TODAY'S GAME: The Giants host the Colorado Rockies in game two of this three-game series after SF snapped Colorado's seven-game winning streak last night.

- ▶ After yesterday's win, SF can clinch its third out of its last four series today.
- ▶ At Oracle Park, the Giants have gone 4-2-1 in their seven completed series this season.
- ▶ A win today would also give SF its first three-game winning streak of the season...the Giants are the lone team in MLB to not have a win streak of three or more games this season.

ROX ON: Beginning with the 2021 season, the Giants have gone 41-14 (.745) against the Rockies, including a 21-5 (.808) record here at Oracle Park...SF has won each of its last six games vs. Colorado here in the Bay and nine of its last 10... SF has outscored COL by a 143-76 (+67) margin during this 26-game stretch of home games, dating to 2021.

- ▶ The Giants have a 14-4 series record against COL since 2021, the highest series winning percentage by SF against any opponent over that span (min. three series) per *Stats, LLC*.
- ▶ SF also has eight sweeps against the Rockies since 2021, the most by any team against a single opponent over that span.

TURNING THE TIDE?: Yesterday's game was the second this season in which the Giants scored double digit runs (other: 11 runs on April 13, 2024 at Tampa Bay).

- ▶ SF entered yesterday ranking 29th in MLB since April 24 with 3.20 runs/game...after yesterday's offensive outburst, the Giants rank 25th with 3.52 runs/game.
- ▶ The Giants are now 13-0 when scoring five or more runs... they are the only team in the Majors with an undefeated record when scoring five or more runs.
- ▶ SF recorded six hits with two strikes, which is tied for their most in a game this season (also: April 9 vs. Washington and April 15 at Miami).

MATOS MANIA: OF Luis Matos plated a career-high five runs yesterday and extended his RBI streak to five straight games.

- ▶ His five-game RBI streak is the longest by a Giant since **OF Michael Conforto** had a five-game streak July 14-18, 2023... the last Giant with a six-game streak was **Evan Longoria** from May 27-June 4, 2021.
- ▶ Matos' 11 RBI are tied with **Barry Bonds** (2002) and **Willie Mays** (1971) for most RBI by a Giant in his first five games of a season with at least one PA...only **Ernie Lombardi** (13, 1945) and **George Kelly** (12, 1921) have more.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Giants have an extra-base hit in 16-straight games entering today (dates back to May 1), tied with PIT for the longest active streak by an NL team.

- ▶ SF's season-long streak is 17 games, done so April 10-28.

YAZ KING: OF Mike Yastrzemski has a three-game multi-hit streak, going 6-for-12 with two doubles and a homer.

- ▶ The Giants are 62-16 (.795) in Yastrzemski's career when he has two or more RBI in a game (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ At Oracle Park this season, Yastrzemski is slashing .305/.359/.492, compared to his .146/.226/.271 slash line on the road with a .354 OPS discrepancy (.851-.497).
- ▶ Yastrzemski has a .274/.356/.517 slash line in 67 career games vs. Colorado with 11 home runs and 40 RBI...his 40 RBI and 20 doubles are his most against any team.

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. has reached base in 17 consecutive games entering play today and has a .470 OBP in that span...the 17-game on-base streak is the third-longest active streak in MLB behind MIL's William Contreras (24 games) and SD's Luis Arraez (22 games).

- ▶ Wade's 17-game on-base streak is the second-longest of his career behind his 19-game streak (April 20-May 13, 2023).
- ▶ He has 16 walks this month, most in MLB...the last Giant with 16+ walks in a month was also Wade (17 in June, 2023).
- ▶ On the season, his .464 on-base percentage and 21.4% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 100 PA).

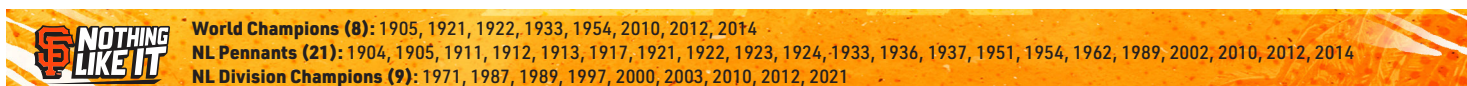
This Date in Giants History

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season today in the first game of this three-game series against the Rockies...Harrison is 3-1 with a 3.42 ERA (19er, 50.0ip) in his nine starts this season... **the Giants are 7-2 in his starts this season, having won each of his last six.**

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched Sunday vs. Cincinnati and did not factor into the decision after issuing a season-high five walks while allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings of SF's 6-5 victory...threw a career-high 98 pitches...had a rough three-run 1st inning in which he loaded the bases and surrendered a costly double to Jeimer Candelario.

▶ "I just came out flat today," Harrison told media following the start..."I hate to put the boys behind early, but they came out and had my back...it was awesome...it's resilience...that's Giants baseball as long as I can remember...just trying to keep the team in the ballgame and the bats came around."

NO FREE PASSES: After allowing just five walks over his first six starts and 33.0 innings, he's issued 12 in his last three starts and 17.0 innings pitched...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues... opposing hitters are 20-for-73 (.274) with three homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball... they're 26-for-115 (.226) in at-bats ending with the four-seam... last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 64.4% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (CHC's Justin Steele, 67.9%).

VS. COLORADO: Has faced Colorado twice in his career, most recently on May 7 at Coors Field, a game in which he shut out the Rockies for 7.0 innings while allowing just four hits and two walks in a 5-0 Giants win.

MORE FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 41 strikeouts vs. 144 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 39 strikeouts out of 212 batters faced.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A... Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 5/14 vs. LAD; 2.0ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, 3k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A on Monday.
- ▶ Has allowed at least one run in six of his seven appearances at the Major League level this season.
- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: 5/15 vs. LAD; S, 1.0ip, h, bb, 2k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 3.18 ERA and 7-for-7 in save chances in 17 games.
- ▶ Has struck out 23 batters over 17.0 innings of work (12.2 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 14 of his 23 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are 4-for-30 (.133) off him...lefties are 8-for-32 (.250).
- ▶ Has gone 7-for-7 in save chances this year and owns a 1.29 ERA (1er, 7.0ip) with five hits allowed, two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ In 10 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip), seven hits allowed (two homers), 10 walks and 13 strikeouts.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 5/17 vs. COL; W, 2.0ip, 3h, k (30 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last eight games, Hjelle has a 1.59 ERA (2er, 11.1ip) with 12 hits allowed, no walks and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Worked 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out 10 over two appearances in SF's series in Philadelphia (May 3-5)...the last time a Giants reliever had 10+ strikeouts in any series (since 1969) was **RHP Tom Griffin** from Aug. 14-17, 1980 vs. ATL.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Seven of his 10 outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ The 6'11 right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 5/17 vs. COL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
