NATIONALS HISTORY
APRIL 8 (7-7)
 2009 – Ryan Zimmerman's sixth-inning double off Florida's Andrew Miller ignited a 30-game hitting streak, the longest such streak in Nationals' history. Zimmerman's 30-game streak ranks third all-time among DC-based big leaguers, behind only Heinie Manush (1933 Nationals, 33 games) and Sam Rice (1924 Nationals, 31 games).

NATIONALS NEWS

RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD
 The Washington Nationals square off against the St. Louis Cardinals in the rubber match of this three-game series on Wednesday afternoon...The Nationals are 1-1 in rubber games so far this season.

- Following the game, the Nationals will travel to Milwaukee where they will enjoy a day off on Thursday before opening a weekend series against the Milwaukee Brewers.

GOOD WOOD
James Wood has homered in three consecutive games for the first time in his career...Seven of his nine hits this year have gone for extra bases (3 2B, 4 HR).

- Thanks to this recent surge, he is now tied for the National League lead with 11 runs scored, tied for second with four home runs and tied for second with seven extra-base hits.
- Since the start of last season, his 13 home runs against left-handed pitching ranks third among left-handed batters, trailing **Kyle Schwarber** (23) and **Shohei Ohtani** (15).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
 The Nationals have scored 70 runs, the second-most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.), behind the 2019 Nationals who scored 77 runs through the first 12 contests.

- Washington has scored 13 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.

STREAKIN'
CJ Abrams has reached base safely in all 10 games to start the season and has hit safely in eight straight...He is 11-for-32 (.344) with four homers, 12 RBI, six walks, four stolen bases and eight runs scored during the hitting streak.

- The eight-game on-base streak is tied for the longest active streak in Major League Baseball.
- Abrams has improved his walk rate this season...He has a 13.0% BB (6 BB in 46 PA) in 2026, compared to a 5.8% BB (37 BB in 635 PA) in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS
Daylen Lile's 14 hits are tied for fifth-most in the National League...He has hit safely in nine of the first 11 games to start the 2026 season.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .319 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced the National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

OUR HOUSE
Brady House leads the Nationals and is tied for fourth in the National League with five multi-hit games this season.

- House has hit safely in six of nine starts, going 13-for-40 (.325) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, four walks, seven runs scored, a .410 on-base percentage and a .600 slugging percentage in those eight starts.
- He has four walks in 45 plate appearances (8.9% BB) through 11 games...He had eight walks in 274 plate appearances (2.9% BB) in 73 games in 2025.

PAUL TOBONI
Paul Toboni was named President of Baseball Operations on Oct. 1, 2025...Widely regarded as one of the best young executives in baseball, Toboni brings a fresh voice to the organization, providing valuable experience in scouting and player development to build around the Nationals' talented core of young star players.

- Toboni comes to the Nationals from the Boston Red Sox, where he most recently held the title of senior vice president, assistant general manager...In his time with Boston, Toboni oversaw player development at the Major and Minor League levels, as well as the MLB First-Year Player Draft and was one of the key voices in the organization's larger baseball operations strategy.

BLAKE BUTERA
Blake Butera was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

- Is tied for second in Major League Baseball with 132 starts and is fifth with 741.0 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season...Is tied with Dylan Cease and behind only Logan Webb (134) for the most starts in MLB since 2022.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

Mikolas allowed 11 earned runs on 11 hits with four strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work on April 3 at Los Angeles (NL).

Miles Mikolas will face his former club for the first time.

- Mikolas went 68-69 with a 4.16 ERA and 833 strikeouts in 204 regular season games (203 starts) with the Cardinals from 2018-25.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
- Posted a 2.77 ERA in five starts from Aug. 28-Sept. 20 with a record of 1-1...Allowed two or less earned runs in all the five games and struck out 15 batters across 26.0 innings.

- Was Cardinals Opening Day starting pitcher, the second of his career, and 1st since 2019.
