AROUND THE HORN

KELLY’S FIRST BOBBLEHEAD ON SEPT. 12: The team will celebrate a starting rotation mainstay with the Merrill Kelly Bobble courtesy of Casino Arizona & Talking Stick Resort on Sat., Sept. 12 for the first 20,000 fans in attendance.

KPOP DEMON HUNTERS ON SEPT. 13: Fans will want to act fast to ensure they get the exclusive D-backs x KPop Demon Hunters Tee as club’s popular Special Event Ticket Pack series embraces the worldwide phenomenon.

SQUISHY DUMPLINGS ON SEPT. 14-15: The viral sensation D-backs x Mystery Squishy Dumpling will feature four options with the red, teal, white and ultra rare City Connect dumplings with each Special Event Ticket Pack including one of the exclusive, must-have dumplings.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-4 in their last 9 games and 3-2 in their last 5 road games.

- The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 Interleague games.
- Merrill Kelly**, in 4 career starts vs. Astros, has allowed 1 or fewer runs in 3 of those...is making his second career bid @ Astros and first as a D-back.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 games, batting .316 (12-for-38) with 3 RBI, 6 walks and 2 stolen bases...has reached base safely 2+ times in 7 of those games.
 - Geraldo Perdomo** vs. Astros, has recorded hits in 7 straight at-bats since July 22, 2025, with 5 singles and 2 doubles.
- Jordan Lawlar** has a team-leading 3 homers since Aug. 21...in his last 8 starts, is hitting .333 (9-for-27)/1.024 OPS with 3 homers, 6 RBI, 1 HBP and 1 sac bunt.
- Lars Nootbaar** has hit safely in 7 of his 8 road games since Aug. 14, batting .375 (9-for-24)/1.256 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 2 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 1-0 vs. Phillies in the series finale on Wednesday and recorded their third 1-0 shutout of the season.

- The D-backs’ 7 pitchers used marked the most in a 9.0-inning shutout win in franchise history.
- Taylor Clarke** (1.2 IP) made his first opener start since Sept. 3, 2023 and was followed by **Derek Law** (1.1), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0), **José Cabrera** (2.0), **Brandy Garcia** (1.0), **Jonathan Loáisiga** (W, 1.0) and **Juan Morillo** (SV, 1.0), to combine for 3 hits, 1 walk and 9 strikeouts.
- James McCann’s** (5) solo homer in the eighth inning was the eventual game-winner...courtesy Sarah Langs @SlangsOnSports, McCann (36 years and 81 days), became the seventh-oldest catcher since at least 1900 with a homer in a 1-0 game:

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated OF **Tommy Troy** from the 10-day injured list (sprained right AC joint; retro to July 12) and designated OF **Jorge Barrosa** for assignment.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are third in the NL Wild Card race, a 0.5 game ahead of the Padres (season tied 5-5), 5.0 games behind the Cubs (WC2, trail 2-4) and 5.5 games behind the Phillies (WC1, tied 3-3).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 29 wins (29-19) since July 9 are tied for second in the National League with the Brewers (29), behind the Braves (30) and tied for fourth behind the league-leading Red Sox (34).

WORK THE COUNT: The D-backs offense’s 4.02 pitches per plate appearance since Aug. 1 is tied for fourth in the Majors (also: Reds), to the Yankees (4.03), Angels (4.05) and Brewers (4.07).

- Since Aug. 25, the D-backs boast 3 players (Nootbaar/5.00, Perdomo/4.86, Moreno/4.79) in the top 5 in MLB and are the lone team with multiple players in the top 10 [min. 20 PA].

N0000T: Lars Nootbaar has reached base safely in 7 straight games, batting .333 (7-for-21)/1.131 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

- Leads MLB since Aug. 25 [min. 20 PA] with 5.00 pitches/PA, ahead of Jake Bauers/MIL (4.88), **Geraldo Perdomo/AZ (4.86)**, **Gabriel Moreno/AZ (4.79)** and Munetaka Murakami/CWS (4.78).

MUCHO MORILLO: Juan Morillo boasts a career-high 17-game (17.0 IP) scoreless streak, going 1-0 with 2 saves, an opponent .169 AVG (10-for-59)/.461 OPS, 0.94 WHIP, 6 walks and 18 strikeouts...has stranded all 8 of his inherited runners.

- Since July 19, is the lone reliever in the Majors [min. 15 G] with a 0.00 ERA...has allowed just 2 extra-base hits (2 2B) in that span.
- Is scoreless in 9 straight road games (9.0 IP) with an opponent .133 AVG (4-for-30)/.354 OPS, 2 walks and 12 strikeouts.

COMEBACK SNAKES: The D-backs’ 41 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (40).

- Their 20 comeback wins on the road lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (18) and Red Sox (18).

ROAD BATS: Gabriel Moreno, has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 road games, batting .314 (11-for-35)/1.057 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 5 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has reached base 2+ times in 4 of his last 6 road games...has reached base in 18 of his last 20 road games, carrying a .362 OBP (15 H, 16 BB, 3 HBP) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers and 7 RBI.

VS. ASTROS: Last played @ Astros from Sept. 6-8, 2024 and dropped 2 of 3.

- The D-backs secured a 2-game series split @ Astros from Sept. 27-28, 2022.
- The D-backs look to take their first series win @ Astros since Aug. 17-19, 2012.
