Postseason Recap

CHAMPIONSHIP Saturday, November 16 Salt River 3, Surprise 2

The Rafters defeated the Saguaros, the regular season champion and No. 1 seed, to win their first AFL championship since 2019 and their fourth overall. The Rafters trailed by a run after the first inning, but quickly came back to tie it in the second before taking the lead for good in the third. Neither team scored after the fifth inning and the Rafters held the tying run on second and goahead run on first in the ninth inning to clinch the title.

PLAY-IN SEMIFINAL Friday, November 15 Salt River 13, Scottsdale 4

The Rafters ended the Scorpions' seven-game winning streak en route to a spot in the title game. Salt River scored four runs in the first inning before making an out and never looked back. The No. 3 seeded Rafters scored multiple runs in five separate innings, all nine starters had a hit, and they took a shutout bid into the eighth inning.

AFL History in 2024

Josue Briceño became the first player in AFL history to win the Triple Crown, leading the league with a .433 batting average, 10 home runs and 27 RBI. Only eight other players had led the league in even two of those categories in the same season. Briceño also led the league in hits, extra-base hits, total bases, slugging percentage and OPS.

Caleb Durbin set the AFL's new single-season stolen base record with 29 SB in 30 attempts (the previous record was 24 by Rick Holifield in 1994) and the league's new career stolen base record with 50 SB in 53 attempts. Durbin stole four bases in a game twice to tie a single-game record and he had eight games with multiple steals.

Evan Justice became the first pitcher in AFL history to finish the season without allowing a hit (minimum four innings pitched). Justice pitched 8 2/3 scoreless innings with 11 K, one BB and one HBP. Prior to Justice's dominant season, Dan Runzler in 2010 and Zheng Xu in 2007 were the only two pitchers since 1999 to work at least three innings and finish the season without allowing a hit.
