AROUND THE HORN

SIX NON-PROFITS SURPRISED WITH OVER \$1 MILLION THRU 2026 KEN KENDRICK GRAND SLAM AWARDS: Six Arizona-based nonprofits - Arizona Educational Foundation, Delivering Dreams Arizona, Foundation for Blind Children, Keys to Change, Phoenix Public Library Foundation and Southwest Human Development - were surprised with a combined \$1 million in grant funding through the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 2026 Ken Kendrick Grand Slam Awards...established in 2002, this signature grant program has awarded more than \$13.8 million to organizations across Arizona, supporting transformative, large-scale projects that drive long-term change by improving operations and strengthening communities.

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs look to secure their first road series in today's rubber match @ Mets.

- **Corbin Carroll** has driven in or scored 18 of the club's 45 runs, accounting for 40 pct., the highest of any player in the Majors [source: MLB Research].
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** and **Nolan McLean** face off today for the first time since starting for their respective countries in the WBC Championship between Team Venezuela and Team USA on March 17.
- D-backs hitters have had runners in scoring position for 10+ plate appearances in each of the last 3 games, hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.965 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 16 RBI, 4 walks and 6 strikeouts.
- Among NL teams, the D-backs rotation's 3.02 ERA (21 ER in 62.2 IP) ranks fourth best, behind the Cubs (2.72), Braves (2.79) and Pirates (2.87).
 - 21 earned runs are the NL's third fewest, behind the Cubs (18) and Pirates (19).
 - 1.75 earned runs per game average is the NL's fourth lowest, behind the Cubs (1.50), Pirates (1.58) and Braves (1.69).
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 43 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the longest active streak in the Majors, ahead of Chandler Simpson/TB (34).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-2 @ Mets yesterday on a season-high-tying 11 hits and 5 extra-base hits.

- **Ryne Nelson** earned the win after allowing 1 run over 5.2 frames with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts.
- **Corbin Carroll** had his second 3-hit effort in the last 3 games with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI and a season-high-tying 7 total bases.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** went 3-for-4 to extend his hitting streak to 6 straight games.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** reached base 3 times, with a single and 2 walks, and had a sac fly.
- **Jorge Barrosa** had a 2-run double and **Ketel Marte** had a RBI single.
- **Ryan Thompson, Andrew Hoffmann** and **Taylor Clarke** combined to allow 1 run over 3.1 innings with 3 hits, 1 walk and 2 strikeouts.

CARROLL'S 500TH GAME: **Corbin Carroll** played his 500th career game yesterday.

- Is the only player in history with 80+ homers, 40+ triples and 120+ stolen bases in his first 500 games.
- Is 1 of 4 players in MLB history with 80+ homers and 40+ triples (84/46) in their first 500 games (also: Lou Gehrig 94/52, Joe DiMaggio 120/46 and Willie Mays 120/41).

RE-WRITING THE RECORDS: **Corbin Carroll** yesterday tied David Peralta (46) for second most triples in franchise history and now trails Stephen Drew (52).

- Is 1 stolen base from surpassing Paul Goldschmidt (124) for second most stolen bases in club history, behind Tony Womack (182).

IN RELIEF: D-back relievers, in their last 5 games, have a 2.37 ERA (7 R-5 ER in 19.0 IP), opponent .191 AVG/.517 OPS, 2 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- **Ryan Thompson** has not allowed an earned run in his first 7 appearances (4.2 IP), with 2 hits, 3 walks and 2 strikeouts.

STAY HOT: **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 9 of his last 10 games, hitting .382 (13-for-34)/1.287 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 triples, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in his first 6 games at a .500 clip (10-for-20)/1.324 OPS, including 3 multi-hit efforts, with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely 14 times (10 H, 4 BB) in his last 11 games, with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.

A TOUGH K: D-back hitters' 81 strikeouts are the fewest in the Majors, ahead of the Marlins (93), Mets (98), Braves (99), Cardinals (99) and Nationals (99).

SAVING RUNS: The D-backs' 17 defensive runs saved (DRS) lead the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (14), Mets (14) and Braves (13).

- **Alek Thomas'** 4 DRS are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Cole Young /SEA), behind Cody Bellinger/NYY (5), while **Ketel Marte's** 3 DRS are tied for second (also: 14 others).

VS. METS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 games @ Mets since June 1, 2024.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 8 straight games since April 29, 2025, hitting .308 (8-for-26)/.873 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Alek Thomas** has reached base safely in 4 straight games, hitting .357 (5-for-14)/.829 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI and 1 walk since May 1, 2025.

ON DECK @ PHILLIES: Following tonight's game, the D-backs head to Philadelphia for a 3-game set...last season, they split the season series 3-3...the D-backs are 3-1 in their last 4 games vs. Phillies since May 4.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MICHAEL SOROKA (2-0, 0.90)

- Has allowed just 1 run in his first 2 starts (1 ER in 10.0 IP, 8 H, 4 BB, 13 K).
- Earned the 2-1 win in his last start on April 4 vs. Braves (1 ER in 5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 BB).
- Earned the 9-6 win in his D-backs debut on March 30 vs. Tigers after recording a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts over 5.0 scoreless innings, which included an immaculate fifth inning.
