606 with 12 extra-base hits (three homers) and a 1.025 OPS in 10 starts...prior to this stretch, opponents were slashing .114/.264/.159 with two extra-base hits (zero homers) and a .423 OPS...in his last two starts, however, opponents are 3-for-15 with one double vs. his sinker.

WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?: Roupp has 95 strikeouts in 86.1 innings this season with his 26.2% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 26.2% strikeout rate is 10th best in the NL among qualified pitchers while his 95 strikeouts are 12th-most in the NL.

WHAT'S THE COUNT?: Roupp's 17.9 pitches per inning is tied for the highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 85.0 innings pitched this season (PHI's Aaron Nola also has 17.9 P/IP)...Roupp's 4.28 pitches per batter faced is also the highest in MLB (min. 85.0ip) ahead of second place, PIT's Paul Skenes (4.16), and teammate **Robbie Ray** (4.09), who is third.

NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED: The righty's 29.1% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in the Majors by a starter (min. 200 batted ball events)...Roupp's 50.9% ground ball rate in 2026 is seventh-highest in MLB (among qualified pitchers).

CALLING CARD: Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, Roupp's curveball has been his best pitch this season in terms of whiff rate (37.2%) and putaway rate (29.3%)...the pitch's +5 run value is tied with his sinker for his best pitch this season.

CLUTCH UP: With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents are batting just .100 (3x30) with a .300 OPS when facing Roupp...the .100 opposing batting average with two outs and RISP is fifth-best in MLB among qualified pitchers while the .300 OPS is third-best.

TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

2026 RECORD: 2-6, 4.94 ERA

- ▶ Will make his 11th start of the season w/SF and second this season against the D-Backs.
- ▶ Pitched better last Saturday vs. Atlanta in SF's 3-1 loss...allowed three runs on seven hits but finished 5.0 innings (he went 5.1 frames) for the first time since June 7.
- ▶ Is 0-6 with a 6.47 ERA (23er, 32.0ip) in his last seven starts dating to May 22...SF is 1-6 in those starts...the Giants were 3-0 in McDonald's first three starts this year.
