NEW YORK METS (85-50) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (49-84) SEPTEMBER 6, 2022 at PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA -- GAME #134/HOME #66 RHP TAIJUAN WALKER (10-3, 3.45 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (4-10, 4.43 ERA)

THE PIRATES:..were rained out for the fourth time this season yesterday...Are 0-3 on their current ninegame, 10-day homestand after being swept by the Blue Jays this past weekend...Went 2-4 on their recently-completed road trip to Philadelphia (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-2)...Are in the final nine games of a stretch that began on August 16 that has the team playing 18 of 24 games at PNC Park

IT'S ALWAYS SUNNY IN PITTSBURGH: Yesterday's rainout against the Mets marked just the third time since the beginning of 2019 that a Pirates home game was postponed due to inclement weather...The only other home games since 2019 to be postponed due to inclement weather came last year on May 28 vs. Colorado and August 13 vs. Milwaukee...It was also the fifth time since PNC Park opened in 2001 that the Bucs and Mets had a game postponed due to inclement weather.

HERE'S THE LINE ON KELLER: Mitch Keller gets the start tonight in the opener of this three-game series against the Mets...Keller struck out a career-high 10 batters while limiting the Brewers to two runs in 6.0 innings in his last start one week ago today at American Family Field.

- Keller has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 13 of his last 16 starts since returning to the starting rotation on May 31 against the Dodgers, posting a 3.69 ERA (85.1ip/35er) during that time.
 - This season, Keller has thrown the most sinkers (458) in MLB without allowing a home run on the
 - He has induced 17 grounded into double plays, tied for the fifth-most in the National League.

STARTERS OF LATE: JT Brubaker allowed two earned runs in 5.1 innings in his start Sunday afternoon against the Blue Jays...In the team's last seven games, Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 2.23 ERA (32.1ip/8er) while surrendering two home runs.

RALPH'S RECOGNITION: Ralph Kiner was one of 19 players inducted into the Pirates' inaugural Hall of Fame class on Saturday...Kiner served as a Mets broadcaster from the team's inaugural season in 1962 until his death prior to the 2014 season...Kiner was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1984....He played for the Pirates from 1946-1953, and is the only player in Major League history to win or share the National League home run title in each of his first seven seasons.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz hit his 12th home run of the season in Sunday's game against the Blue Jays...Since being promoted to the big leagues on June 20, Cruz ranks second among all National League rookies in both total bases (95) and extra base hits (22) while being tied for the most home runs along with Atlanta's Michael Harris II (12).

WELL-ROUNDED REYNOLDS : Bryan Reynolds enters today fifth among
all MLB center fielders with 175 total bases this seasonOnly Seattle's
Julio Rodríguez (222) Brandon Nimmo (205) of the Mets Baltimore's

Cedric Mullins (202) and Mike Trout (202) of the Angels have more total bases.

MEET THE METS: The Mets are the only National League team the Bucs have yet to face this season...Tonight will begin a stretch for the Pirates that has the team playing the Mets seven times in 14 games...This the first

time the Mets are back in Pittsburgh since the Pirates took two of three from July 16-18, 2021.
