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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles open a seven-game homestand tonight against the Red Sox (4 G) before hosting the Guardians (3 G)...Baltimore wrapped up a 6-3 road trip at the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3-0), and Rockies (1-2) yesterday, but dropped the final two games in Colorado after beginning the trip 6-1...The O's are in the midst of 16 games in as many days since August 25, which will end with an off day following this homestand on September 10...The O's are tied for fourth place in the AL East with the Blue Jays and tied with Texas and Toronto for the final Wild Card spot, 1.5 games behind Cleveland.

👉 O's pitching struck out 17 batters yesterday, matching a season high (also 6/24 at LAA)...The team's only two walks were intentional.

👉 **Luis Robert Jr.** made his team debut, going 1-for-5 with a two-run double in the third inning...He's the first Oriole with at least two RBI in his Orioles debut since **Samuel Basallo** (also 2) on August 17, 2025 at Houston...According to *STATS Perform*, Robert Jr. became the fourth Oriole to start and bat cleanup in his team debut this century, joining Sammy Sosa (4/4/05 vs. OAK), Vladimir Guerrero (4/1/03 at TB), and Mark Trumbo (4/4/16 vs. MIN).

👉 **Blaze Alexander** matched a career high with three hits for the ninth time this season (last: 7/5 at CIN) and for the 12th time in his career yesterday.

👉 **Coby Mayo** has hit safely in a career-high seven straight games since August 25...He's batting .308/.379/.538 (8-for-26) with two homers, seven runs, and eight RBI during that time...Mayo had scored a run in six consecutive games until yesterday.

👉 **Yennier Cano** appeared in his 60th game of the year yesterday...He's the eighth Oriole with four seasons of 60+ games pitched, joining Buddy Groom, Darren O'Day, Jesse Orosco, and B.J. Ryan (all 5), and Jim Johnson, Jorge Julio, and Gregg Olson (also 4).

ROGER THAT: **Trevor Rogers** struck out a career-high 11 batters in 6.2 innings yesterday...It's the second-most strikeouts by an Oriole this year behind **Kyle Bradish's** 12 on June 17 at Seattle and the most punchouts by an O's lefty since John Means recorded 12 in his no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle.

👉 Rogers did not issue a walk, the first Oriole with 11+ strikeouts and no walks since Corbin Burnes on March 28, 2024 (11 K)...Means' no-no on May 5, 2021 at Seattle was the last time a lefty did so.

👉 He struck out six batters in a row from the second out in the fifth inning until the first out of the seventh...Over the last 20 years, only two other Orioles struck out at least six batters in a row: John Means (7) on September 20, 2020 vs. Tampa Bay and Keegan Akin (6) on September 16, 2020 vs. Atlanta.

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (2nd, 92), total bases (3rd, 261), home runs (4th, 32), slugging percentage (5th, .497), OPS (6th, .858), extra-base hits (6th, 56), runs (7-7th, 85), and hits (7-7th, 141).

👉 Alonso has started all 140 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with SF's Rafael Devers, PHI's Bryce Harper, and ATL's Matt Olson...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminer...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

👉 Only HOU's Yordan Alvarez (94) has more RBI in the AL this year...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 35 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (51) and ahead of the White Sox (30) in the AL during that time...The team hit one home run in the Rockies series after having nine in the first six games of the road trip.

👉 The O's have homered in nine straight home games since August 4 (13 total HR), their third such streak of the year...The team hit a home run in season-high 11 straight games at Camden Yards from March 29-April 24, as well as nine straight from July 8-31.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank third in the majors with 523 walks this season behind the Cubs (591 BB) and Brewers (578 BB)...The Yankees rank second in the AL with 502 free passes.

👉 The team's 30 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, tied for second in MLB with the Yankees behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has posted a 1.65 ERA (8 ER/43.2 IP) since August 20, the lowest ERA in the majors during that time, though relievers have surrendered six runs (4 ER) over the last two games.

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 12 appearances (9.2 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5...His streak of 12 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the AL with teammate **Josh Walker**, behind HOU's Josh Hader (19 G), TOR's Mason Fluharty (17 G), and NYY's Paul Blackburn (15 G).

👉 **Yennier Cano** has gone 48 consecutive appearances (36.0 IP) without allowing a home run...It is tied for the third-longest active streak among MLB relievers with LAD's Edgardo Henriquez, behind MIL's Trevor Megill (62 G) and CLE's Colin Holderman (52 G).

👉 Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 46-48 (.489) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the most such games in the majors this year ahead of the Guardians (48-45) and Royals (41-52).

👉 Despite owning a 16-20 (.44) record in one-run affairs this season, the Birds are 6-2 in their last eight games decided by one run since August 14.

PEDAL TO THE METAL: High-A Frederick outfielder **Enddy Azocar** was named the South Atlantic League Player of the Month for August...He slashed .365/.404/.656 (35-for-96) with nine doubles, two triples, five homers, 24 runs, 23 RBI, and seven stolen bases in 23 games for the Keys...Azocar led the league in batting average, hits, and doubles, and was second in runs and total bases (63).

👉 He was acquired from the Red Sox along with six players in exchange for catchers Adley Rutschman and Jake Rogers on August 3.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 24th start of the season and the 36th of his career...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision of a 4-3 (10 inn.) Orioles win on August 28 at the Athletics after tossing a season-high-tying 7.0 innings (4x, last: 7/19 at HOU) of one-run ball on five hits (1 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts...Threw 91 pitches, 65 strikes.
⚡ Has permitted eight home runs over his last six starts (32.2 IP) after allowing six home runs over his previous 14 outings (83.0 IP).

THE SOX: Young made his lone career start vs. Boston earlier this year on April 24 at Camden Yards, where he earned the win after allowing three runs in 5.2 innings on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts.
⚡ He is 2-0 with a 4.08 ERA (18 ER/39.2 IP) in seven career starts against the AL East, during which the O's are 6-1.

SWEET VICTORY: The Orioles are 18-5 (.783) in Young's 23 starts this season...According to *STATS Perform*, it is the sixth time the O's have won at least 18 of a pitcher's first 23 starts of a season...The others were for Dave McNally (1966, 1969), Steve Stone (1980), and Chris Tillman (2013, 2016).
⚡ Young is 9-3 (.750) in 23 starts this season...The .750 winning percentage is third highest in the AL (min. 15 GS) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (.800, 16-4) and TB's Nick Martinez (.765, 13-4).
⚡ According to *STATS Perform*, after going 1-7 (.125) in 2025, his +.625 increase in winning percentage would be the largest in MLB history from a pitcher's first major league season to his second (min. 10 GS each season)...The record currently belongs to George "Stump" Weidman, who went 0-9 in 1880 with the Buffalo Bisons and 8-5 in 1881 with the Detroit Wolverines (+.615).

HOME COOKIN': Young is 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA (26 ER/69.1 IP) across 12 home starts in 2026, with the Birds going 9-3 in those games...Last season he was 0-4 with an 8.72 ERA (31 ER/32.0 IP) in seven home starts, over which the Orioles went 2-5.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .217/.312/.360 (41-for-189) off his four-seam fastball with six doubles, seven home runs, 25 walks, and 33 strikeouts...However, Young allowed a career-high six hits on the pitch in his August 17 start at Tampa Bay, including a career-high two home runs.
⚡ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is tied for the sixth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB, including the highest by a starting pitcher.
⚡ Opponents are slashing .322/.390/.489 (29-for-90) on his sinker with three doubles, four home runs, nine walks, and 10 strikeouts.

WHIFFIN': Young recorded a 9.00 K/9.0 IP from June 21-July 31, tallying five or more strikeouts in a career-high seven consecutive starts...However, held a 6.00 K/9.0 IP with four or fewer strikeouts in each of his five outings this in August...Opened the season with a 6.35 K/9.0 IP over his first 11 starts with five or more strikeouts in five of those games.
⚡ On June 27 at Washington, recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.
⚡ He has tallied 35 of his 103 strikeouts (34.0%) this season on his slider, which opponents are whiffing at 41.0 percent of the time...The 41.7 percent whiff rate is the second-best mark among AL starters (min. 200 sliders thrown) behind TOR's Dylan Cease (43.8%).

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.4 mph and 1,396 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last 17 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .253 (19-for-75) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 15 strikeouts to two walks...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.
