RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game, seven-day road trip against the Red Sox (1-0, 3 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Fenway Park...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents, which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)...the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox from May 20-22 to complete the 13-game stretch...

Tampa Bay has been at or within one game of the .500 mark for nine consecutive days.

The Rays plated three runs in the 1st inning of last night's victory, tying their most runs scored in an opening frame this season (3x, last: April 14 vs. SF)...Tampa Bay also conceded three runs in the 1st inning, matching a season high (also April 1 vs. TEX).

SS José Caballero (2-for-4, 2B, R, 2SB) stole his AL-leading 16th and 17th bags of the season, trailing only CIN Elly De La Cruz (25SB) for the MLB lead...he has 8 SB in his last seven games, the most steals by a Ray in a seven-game period since B.J.

Upton (also 8SB) from June 12-19, 2009.

The Rays have won six straight games at Fenway Park dating to June 3, 2023, outscoring Boston 33-15 (+18) during that stretch...it marks Tampa Bay's longest winning streak in Boston since a franchise-best eight-game run from June 9, 2019—Aug. 13, 2020...Tampa Bay has homered in only two of the six games (3HR overall), but has tallied a total of 16 doubles during the winning streak.

The Rays have a five-game winning streak overall against the Red Sox since Sept. 5, 2023...their last streak of 6+ games vs. Boston came from July 5-14, 2022 (6G).

Tampa Bay has recorded 4+ XBH in a season-high three straight games...the Rays last had 4+ XBH in four straight games from Sept. 8-11, 2023 (4G).

The Rays improved to 14-7 (667) in games decided by two runs or fewer, the third-best winning pct. in the majors behind the Philles (12-4, .750) and Orioles (14-6, .700).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to tonight's game, **INF Jonathan Aranda** (right fourth finger fracture) was reinstated from the 10-day IL and **INF Austin Shenton** was optioned to Triple-A Durham.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 12 straight games dating to April 28, slashing .381/.481/.595 (16-for-42) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI and 8 BB while producing a 7.7 pct. SO rate (4SO/52PA)...the 12-game run is tied with José Caballero for the 2nd-longest streak by a Ray this season, trailing Amed Rosario (14G) from April 5-22.

Paredes has 10 multi-hit games since April 17, tied with teammate Yandy Díaz and PHI Alec Bohm for the most in the majors during that period.

YANDY DANDY—Yandy Díaz has hit safely in five straight and nine of his last 10 games since May 3, including six multi-hit efforts, going 17-for-42 (.405) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI...this, following an 0-for-15 skid from April 28-May 1.

Last night, Díaz recorded his 48th 3+ hit game as a Ray, fifth most in franchise history behind Carl Crawford (124G), Evan Longoria (92G), Aubrey Huff (65G) and Ben Zobrist (63G)...his 22 games with 3+ hits since the beginning of 2023 rank fourth in the majors behind SD Luis Arraez/LAD Freddie Freeman (both 25G) and ATI Ronald Acuña Ir (23G)

ATL Ronald Acuña Jr. (23G). In 69 career games against Boston, Díaz is slashing .341/.426/.530 (85-for-249) with 19 2B, 2 3B, 8 HR, 34 RBI and 33 BB against 46 SO...min. 200 AB, his .341 career batting average vs. Boston leads all active players, outpacing HOU Jose Altuve (.321) and TOR Bo Bichette (.315).

WALK IT OUT—Ben Rortvedt has drawn at least one walk in a career-best five straight games, the longest active streak in the majors...he is the first catcher in franchise history to draw a walk in five straight games...three other Tampa Bay catchers (4 instances) have turned the trick in four straight games, the most recent being Derek Norris from May 1-5, 2017...John Jaso (2x) and Dioner Navarro also put together four-game streaks.

With a walk in his next appearance, Rortvedt can tie NYY Austin Wells (6G) for the most consecutive games with walk by a catcher this season.

Tampa Bay has drawn an AL-best 68 walks in 16 games (4.25BB/G) since April 26, trailing only Philadelphia (69BB) in all of MLB.

EXTRA, EXTRA!—Tampa Bay has registered 33 extra-base hits over its last 10 games since May 3 (21 2B, 3 3B, 9HR)...the Rays had 20 extra-base hits (12 2B, 8HR) in their previous 10 games from April 21-May 1.

**Amed Rosario* was responsible for two of the Rays five extra-base hits last night, going 2-for-4 with 1 2B, 1 3B and a season-high 3 RBI...it marked his first multi-extra-base hit game since Sept. 17, 2023 at Seattle...since 2018, Rosario leads the majors in triples (42) and has an MLB-best 11 games with both a double and a triple, ahead of COL Charlie Blackmon and LAD Shohei Ohtani (both 10G).

TWO-OUT TROUBLE—The Rays have allowed 55 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in MLB...18 of Tampa Bay's 55 HR allowed (32.7%) have come with two outs, fourth most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (23HR) and Baltimore/San Diego (both 19HR)... overall, opponents are hitting .257 against the Rays with two outs, the highest mark in the AL and third highest in MLB behind the Rockies (.274) and Giants (.263).

PEN PALS—Over the last 10 games, the Tampa Bay bullpen has posted a 2.08 ERA (39.0IP, 9ER), limited opponents to a .197 average (28-for-142) and allowed only 4 HR.

LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run over his last 14 appearances (11.2IP) since April 6, holding opponents to a .105 (4-for-38) AVG while producing a 44.7 pct. strikeout rate (21SO/47BF).

RHP Phil Maton has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (8.2IP, 1ER) and 0.46 WHIP in his last 10 games since being tagged for a career-high-tying five runs on April 15 vs. LAA.

RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.60 ERA (15.0IP, 1ER) in his last 15 appearances.

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON—Tampa Bay and Boston continue a four-game set tonight at Fenway Park...the two clubs will meet seven times in 10 days, with the Red Sox traveling to St. Petersburg from May 20-22 for a three-game series...Tampa Bay went 11-2 vs. Boston last season, including a 5-1 mark at Fenway Park.

The Rays have collected 10+ hits in five of their last seven games at Fenway since June 3, 2023, tallying a total of 20 doubles during that time.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Yesterday, it was announced that three Tampa Bay farmhands were named Player/Pitcher of the Week in their respective leagues: Bowling Green 1B Xavier Isaac, Charleston RHP Chandler Murphy and FCL Rays OF Brailer Guerrero.

Saac, rated by MLB.com as the No. 47 overall prospect in baseball, went 9-for-17 (.529) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 5 BB and 9 R across six games.

Murphy posted a 1.29 ERA (7.0IP, 1ER) in two appearances (1GS), allowing just one hit and one walk while fanning seven.

Guerrero, rated by MLB.com as the No. 9 prospect in the Rays system, hit .467 (7-for-15) with 2 3B, 1 HR and 7 RBI in the Florida Complex League's opening week.

- On April 13, 2023, the Rays improved to 13-0 with a 9-3 win vs. Boston, tying the 1982 Braves and 1987 Brewers for the longest and 1907 bleeks for the longes season-opening winning streak in the modern era (since 1900) and marking the longest winning streak at any point in a season in franchise history.
- The Boston Braves held Spring Training in St. Petersburg from 1922-37 before departing for

- Rays LHP Jeffrey Springs was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021...Springs, currently rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, grew up a Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching Pedro Martínez and Jason Varitek.
- Tampa Bay **RHP Zack Littell** was claimed off waivers by the Rays from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.
- Red Sox INF **Vaughn Grissom** was born in Orlando, FL and attended Hagerty High School in Oviedo, FL.
- Wade Boggs, who was inducted into Tampa Bay's inaugural Hall of Fame class in 2023, hit .338 with 422 2B, 47 3B and 85 HR in 11 seasons with Boston (1982-92).
- Boston INF Romy Gonzalez was born in Miami, FL and attended American Senior High School in Hialeah before playing collegiately at the University of Miami (2016, 19) (2016-18).

TONIGHT'S START—Civale will take the ball for his ninth start of the season, including his fifth on the road...has gone 0-2 with a 9.82 ERA (18.1IP, 20ER) in his last four starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA...has gone 4-6 with a 5.61 ERA (86.2IP, 54ER) in 18 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT—Permitted only two runs, but was unable to complete 5.0 IP for the fourth consecutive start in the Rays 4-1 home loss to the White Sox on May 8 (L, 4.2IP, 5H, 2ER, 2BB, 4SO, HR)...opened the game with four scoreless innings, retiring his first 10 BF before walking **Gavin Sheets** in the 4th...to open the 5th, allowed a double followed by a tworun homer by **Paul DeJong**...proceeded to record back-to-back outs, but was lifted after yielding consecutive two-out baserunners. A LONG TIME COMING—The sixth-year veteran will make his first career start at Fenway Park this evening...Civale, an East Windsor, CT native, attended Boston's Northeastern University, approximately one mile from Fenway, and grew up a Red Sox fan...he resides in Boston during the offseason...Civale has made three career home starts vs. the Red Sox, going

1-1 with a 4.80 ERA (15.0IP, 8ER), allowing three runs or fewer each time.

Civale has pitched at Fenway Park once in his baseball career, a 2015 matchup with Harvard in a Beanpot college tournament game.

Since being acquired by the Rays, he is 1-2 with a 5.16 ERA (22.2IP,

13ER) in five starts against AL East opponents...Tampa Bay is 2-3 in those games.

ROUGH WATERS—Civale has pitched to a 9.82 ERA (18.1IP, 20ER) over his last four starts since April 21, the highest mark in the AL over that timeframe (min. 15.0IP)...LAA Reid Detmers (8.74) is the next closest pitcher...he yielded 5+ ER in three straight starts for the first time in his career from April 21-May 3.

He has failed to reach the 5.0-inning mark in four consecutive starts for the second time in his career matching his career-long.

starts for the second time in his career, matching his career-long four-start streak from April 11-29, 2022...excluding openers, it marks the longest single-season streak by a Rays starter since **Drew Rasmussen** (4GS) from June 30-Aug. 17, 2021.

In his career, he owns a 4.81 ERA (159,0IP, 85ER) in 28 starts from

March thru April compared to a 3.75 ERA (357.2IP, 149ER) in 66 starts from June 1 on.

CRUISING, THEN BRUISING—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.63 ERA (24.0IP, 7ER) and a .211 (19-for-90) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 10.38 ERA (17.1IP, 20ER) with a .329 (25-for-76) opp. average... he has allowed a combined 17 runs in the 4th and 5th innings compared to eight tallies in all other frames.

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing opponents to slash .316/.391/.544 (18-for-57) with two outs...14 of the 24 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of the 8 HR.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL-Civale's 8 HR allowed are tied for sixth most in the AL, two shy of AL leader CWS Michael Soroka (10HR)...he has yielded at least 1 HR in seven of his eight starts this season and 13 of his last 15 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25–Aug. 16, 2023.

Over half (15) of the 28 runs he has allowed this season have come

on the 8 HR against him.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER—For his career, Civale is 31-1 with a 3.38 ERA (311.2IP, 117ER) in games when he receives three or more runs of support... he has a 2-28 record with a 5.14 ERA (205.0IP, 117ER) in games receiving two or fewer runs of support.
