<b>THE TWINS:</b> After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Washington and 1-2 vs. Boston), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss to the Guardians last nighttoday, they will play the second of three in Cleveland through tomorrow afternoon after tomorrow's game, they will travel to Detroit to play the Tigers from Monday-Wednesday.
TWINS ENTER AUGUST WITH AN L: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night in 10 innings by a score of 3-2, suffering their eighth walk-off defeat of the seasonJoe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeoutsthe offense recorded six hits, including a career-high three from Austin Martin, who was making his 2025 Twins debutboth runs scored on a throwing error in the seventh inning from Hunter Gaddis.

OBERTIME: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Ober, who was placed on the 15-day IL on July 2 with left hip impingement, made two starts on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, posting a 1.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 1 ER), with six hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts... prior to being placed on the IL, Ober made 17 starts for the Twins, going 4-6, 5.28 ERA (92.0 IP, 54 ER), 21 home runs allowed, 22 walks and 74 strikeouts...Ober takes the 26th spot on the roster which was vacated after the trade deadline moves made earlier in the week. 
◆ In his final five starts prior to landing on the IL (from June 6-28), Ober went 0-5, 9.00 ERA (30.0 IP, 30 ER) with 38 hits allowed, 14 home runs allowed, eight walks and 24 strikeouts.

GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the eighth of 13 games in 2025... Twins have gone 2-5 this season, going 1-1 at Target Field and 1-4 at Progressive Field.

◆ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 73 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

◆ Royce Lewis is hitting 333 (9-for-27) with one home run, four walks, six RBI, a .419 on-base percentage and an .864 OPS in eight career games at Progressive Field.

◆ Matt Wallner is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with two home runs, six RBI and an .887 OPS in 12 career games at CLE; he made his MLB debut in this ballpark in September 2022.

◆ Austin Martin is hitting .500 (5-for-10) in five career games against the Guardians.

ROYCE ROLLS: Since the All-Star break, Royce Lewis is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .609 slugging percentage and a .963 OPS in 12 games played...below are his season comparisons in a few categories:

**TOP JEFF:** Over his last 16 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .370 (20-for-54) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, a .414 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .914 OPS...in those 16, he has reached safely in 12.

AL-LOW ME TO INTRODUCE MYSELF: Alan Roden, 25, was acquired on Thursday from the Blue Jays along with minor league left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas, in exchange for Ty France and Louis Varland...prior to the trade, he spent most of the season at Triple-A Buffalo, hitting. 331 (40-for-121) with nine doubles, one triple, three home runs, 18 RBI, 25 runs scored, 16 walks, a .423 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and a .918 OPS in 32 games...he made his major league debut on Opening Day for Toronto and played 43 games for the Blue Jays this season...the Middleton, Wisconsin native was selected by the Blue Jays in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Creighton University.

The season at Triple-A Buffalo, hitting. 331 (40-for-121) with nine doubles, one triple, three home runs, 18 RBI, 25 runs scored, 16 walks, a .423 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and a .918 OPS in 32 games for the Blue Jays in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Creighton University.

Last night marked Roden's 44th game at the big league level...all 43 previous games came with Toronto.

**AUSTIN POWER:** Dating back to August 19, 2024, Austin Martin is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with seven doubles, five RBI, four walks, a .362 on-base percentage and a .784 OPS in 22 games for the Twins...he has multiple hits in three of his last four major league games.

SERIES STUFF: The Twins need a win today and tomorrow to earn their 15th series victory this season and their first since taking two of three from Pittsburgh at Target Field from July 11-13, leading into the All-Star break...Minnesota is 14-19-2 in series play, going 9-7-2 at home and 5-12-0 on the road.

◆ Twins have lost each of their last three series at Progressive Field, dating back to May of 2024.

◆ Minnesota's last series win over the Guardians came September 4-6, 2023 in Cleveland... they are 0-3-2 in series play vs. the Guards since then.

TIM WILL TELL: The Twins welcome Double-A Wichita broadcaster Tim Grubbs, who is calling games on the Treasure Island Baseball Network during this roadtrip...Grubbs, who has been the voice of the Wind Surge since the franchise's inception, called his 4000th career minor league baseball game on April 25...2025 marks his 30th season with affiliated ball as he began his career with the Hickory Crawdads in 1995, broadcasting games that featured Hall of Famers Todd Helton and Vladimir Guerrero...he joined Winston-Salem from 1996-98, then on to Knoxville from 1999-2001 and was named Southern League Broadcaster of the Year in 2001...in 2002, Grubbs joined the New Orleans Zephyrs, where he called games for 18 seasons, until the franchise's relocation to Wichita after the 2019 season.

**ON THIS DAY IN FRANCHISE HISTORY:** In **1907**, Senators rookie Walter Johnson made his major league debut, losing to the Tigers, 3-2...Ty Cobb got the first hit off of the future Hall of Famer with a bunt single...in **1925**, Walter Johnson, who had been ailing with the flu, recovered to give the Senators a 5-1 win over the Tigers on the 18th anniversary of his first appearance, also against the Tigers. give the Senators a 5-1 also against the Tigers.

REHABBING ACROSS THE RIVER: Made two rehab starts with Triple-A St. Paul...on July 18, faced the Louisville Bats, opposite Chase Petty, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 3-1 victory... allowed four hits with three strikeouts in 4.0 scoreless innings...on July 25, faced the Worcester Red Sox, but did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 3-5 defeat...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

# July 18 was his first appearance in Triple-A since September 9, 2023.

LAST MAJOR LEAGUE START: Last pitched in the majors on June 28 at Detroit, opposite Casey Mize, taking the loss in Minnesota's 5-10 defeat...allowed seven runs on a career-high-tying 11 hits (career-high-tying 4 HR), one walk and a five strikeouts in 5.2 innings...permitted a sacrifice fly to Matt Vierling in the second, a solo homer to Kerry Carpenter in the third, a sac fly to Colt Keith followed directly by a two-run shot to Gleyber Torres in the fourth, a homer to Riley Greene to start the fifth and a homer to Zach McKinstry in the sixth before being replaced by reliever Joey Wentz.

© Ober was dealt his sixth loss of the season, and fifth consecutive loss; is the second time in his career he has had a five game loss-streak (also, 8/26/24-3/30/25)...is the first time in his career he has been dealt five consecutive losses...Ober now holds the longest active losing streak in the majors among starting pitchers.

© Has allowed a home run in six-consecutive starts, his longest such streak in a single season since July 18-September 20, 2023 when he allowed a homer in 10-straight games.

© 11 hits allowed to Detroit matched his career high, most recently done also at Detroit on August 9, 2023.

© Surpassed 500 career hits allowed, and 100 hits allowed so far in 2025.

JUNE GLOOM: Bailey allowed 14 home runs in the month of June; tied the most homers allowed by a pitcher in Twins history (1961-) (also 14, Bert Blyleven, May 1986)...Blyleven did so in six games and 43.2 innings, whereas Ober did so in five games and 30.0 innings...also the second most home runs allowed in a single month in American League/National League history, behind only Washington Senators pitcher Pedro Ramos, who allowed 17 in June 1957.

The Marked the first time a Twins pitcher has recorded five losses in a single month since Kevin Slowey went 0-5 in five starts in September 2011, part of an eight-game losing streak.

Recorded the highest ERA in a single month by any MLB pitcher since Aaron Sele had a 9.30 ERA (0-6) in July 2005.

GUARDING CLEVELAND: Ober is 3-2 in 10 career starts against Cleveland, posting a 2.10 ERA (55.2 IP, 13 ER) with five walks, 51 strikeouts and a .215 (44-for-205) opponent batting average.

◆ Has faced the Guards twice so far in 2025, going 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP, 2 ER), no walks and 5 strikeouts in 10.2 total innings of work.

◆ Last played Cleveland on the road on April 28 where he earned his third consecutive win in Minnesota's 11-1 victory...allowed one run on eight hits, with no walks and two strikeouts in 7.2 innings...recorded a career-high 10 groundouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-12 with a 4.11 ERA (282.1 IP, 129 ER), 9.05 W/9, 2.23 BB/9 and 1.72 HR/9 in 54 games (53 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.04 ERA (285.1 IP, 128 ER), 8.77 W/9, 1.73 BB/9 and 1.39 HR/9 in 53 road starts.

© Ober is 2-3, 5.74 ERA (42.1 IP, 27 ER) with 10 walks and 32 strikeouts in eight road starts this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 17 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .285/.317/.497 in 193 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .293/.345/.541 in 181 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.3 mph and a whiff rate of 21.1 compared to righties' 92.2 mph and 27.5 percent.

◆ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its lowest since 2022, 29.0 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 54.9 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 38.2% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
