RAY REPORT—The Rays are 4-3 during a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (1-2), Minnesota (2-1) and Pittsburgh (1-0, 2 to play)...have won four of their last five games and six of their last 10...are 12-11 in their last 23 contests on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...prior to that stretch, Tampa Bay posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...the Rays are 6-8 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Last night, Tampa Bay recorded a season-high 17 hits while scoring a season-high-tying 10 runs (also May 3 vs. NYM)...it marked the Rays most hits since Aug. 19, 2023 at LAA-G2 (19H).

The Rays seven-run win (10-3) was their largest of the season and their largest on the road since an 11-2 (+9) victory on Aug. 29, 2023 at Miami.

Tampa Bay has scored first in seven consecutive games for the first time since Aug. 16-24, 2023 (also 7G).. the last time the Rays scored first in eight straight games was a nine-game streak from May 11-20, 2023 (Elias).

PRETTY EFLIN GOOD—The Rays have won each of Zach Eflin's last six starts, the longest team winning streak in a pitcher's starts since Eflin's own six-start run last season (Aug. 30-Sept. 26)...the last longer streak belongs to Shane McClanahan (8GS, March 30-May 8, 2023)...since the winning streak began on May 7, the Rays are 6-0 in Eflin's starts and 12.21 in all other games. 12-21 in all other games.

THE YANDY MAN CAN—Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a career-high 23 straight games, surpassing streaks of 22 games from April 27–May 28, 2023 and July 24–Aug. 16, 2020...during the current 23-game run, he is batting .295 (28-for-95) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 9 RBI, 9 BB and 15 SO...it marks the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (27G).

Additionally, Díaz owns a career-high-tying 14-game hitting streak (also May 3-21, 2023), tied with Henderson and HOU Mauricio Dubón for the second-longest active run in the majors behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (18G).

The 14-game run is tied with Amed Rosario (April 4-22) for the longest hitting streak by a Tampa Bay batter this season...the last Ray to hit safely in 15 straight games was Manuel Margot (15G, May 1-28, 2022).

RANDY'S REVIVAL—Randy Arozarena is batting .309 (17-for-55) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 10 BB, 10 SO, 3 SB and 6 HBP over 18 games in June...his .465 on-base pct. this month ranks fifth in MLB behind CLE Steven Kwan (.516), NYY Aaron Judge (.500), NYY Juan Soto (.486) and WSH Jesse Winker (.471).

He has hit safely in a season-high seven straight games, his longest streak since Aug. 26-Sept. 3, 2023 (also 7G)...he last hit safely in eight straight from Aug. 6-14, 2023 (8G). He has recorded an extra-base hit in a season-high four straight games...he last did so in five straight during a career-best six-game streak from Aug. 2-13, 2021.

During the seven-game hitting streak, he has reached base safely in 17 of 31 PA (.548 OBP)...Arozarena has produced a 14.1 pct. strikeout rate this month—he entered June at 28.7 pct.

SCORCHING SIRI—Jose Siri is hitting .296/.351/.648 (21-for-71) with 7 2B, 6 HR and 12 RBI in 20 games since May 29, ranking among AL leaders over that span in doubles (T3rd), slugging pct. (6th) and HR (T6th)...he has eight multi-hit efforts during the 20-game run after entering that stretch with three multi-hit performances in his first 43 games.

Last night, he tallied a season-high three hits while scoring a career-high-tying three runs (4x, last: Aug. 30, 2022 at MIA)...he reached base safely four times , also matching a career high (also Sept. 13, 2021 at TEX).

RUMBLING RAYS—Amed Rosario is batting .400 (16-for-40) in June, second in the AL (min. 35AB) behind CLE Steven Kwan (.444)... with a season average of .301, Rosario is one of eight AL hitters with 200+ at-bats batting .300 or better.

Ben Rortvedt is 10-for-29 (.345) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI over his last nine games since June 9...he has 2 HR in his last four games after having none in his first 51 games...his three hits last night matched a career high (also April 27, 2024 at CWS), while his two extra-base hits (2B, HR) set a career high.

ALL-AROUND EFFORT—Seven of Tampa Bay's 17 hits last night came from the 7-9 spots in the order thanks to **Jose Siri** (3-for-4, 2B, BB, 3R), **Ben Rortvedt** (3-for-5, 2B, HR, 3RBI, 2R) and **Taylor Walls** (1-for-4, RBI, R)...it marked the first time the Rays received 7+ hits from their 7-9 hole hitters since Aug. 13, 2020 at BOS (7H, Margot/Tsutsugo/Zunino).

ROAD TRIPPIN'—The Rays are 11-6 over their last 17 road games after a 7-10 start...their .647 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) is second best in the majors behind the Yankees (13-5/.722)...the Rays have played 34 road games, tied for second fewest in the majors, ahead of only the Mets (33G)...they are in the midst of a stretch from June 14–July 7 in which 15 of their 21 games take place on the road.

Isaac Paredes has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 road games since May 18, batting .315 (17-for-54) with 5 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI during that stretch.

Yandy Díaz has a 17-game road on-base streak, tied for the second-longest streak of his career behind a 19-game run from July 27-Sept. 13 (G1), 2022.

Randy Arozarena has hit safely in 11 straight road games, the second-longest streak of his career (12G, Aug. 19-G2-Sept. 16, 2023).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays 15-6 (.714) record in one-run games leads MLB, ahead of Seattle (17-8/.680)...their 26-11 (.703) mark in games decided by two runs or fewer also pace the majors, ahead of Philadelphia (20-10/.667)...since April 29, they are 17-5 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 7-18 in all other contests...Tampa Bay is 11-4 in its last 15 one-run games.

SHIVER ME TIMBERS—Tampa Bay and Pittsburgh continue a three-game set this afternoon at PNC Park...the Rays have won seven straight games against the Pirates, having earned series sweeps over Pittsburgh at Tropicana Field from June 24-26, 2022 and May 2-4, 2023...they have outscored the Pirates, 39-17 (+22), during the streak.

This marks Tampa Bay's fourth series in franchise history at PNC Park (June 10-12, 2005; June 27-29, 2008; June 27-29, 2017).

The two franchises have met only 22 times, with the Rays leading the all-time series, 13-9.

TODAY'S START-Eflin will take the mound for his 14th start of the season, including his ninth on the road...marks his fourth start since his May 20-June 5 stint on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation), posting a 4.11 ERA (15.1IP, 7ER) in the previous three...marks his fourth straight start against an NL opponent...is seeking his first win since May 13 at Boston... is five strikeouts shy of 800 for his career...has taken a no-decision in four straight outings, but the Rays have won each of his last six starts

LAST TIME OUT-Collected a season-high 7 SO and fell one out shy of a quality start for the second straight outing, but did not factor into the decision of an 8-6 Rays win at Atlanta on June 16 (5.2IP, 7H, 4R, 3ER, BB, 7SO, 2HR)...allowed a **Jarred Kelenic** leadoff homer and a **Travis d'Arnaud** solo shot in the 2nd frame...struck out the side in order in the 5th, but permitted four straight two-out hits in the 6th to conclude the outing.

PIRATE PROFILE—Eflin is 2-1 with a 1.35 ERA (20.0IP, 3ER) and 0.55 WHIP in three career starts opposite Pittsburgh, two of which were scoreless... min. 1 GS, it marks his lowest WHIP and second-lowest ERA against any opponent, trailing only the Twins (0.66)...last season, he worked 7.0 shutout innings vs. the Pirates on May 4 at Tropicana Field (7.0IP, 3H, 0R, 10SO)—in that start, he became the fifth Ray to permit three hits or fewer across 7.0+ scoreless, walk-less frames, first since Blake Snell on Oct. 1, 2017 vs. Baltimore...Eflin tossed his second of five career complete games on July 22, 2016 at PNC Park (9.0IP, 6H, ER, 6SO, HR).

Since joining the Rays in 2023, Eflin is 3-4 with a 3.24 ERA (83.1IP, 30ER) and 0.89 WHIP in 14 Interleague starts...this includes a 2.82 ERA (38.1IP, 12ER) and 0.78 WHIP in six starts vs. the NL Central.

EF-WINS—The Rays have won each of Eflin's last six starts, the longest team winning streak in a pitcher's starts since Eflin's own six-start run last season (Aug. 30–Sept. 26)...the last longer streak belongs to Shane McClanahan (8GS, March 30–May 8, 2023)...it ties three others (BAL Corbin Burnes, BOS Tanner Houck, ATL Spencer Strider) for the longest active streak in the majors...Tampa Bay has outscored its opponents, 33-19 (+14), during the streak...they have scored 5+ runs in all six outings, the longest such streak in a Tampa Bay hurler's starts since Drew Rasmussen (6GS) from May 3-30, 2022...excluding openers, the last time the Rays plated 5+ runs in seven consecutive starts by a pitcher was from April 22–May 23, 2009 in Jeff Niemann's outings.

Since the winning streak began on May 7, the Rays are 6-0 in Eflin's starts and 12-21 in all other games.

SO CLOSE, BUT SO FAR—Over his last two starts, opponents are hitting 172 (5-for-29) against Eflin with one or zero outs and and .474 (9-for-19) with two outs...on the season, opposing hitters are 38-for-110 (.345) against him with two outs, the second-highest mark in MLB (min. 100AB) behind WSH Patrick Corbin (.350), and 44-for-193 (.228) with one or zero outs.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING—Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 47 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors and tied for eighth longest in the majors since at least 1901...since 2005, only MIN Phil Hughes (64GS, 2014-16) has strung together a longer streak...of the 46 starts, 44 have come with the Rays, surpassing Andy Sonnanstine (42GS, Aug. 5, 2007–Sept. 21, 2008) for the longest streak in franchise history.

From April 26–June 16, he did not issue a walk to 165 consecutive batters spanning 39.1 IP—both streaks are the longest in franchise history (prev. Corey Kluber, 150BF; Kluber/David Price, 35.1IP)...the streak was halted when ATL Matt Olson drew a five-pitch walk to lead off the 4th inning of Eflin's June 16 outing.

The 39.1 IP walk-less streak was the longest in the majors since SF Ross Stripling (42.0IP) from July 2-Aug. 16, 2023, per Elias.

QUALITY CONTROL—Min. 50.0 IP. Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (1.6%), walks per 9.0 IP (0.61) and SO/BB ratio (11.40)...he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 (min. 1,750BF) at 3.7 pct., ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%)...Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 37 of his 44 starts since the beginning of 2023—only Kirby (41) has more starts.

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.95 ERA (64.0IP, 21ER), .228 (56-for-246) opp. average and .601 opp. OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns an 11.32 ERA (10.1IP, 13ER), .456 (26-for-57) opp. average and 1.264 opp. OPS...he has a .212 (48-for-226) opp. average the first two times through the order and .442 (34-for-77) the third time through and beyond.
