THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 4
1975 - Astros great **1B Bob Watson** makes history, as he scores the 1,000,000th run in Major League history in Game 1 of an Astros doubleheader in San Francisco... he crosses the plate at approx. 12:32 p.m. in the afternoon, scoring from second base on a three-run homer by **C Milt May**...the Astros lose the opener, 8-6.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight as they welcome in the rival Dodgers for the first game of a three-game series...veteran reliever **LHP Steven Okert** will get the start for the Astros as an opener tonight opposite the Dodgers **RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto**.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **LHP Steven Okert**, a nine-year MLB veteran, will be making his fifth Major League start as an opener and his second as an Astro (also, Aug. 5, 2025 at MIA)...the often-used lefty reliever had made 17 relief appearances in 2026, which ranks tied for fourth in the AL.

VS. THE DODGERS: The Astros and Dodgers will forever be connected by the 2017 World Series, which was won by Houston in a thrilling seven games...since that 2017 season began, the Astros and Dodgers have been the two top clubs in baseball, in terms of regular season wins and playoff wins...since the 2017 World Series, the Astros are 11-9 against the Dodgers in the regular season and have won six of the last seven games...in their last meeting, the Astros swept the Dodgers in a three-game series at Dodger Stadium (July 4-6, 2025), outscoring the Dodgers 29-6 in the three games.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH!: Announced earlier today, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for March/April for his third career AL Player of the Month Award...for the months of March and April, Alvarez batted .356 (42x118) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 27 RBI, 21 walks, 25 runs scored and a 1.199 OPS (.462 OBP/.737 SLG).

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2... **Danny Gonzalez** and **Gene Flores** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast tonight.

YESTERDAY IN BOSTON: The Astros won the rubber game of their three-game series in Boston yesterday with a 3-1 win in 10 innings...**RF Cam Smith** (3x5) was the hero as he connected for the go-ahead single in the 10th...**RHP AJ Blubaugh** (1ER/3.21P) pitched great in relief, working parts of 4.0 innings, while **RHP Bryan Abreu** (0ER/2IP) picked up his first win of the season after tossing scoreless 9th and 10th innings.

HIT PARADE: The Astros, who lead the AL in batting average (.269), have reached double-figures in hits in each of the last six games, hitting .316 (71x225) in that span...the last time the Astros reached double-figures in hits in six straight games was Aug. 6-12, 2024...the club record is eight straight games, done several times (last, June 10-18, 2018)...yesterday marked the 17th game in which Houston reached double figures in hits in 2026.

MLB PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Earlier today, the Astros named **RHP Brandon McPherson** and **C Jason Schiavone** the Astros Minor League Pitcher and Player of the Month for April...McPherson, 26, went 0-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6ER/16.2IP) in four starts in April with Double A Corpus Christi...Schiavone, 23, hit nine home runs and recorded 23 RBI, with 22 walks, seven stolen bases and a 1.050 OPS in 20 games in April with High A Asheville.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have recalled **OF Zach Cole** and designated **OF Daniel Johnson** for assignment...additionally, the club has reinstated **OF Zach Dezenzo** from the Injured List and optioned him to Triple A Sugar Land.

FROM THE TRAINER'S ROOM: The Astros have 13 players on the Major League IL...updates on each:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) continues his bullpen progression in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Hunter Brown** (rt. shoulder sprain) is progressing through his throwing program and is now up to throwing from 120 ft.
- **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (rt. arm fatigue) is scheduled to make his second rehab start tomorrow at Triple A.
- **RHP Cristian Javier** (rt. shoulder strain) will begin a throwing progression this week.
- **LHP Josh Hader** (lt. biceps tendinitis) is scheduled to make his first minor league rehab appearance this week at Triple A Sugar Land.
- **RHP Nate Pearson** (rt. elbow surgery) is scheduled to make his third minor league rehab appearance tomorrow at Triple A Sugar Land.
- **LHP Brandon Walter** (lt. elbow surgery) continues his throwing progression this week in West Palm Beach.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) continues his bullpen progression in West Palm Beach.
- **IF Nick Allen** (mid-back spasms) played in two minor league rehab games over the weekend at Double A Corpus Christi, going 2x7 with a double and two RBI.
- **OF Joey Loperfido** (rt. quad strain) has started light running and light baseball activity.
- **OF Jake Meyers** (rt. oblique strain) has started swinging a bat and doing running and throwing activities.
- **SS Jeremy Peña** (rt. hamstring strain) continued baseball activity in Boston over the weekend...he continues to increase the intensity of his workouts.
- **OF Taylor Trammell** (left groin strain) has begun a running progression and light baseball activity.

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 35 different batting orders in their 35 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **Christian Walker** is hitting .426 (20x51) in his last 12 games (since April 20) with four homers and 10 RBI...for the season, Walker ranks tied for fourth in the AL in RBI (26), fifth in SLG (.579) and sixth in OPS (.975).

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career homers as a second baseman, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...Altuve also needs three RBI to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 900.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/3 at BOS): Picked up his 1st win of the season in yesterday's series-clinching victory at BOS, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings on 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout (22 pitches-15 strikes)...was his longest outing of the season and his 2nd multi-inning scoreless effort of the year (also: 1.1 IP on April 15 vs. COL)...marked his longest scoreless outing since 2.0 scoreless innings on June 29, 2025 vs. CHC...was also his 1st winning decision since June 26, 2025 vs. PHI.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 341.0 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (465) and 7th in apps. (329).

CAREER: In 329 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.90 ERA (110ER/341IP) with 465 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.27 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

NO. 50: Tossed a scoreless 1.0 inning in Game 1 of last Thursday's doubleheader at BAL, marking his 50th career appearance.

MULTI-INNING MAN: Leads AL relievers with 22.0 innings pitched this season...a starter throughout his minor league career, he has 8 multi-inning outings among his 14 appearances this season.

CHANGING THINGS UP: Has tossed his changeup at a 26.2-percent rate, which would be a career-high usage for the pitch...used his changeup at a 19.3-percent rate as a rookie in 2025...has held opponents to a .148 average (4x27) with his changeup this season.

OKERT THE OPENER: Is set to serve as the opener tonight vs. LAD, which will be his 5th career start, all coming as an opener...made his last start on Aug. 5 of last season at MIA, allowing 1 run on 1 hit with 2 strikeouts through 1.2 innings...his 1.2 innings in his start last season marked the longest start of his career.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/3 at BOS): Hurlled a scoreless 1.0 inning while allowing 1 hit with 1 strikeout yesterday at BOS (12 pitches-8 strikes)...is 3 strikeouts away from reaching 350 career strikeouts.

BACK-TO-BACK: Tonight will mark the 1st time an Astros pitcher has appeared in back-to-back team games, with the 2nd game as a starter, since **LHP Rich Scheid** did so on 9/20/1992 and 9/22/1992 at ATL.

LEAGUE LEADER: Among AL relievers, he ranks T-4th in appearances (17).

VS. LAD: owns a 2.18 ERA (5ER/20.2IP), 0.87 WHIP and .189 opponent batting average in 19 career appearances vs. the Dodgers...his 0.87 WHIP ranks 7th all time among relievers with at least 20 career innings pitched vs. the Dodgers...his 2.18 ERA also ranks 4th among active relievers with at least 20 innings vs. LAD.

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 98th percentile in hard-hit percentage (22.2) and 92nd percentile in average exit velocity (85.5 mph).

CAREER: Has pitched parts of 9 Major League seasons (2016-18, 2021-26) with the Giants (2016-18), Marlins (2021-23), Twins (2024) and Astros (2025-26), making 357 career Major League appearances...has 347 strikeouts across 316.1 MLB innings.
