RAY REPORT—Today, the Rays complete their 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (1-2), Minnesota (2-1) and Pittsburgh (1-1, 1 to play)...have won four of their last six games and six of their last 11...are 12-12 in their last 24 contests on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...prior to that stretch, Tampa Bay posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...the Rays are 6-9 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Yandy Díaz accounted for the Rays lone extra-base hit yesterday, a two-out RBI double in the 9th inning...the Rays tallied 8 XBH on Thursday at MIN and 6 XBH on Friday at PIT, the first time they had 6+ XBH in back-to-back games since April 11-12, 2023.

Per Elias, Tampa Bay has scored first in eight consecutive games for the first time since May 11-20, 2023 (9G).

Tampa Bay's 14-8 (.636) mark in Interleague play is fourth best in the majors behind Atlanta (21-11/.656), New York-AL (13-7/.650) and Philadelphia (11-6/.647).

The game-time temperature for Friday's series opener was 96 degrees, while yesterday's was recorded at 95 degrees...according to Baseball Reference, it marked the first time the Rays have played in back-to-back games with a game-time temperature of 95 degrees or higher since July 22-23, 2022 at Kansas City (95°, 99°).

Today, Tampa Bay will be opposed by a rookie starting pitcher for the third time in the last four games and 13th time overall, going 6-6 in the previous 12 matchups.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Earn back-to-back series victories on the road for the first time since May 13-19 (3-1 at BOS, 2-1 at TOR).

Improve to 7-4 in rubber games and earn their fourth straight rubber match victory (May 30 vs. OAK, June 13 vs. CHC, June 20 vs. MIN).

LET'S GET IT STARTED—Tampa Bay has lost each of Aaron Civale's last eight starts dating to May 8, with Civale going 0-3 with a 4.76 ERA (39.2IP, 21ER) during that stretch... it marks the longest team losing streak in a pitcher's starts since Matt Andriese (8, May 30, 2017—April 29, 2018)...the last longer streak was Jeremy Hellickson (9, Aug. 12–Sept. 25, 2014)...the Rays eight-game losing skid in starts made by Civale is tied for the longest active streak in the majors, joining the White Sox in Chris Flexen's starts.

In 31 games since May 18, a strech in which Tampa Bay is 13-18, only two wins have been credited to a Rays starter: Ryan Pepiot (June 4 at MIA) and Taj Bradley (June 13 vs. CHC).

Tampa Bay starters have a combined 14 wins on the season, third fewest in the majors, ahead of Colorado and Miami (both 13)...in comparison, Rays relievers have 23 victories, second most in MLB behind Milwaukee (27).

THE YANDY MAN CAN—Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a career-high 24 straight games, batting .290 (29-for-100) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI, 9 BB and 16 SO during the run...it marks the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (27G)...he is the first Ray to reach base safely in 24 straight games since Wander Franco (43G, July 25-Sept. 29, 2021).

Additionally, Díaz owns a career-high 15-game hitting streak, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (19G).

The 15-game run is the longest by a Ray since Manuel Margot (15G, May 1-28, 2022)...the last Tampa Bay batter to hit safely in 16 straight games was Austin Meadows (16G, Sept. 1-18, 2019).

Díaz has driven in a run in four straight games for the first time since Aug. 11-14, 2023 (also 4G)...he last did so in five straight games during a career-high-tying six-game streak from June 12-27, 2019...the current four-game stretch is tied for the longest active run in the AL with OAK Darell Hernaiz, TEX Wyatt Langford and NYY Gleyber Torres.

RANDY'S REVIVAL—Randy Arozarena is batting .293 (17-for-58) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 11 BB, 12 SO, 3 SB and 6 HBP over 19 games in June...his .463 on-base pct. this month ranks sixth in MLB behind CLE Steven Kwan (.515), NYY Juan Soto (.507), NYY Aaron Judge (.494), WSH Jesse Winker (.472) and PHI Bryce Harper (.457).

He has reached base safely in a season-high eight straight games, his longest run since Sept. 6-16, 2023 (10G)...he owns a .514 OBP during that time, reaching base in 18 of 35 plate appearances.

ROAD TRIPPIN\*—The Rays are 11-7 over their last 18 road games after a 7-10 start...their .611 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) is tied with the Red Sox (also 11-7) for second best in the majors behind the Yankees (13-5/.722)...the Rays have played 35 road games, fourth fewest in the majors...they are in the midst of a stretch from June 14–July 7 in which 15 of their 21 games take place on the road.

Yandy Díaz has an 18-game road on-base streak, second longest of his career behind a 19-game run from July 27–Sept. 13 (G1), 2022.

Randy Arozarena has reached base safely in 12 straight road games since June 1, batting .351 (13-for-37) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 6 RBI in those contests.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have allowed an MLB-high 107 HR, with the next closest team being the Blue Jays (102HR)...it marks the second-most homers Tampa Bay has allowed through 77 games in franchise history behind the 2000 Devil Rays (112HR).

The Rays have allowed 1+ HR in a season-high-tying eight straight games (also May 19-28)...they last permitted 1+ HR in nine straight games from Sept. 11-22, 2023 (11G).

Tampa Bay has allowed 1+ HR in eight straight road games for the first time since Sept. 11-26, 2023...the Rays last allowed 1+ HR in nine straight road games from July 22-Aug. 11, 2021 (also 9G).

The Rays have allowed 48 HR in 30 day games, accouting for 44.9 pct. their overall HR total...this, compared to their 59 HR allowed in 47 night games.

IT'S A MARATHON—From innings 1-3, Tampa Bay pitching has posted a 3.43 ERA and .234 opp. average, ranking eighth and 15th, respectively, in MLB...from innings 4-6, the Rays 5.88 ERA is the highest in the majors, ahead of the Diamondbacks (5.18), while their .281 opp. average is second highest (Pirates, .283)...of Tampa Bay's 107 HR allowed this season, an MLB-high 44 HR have come during innings 4-6.

**BUMPS AND BRUISES**—Rays batters have been hit by an MLB-leading nine pitches over their last 10 games since June 12...the Rays 43 HBP overall are tied with the Reds for third most in the majors, trailing only the Guardians (54HBP) and Twins (52HBP).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays 15-7 (.682) record in one-run games leads MLB, ahead of Seattle (17-8/.680)...their 26-12 (.684) mark in games decided by two runs or fewer also pace the majors, ahead of Philadelphia (20-11/.645)...since April 29, they are 17-6 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 7-18 in all other contests...Tampa Bay is 11-5 in its last 16 one-run games.

**SHIVER ME TIMBERS**—Tampa Bay and Pittsburgh complete a three-game season series this afternoon at PNC Park...the Rays have won seven of their last eight games vs. the Pirates since June 24, 2022, outscoring Pittsburgh, 42-21 (+21), during that stretch.

TODAY'S START—Civale will take the ball for his club-leading 16th start of the season, including his eighth on the road...has turned in a 4.38 ERA (24,2IP, 12ER) over his last five starts...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA—has a career-high four-decision losing streak...the Rays have lost each of his last eight starts...has gone 4-8 with a 5.40 ERA (121.2IP, 73ER) in 25 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT**—He held the Twins scoreless through three innings, but ran into trouble in the 4th frame of his shortest start of 2024 in Tampa Bay's 7-6 walk-off loss at Minnesota on June 18 (ND, 3.2IP, 7H, 4ER, 2BB, 5SO)... worked around leadoff doubles in the 1st and 2nd frames, and recorded three straight outs in the 3rd after allowing the first two Twins to reach base (1B, BB)...had one baserunner with two outs in the 4th, but allowed four straight hitters to reach, including a bases-clearing double by **Willi Castro**.

STEEL CITY CIV—Civale is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (18.1IP, 11ER) in three career starts against the Pirates, posting a 1.88 ERA (14.1IP, 3ER) in two road outings...he threw his only career complete game at PNC Park on Aug. 19, 2020 in a 6-1 Cleveland victory (W, 9.0IP, 5H, ER, 6SO)...he held the Pirates to a pair of runs in his most recent outing against them on July 19, 2023 (ND, 5.1IP, 5H, 2ER, BB, 3SO)...that performance was part of a six-start run during July 2023 in which he went 3-0 with a 1.45 ERA (37.1IP, 6ER), the

during July 2023 in which he went 3-0 with a 1.45 ERA (37.11P, 6ER), the lowest ERA in any month of his career (min. 2GS), before being dealt to the Rays in a trade deadline swap on July 31.

Civale has made two Interleague starts this year, allowing a seasonhigh 7 ER across 4.2 innings on May 3 vs. NYM before holding the Cubs to one run across 5.1 innings on June 12...he has a 2.12 ERA (17.0IP, 4ER) and 0.94 WHIP in his last three starts against the NL Central.

ROAD WOES—In seven road starts, Civale owns a 6.75 ERA (33.1IP, 25ER), third highest in MLB (min. 25.0IP) behind SF **Keaton Winn** (9.88) and MIN **Chris Paddack** (7.84)...since May 8, he has turned in a 5.59 ERA (19.1IP, 12ER) in four road starts and a 3.98 ERA (20.1IP, 9ER) in four home outings.

CUT IT OUT—Over his last three starts, opponents are 11-for-23 (.478) against Civale's cutter...he allowed a season-high five hits against the pitch in his last outing, second most of his career behind April 7, 2023 vs. Seattle (7), despite recording a career-high-tying eight swings-and-misses on the cutter (3x, last: June 20, 2023 vs. OAK)...this, after limiting opposing hitters to a 6-for-37 (.162) clip on his cutter in his previous five starts (May 8-31).

In his last three starts, opponents are 12-for-25 (.480) vs. his cutter and four-seam fastball and 5-for-23 (.217) vs. his other four pitches.

**UPS AND DOWNS**—In his last outing, Civale was unable to escape the 4th UPS AND DOWNS—In his last outing, Civale was unable to escape the 4th inning for the first time this season, yielding four runs in the frame...over his previous four starts, Civale had posted a 3.43 ERA (21.0IP, 8ER) while limiting opponents to a 1-for-12 (.083) clip with RISP...this, following a six-start stretch from April 21–May 19 in which he went 0-3 with an 8.48 ERA (28.2IP, 27ER) and .462 (12-for-26) opp. RISP average...in his first four starts to open the season, he went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA.

The Rays have lost each of his last eight starts, the longest team losing streak in a Tampa Bay pitcher's starts since Matt Andriese (8GS, May 30, 2017–April 29, 2018) and tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the majors ...the last longer streak by a Ray belongs to Jeremy Hellickson (9GS) from Aug. 12–Sept. 25, 2014.

CRUISING. THEN BRUISING—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.40 ERA (45.0IP, 12ER) and a .205 (34-for-156) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns an 9.77 ERA (31.1IP, 34ER) with a .355 (50-for-141) opp. average...he has allowed a combined 32 runs (30ER) in the 4th and 5th innings compared to 16 runs (all earned) in all other frames.

He has allowed opponents to slash .307/.391/.495 (31-for-101) with two outs...the .307 two-out opp. average is seventh highest in the AL (min. 75AB)...Zach Eflin (.336) owns the highest mark.

Opponents are batting .222 (28-for-126) against him the first time through the order and .320 (58-for-181) thereafter.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Civale's 14 HR allowed are tied for sixth most in the majors behind TOR José Berríos (17HR), MIN Pablo López (16HR), CIN Andrew Abbott, CLE Logan Allen and CLE Triston McKenzie (all 15HR)... he has yielded at least 1 HR in 12 of his 15 starts and in 18 of his last 22 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023... 22 of the 48 runs (45.8%) he has allowed this season have come on the 14 HR against him.
