## 1-0

The Braves and White Sox combined for just seven hits yesterday afternoon, with Atlanta ultimately falling to Chicago, 1-0.
It marked the first time Atlanta lost a game, $1-0$, since falling by the same score to San Diego on April 19, 2023.
Chicago's only run scored on a solo homer with two outs in the first inning. Atlanta last lost a 9.0 -inning game, $1-0$, with the only run scoring in the first inning on April 6,

1993, also in the city of Chicago.
The Cubs beat the Braves, 1-0, that afternoon despite John Smoltz fanning seven in a complete game.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Pirates tonight open a three-game weekend series with what is the fourth of six scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...Atlanta played three games at PNC Park in Pittsburgh, May 24-26.

A Atlanta dropped two-of-three in that series in Pittsburgh, winning the finale, 8-1, to avoid the series sweep...It marked the first time the Braves lost a series to the Pirates since July of 2021.
A The Braves went 4-3 in seven games versus the Pirates last season, including winning two-of-three here at home.
A Atlanta has won the season set with Pittsburgh every year since 2018 in which they have played, going a combined 26-11 (.703) in that span...That includes a perfect 7-0 record against the Pirates in 2022, one of just three instances in the franchise's modern era that they swept a season series of seven or more games with an opponent.
A The Braves need a sweep this weekend to take the season set, or a series win to split the six games.
A Atlanta has never lost a series to Pittsburgh here at Truist Park, going 17-5 (.773) at home since the facility opened in 2017...The Braves and Pirates split four games in their first series in this building in 2017, and Atlanta has gone 15-3 in the 18 games since.

A LH Martín Pérez has made two starts against Atlanta in his career, combining to go $0-1$ with an 8.00 ERA ( $8 \mathrm{ER} / 9.0 \mathrm{IP}$ )...The 6 -foot- 0 , 200poundVenezuela native pitched against the Braves in the series finale at PNC Park earlier this season, May 26, and allowed four hits and one run over 3.0 innings before leaving the game due to a left groin injury...He was placed on the injured list following that start and has not pitched since.
LOSS: Atlanta tallied just three hits in a 1-0 shutout defeat to Chicago yesterday...The Braves and White Sox were playing a make-up game from a postponement in April, and the loss will officially go down as a onegame series sweep, Atlanta's second time being swept this season.

A The two officially split a two-game series, April 1-2.
A The Braves were shut out for the third time this season, all of which have come since June 5...Only one team in baseball, Detroit, has been blanked more since that date...Atlanta went 182 games without being shut out prior to its defeat on June 5 , the fifth-longest stretch by a team in baseball's modern era.

A LH Chris Sale took the loss despite pitching 7.0 innings, allowing just one run and fanning 11....He is just the fifth pitcher in franchise history to lose with such a line, and the first since Alex Wood took the defeat despite striking out 11 over 8.0 one-run innings on April 22, 2014 vs. Miami.

CHARLIE MORTON: The 6-foot-5, 215-pound right-hander is set to make his second career start against Pittsburgh, for whom he made 142 starts over seven years with the club (2009-2015).
A Morton went $41-62$ with a 4.39 ERA (391 ER/801.0 IP) with the Pirates, fanning 563... Pittsburgh originally acquired him from Atlanta in exchange for Nate McLouth on June 3, 2009.

A He made his only career start against his former team on June 11, 2022 while back with the Braves, and allowed five hits and four runs over 6.0 innings...He fanned 12 in a no-decision in Atlanta's win, 10-4.
A Morton has pitched against one former team already this season, allowing just three hits and one run over 6.0 innings in a win over Tampa Bay on June 15.. He pitched two seasons for the Rays, 2019-20.

A Morton is averaging 9.1 strikeouts per nine innings this season...Only Hall-of-Famers John Smoltz, Nolan Ryan and Randy Johnson, along with Roger Clemens, Luis Tiant and Orlando Hernández, had higher K/9 rates in a season at age 40 or older.
BULLPEN WEEK: RH Daysbel Hernández pitched a scoreless eighth inning yesterday afternoon, the only Atlanta reliever to appear in the game...The Braves' 3.19 ERA (91 ER/256.2 IP) in relief ranks fourth in baseball.
A Atlanta (91 runs) is one of three teams in baseball to allow fewer than 100 runs in relief this season, along with Cleveland (78) and Philadelphia (96)... It's 256.2 total innings are third fewest, more than just Seattle (246.0) and Philadelphia (252.1).

A There are 40 relievers in the National League to make at least 25 appearances and hold an ERA under 3.70, and six have done so for Atlanta (Jesse Chavez, 1.38 - Raisel Iglesias, 2.43 - Joe Jiménez, 2.61 - A.J. Minter, 2.95 - Pierce Johnson, 3.42 Aaron Bummer, 3.67)...That is the most such pitchers on a single team in the NL...LH Dylan Lee has pitched in 24 games and has a 2.20 ERA.
A Additionally, the Braves do not have a single reliever who ranks in the top 80 in appearances in the majors...Raisel Iglesias and Joe Jiménez lead the team with 31 games pitched this season, tied for 86th in baseball.

A Pierce Johnson, Joe Jiménez and Raisel Iglesias pitched the seventh, eighth and ninth innings, respectively, in Game 1 on Wednesday afternoon.. It marked the seventh time this season those three were assigned those respective innings, and Atlanta is a perfect 7-0 when doing so.

FRIDAY NIGHTS: Atlanta opens a weekend series at Truist Park tonight, and is 11-6 on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays in its home park this season... The club is 5-1 at home on Friday nights.

A Atlanta's 5-1 record at home on Friday nights is best in the National League, and behind just Seattle (6-0) in the majors.

A. Set to make his 15 th start of the season and second of his career against Pittsburgh.

A Will be just his second career appearance against his former team.
A Played for the Pirates for seven seasons between 2009-'15, going 41-62 with a 4.39 ERA in 142 starts with the club.
A Was traded from Atlanta to Pittsburgh with Gorkys Hernández and Jeff Locke in exchange for Nate McLouth.
Allowed five runs, five hits through 5.2 innings pitched in his last start while facing New York (AL).
A Morton is averaging 9.1 strikeouts per nine innings this season...Only Hall-ofFamers John Smoltz, Nolan Ryan and Randy Johnson along with Roger Clemens, Luis Tiant and Orlando Hernández had higher $\mathrm{K} / 9$ rates through a season at age 40 or older.
Went 2-0 with a 3.16 ERA in his first five starts this season.
A Has gone 2-4 with a 4.56 ERA in nine starts since.
A His 168 quality starts are the seventh most among active pitchers...teammate Chris Sale ranks fifth with 178.
A His 2039.2 innings pitched are the fourth most among active pitchers.
A Trails only Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer and Clayton Kershaw.
A Struckout Wyatt Langford to reach 1,900 on his career.
A Morton's 1,1956 strikeout are the eighth most among active players.
A Teammate Chris Sale ranks fourth with 2,296.
A Throwing his curveball on $40.0 \%$ of pitches; the highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
A Morton has struck out 447 hitters with his curveball since the beginning of the 2020; easily the most in the majors.
( Morton has recorded 684 strikeouts since joining Atlanta's staff in 2021, the seventh most in baseball.
A His rate of 10.25 strikeouts per nine innings is also the sixth highest in the majors during that span among qualifed pitchers.

## 2024 Recap

A With his first start this season, Morton became the seventh player in Braves franchise history to pitch for the club in his 20's, 30 's and 40 's...Joins Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn, Phil Niekro, Tom Glavine and John Smoltz along with teammate Jesse Chavez and Dick Rudolph.
A Morton became the 13th player in franchise history to start a game at age 40 or older.
A Prior to Morton, the last Braves pitcher to start a game over the age of 40 was R.A. Dickey in 2017

A Six of the 12 other pitchers have been selected into the Hall of Fame (Tom Glavine, Phil Niekro, Gaylord Perry, John Smoltz, Warren Spahn and Cy Young).
At 40 years, 167 days-old in his start against Cleveland on April 17, became the fifth Braves pitcher over the age of 40 , in the Atlanta-era (since 1966), to toss at least 7.0 scoreless frames, joining Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro (11x) and John Smoltz (3x), along with Dennis Martínez and R.A. Dickey.
A Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998. (Research courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau)

A Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
A Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013,'14 \& '16) ...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the 2018 Fall Classic with Boston.
t Morton's 3.14 ERA to open the season was the lowest in Atlanta frahcnise history for pitcher's above the age of 40 through their first seven starts since Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro and Gyalord Perry in 1981.

A A 16-year major league veteran, entered the 2024 season with a 130-113 record and a 4.00 ERA across 353 games, 352 starts...Fanned 1,880 and pitched three shutouts.
A Has pitched for Atlanta (2008, '21-23), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).

A Is a two-time All-Star (2018 \& 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston and 2021 World Series with Atlanta.
