TODAY'S GAME: The Giants return home to Oracle Park, where they will open a six-game, seven-day homestand this afternoon with the first of three games against the Cardinals.

- ▶ SF and St. Louis are facing each other for the first time in 2026 and the entire season series will take place over the span of 10 days as the Giants travel to St. Louis next Monday-Wednesday.
- ▶ The Giants are searching for their first series win over the Cardinals since sweeping a three-game set in June 2023...according to *Stats, LLC*, each of the last five games between these teams have all been decided by a single run, the longest such streak in the Giants-Cardinals series since 1982 (seven straight).
- ▶ SF has lost the season series to St. Louis in nine of the last 10 seasons they've played (excl. 2020) dating to 2015...SF's only season series win came in 2023 (6-1).
- ▶ Lastly, SF needs to win four of its final 18 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in franchise history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **RHP Braxton Roxby** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Philip Abner** (#57) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

HOME, SWEET HOME: SF's pitching has fared much better here at home this season, allowing a .355 slugging percentage compared to a .422 clip on the road...according to *Stats, LLC*, the only larger difference in MLB is by the White Sox (0.69 difference; home better than road).

- ▶ Overall, the Giants have won five of their last nine games here at home and are 20-16 in their last 36 games at Oracle Park dating to June 14.

HE GETS ON BASE...: Yesterday, **IF Bryce Eldridge** extended his on-base streak to 15 games, tied for the third-longest active such streak in the Majors behind PIT's Bryan Reynolds (17) and LAD's Mookie Betts (16)...it's Eldridge's second 15+ game on-base streak this season after a career-best 22-game on-base streak from May 23-June 17.

- ▶ Eldridge is the first Giants rookie with multiple on-base streaks of 15+ games within the same season since **Orlando Cepeda** had two 15-game stretches in 1958.
- ▶ Giants rookies have a .327 OBP this season, sixth-best in the Majors and third-best in the NL behind the Rockies (.361) and Brewers (.330).

WEBBMASTER: **RHP Logan Webb** will look to bounce back from his most recent start today as he makes his return to Oracle Park...Webb has a 3.39 ERA (32er, 85.0ip) and .581 opponents OPS in 13 starts at home compared to a 5.29 ERA (38er, 64.2ip) and .730 OPS in 12 starts on the road.

- ▶ Webb has gone at least 6.0 innings in each of his last nine home starts...according to *Stats, LLC*, that is the longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ He has a 0.82 WHIP at home since June 1, second best among pitchers with 40+ innings at home behind MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (0.71).
- ▶ Since 2021, Webb's 2.88 ERA at home is fourth-best in the Majors (min. 60 GS).

40 FOR RAFI?: **IF Rafael Devers** is coming off an epic road trip where he homered six times in seven games in Atlanta (one), Pittsburgh (two), and Queens (three) for a 1.154 slugging percentage...he is now five homers shy of becoming the fourth Giant with a 40-HR season in the last 56 years (*see chart on the right*).

- ▶ Devers is now a double shy of a 35-homer, 35-double season...the last Giant to accomplish that feat in a season was Hall of Famer **Jeff Kent** in 2002.
- ▶ He's also trying to chase down the 100-RBI mark, something no Giant has done since **Buster Posey** drove in 103 runs in 2012...the last Giants infielder to do it was Kent in 2002 (108).
- ▶ Devers is slashing .351/.455/.689 in 20 career games against the Cardinals...it's his highest career OBP against any single opponent, his second-highest AVG (.356 vs. Cubs) and his third-highest slugging percentage.
- ▶ Devers is 3-for-5 with two homers in his career vs. Cardinals starter Michael McGreevy.

GOLD GLOVE: 2025 | ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025, 2026

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Surrendered a career-high nine runs on Tuesday at Pittsburgh...Webb left the game after just 2.0 innings, marking his second-shortest career start (threw 1.1ip on July 22, 2023 at WSH) ...overall, he gave up nine hits with two walks, two hit batters and a strikeout in the outing (65 pitches)...batters were 5-for-7 off his changeup and are 10-for-23 (.435) vs. the pitch over his last four starts (since August 15).

VS. ST. LOUIS: Will face the Cardinals for the ninth time in his career...in eight career starts vs. St. Louis, Webb is 3-3 with a 5.19 ERA (25er, 43.1ip), 38 strikeouts and a .314 BAA...last faced them on September 23 of last season, tossing 6.0 innings with three runs on eight hits, a pair of walks and six strikeouts.

HOME, SWEET HOME: Returns to Oracle Park today where he has a 3.39 ERA (32er, 85.0ip) and .581 opponents OPS in 13 starts at home this season, compared to a 5.29 ERA (38er, 64.2ip) and .730 OPS in 12 starts on the road...overall, Webb is 43-29 with a 2.92 ERA in 103 career games (100 starts) at Oracle Park compared to a 4.10 ERA in 102 starts on the road...since 2021, Webb's 2.88 ERA at home is fourth-best in the Majors (min. 60 GS).

STAYGROUNDED: Has a 51.5% ground ball rate this season, fourth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.6%), DET's Framber Valdez (55.3%) and TOR's José Soriano (52.3%).

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 9-16 in Webb's 25 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago...since 2022, SF as a team is 76-81 in Webb's 157 starts, yet his 3.37 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

SWEEP IT UNDER: Since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, Webb has been limiting batters to a .167 (10x60) average with one extra-base hit (HR) and 17 strikeouts via his sweeper.

WORKHORSE: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 967.2 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framber Valdez, who has logged 918.1 innings...Webb's 101 quality starts and 156 total games started since 2022 are most in MLB over that span.

SINK OR SWIM: His most used pitch is his sinker, which he throws 28.9% of the time...Webb's sinker has a +12 run value this season, his highest value of any pitch since 2024, when he finished the year with a +17 run value on his sinker...batters are hitting .232 with a .346 slugging percentage off his sinker this season...they had a .294 BAA and .438 SLG with the pitch in 2025.

IN PLAY...: Has struck out 119 batters in 149.2 innings this season...Webb's 19.2% strikeout rate is down from 26.2% last season and currently his lowest in any full season (excluding 2020).

DAMAGE CONTROL: Opponents are slashing .315/.337/.506 with three triples, a pair of homers and a .843 OPS on the first pitch of an at-bat...after falling behind 0-1, however, they are slashing just .195/.227/.300 (.527 OPS).
