RAY MATTER—The Rays have lost three of their last 4 games following a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak...the Rays would need a win today to avoid a .500 record for the 10th time in 38 games...while the Rays are 6-3 in their last 9 games, they are 6-6 in their last 12 and 9-10 in their last 19...with last night's loss, the Rays fell to 4th place in the AL East but remained 3 GB of the first-place Red Sox...the 2nd-place Yankees, 3rd-place Blue Jays and 4th-place Rays are all within a game of each other.

- + Tonight the Rays continue a 6-game homestand against the Yankees (0-1) and Mets (3)...the Rays are 7-11 at Tropicana Field this season after going 20-9 last season...they are 1-3-1 in home series after going 6-0-4 last season, and their only home series win this season came against the Yankees from April 9-11 (2-1)...the Rays have suffered back-to-back losing homestands for the first time since they went 2-4 from July 21-26, 2017 and 2-7 from Aug 4-13, 2017.
- + The Rays have 13 players on the injured list, tying the single-game club record...this season the Rays have used 38 players (tied for 4th in majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd) and 11 starting pitchers (2nd).
- + The Rays have nine comeback wins this season, overcoming a season-high 3-run deficit in 4 games...they have blown a lead in eight of their losses, tying their total from the shortened 2020 season.
- + The Rays have used 36 different batting orders in 37 games.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—Last night the Rays were limited to 1 run on a **Mike Zunino** solo homer in the 3rd inning...all 5 runs scored by the Rays over the last 2 games have come on homers (3-run, solo, solo)...this season the Rays rank 7th in the AL in runs scored (154), 11th in avg. (.219), 11th in on-base pct. (.301) and 11th in homers (38)...the .219 avg. would be the lowest mark in franchise history, passing the shortened 2020 season (.238).

- + The Rays have scored 1 run (or fewer) eight times this season, tied for 3rd-most in the majors, compared to six times in the abbreviated 2020 season (tied for 3rd-fewest in the majors)...the Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 24 of 37 games (64.9 pct.), tied with the Athletics and Orioles for the most such games among AL clubs.
- + The Rays have struck out a major-league-most 384 times, ahead of the Rangers (374)...the Rays are on pace for 1,681 SO, which would be a major league record ahead of the 2019 Tigers (1,595)...the Rays have a majors-most 25 games of reaching double-digit strikeouts.
- + In the last 4 games, the Rays have combined for 9 runs on 20 hits, 4 HR and 8 BB and are batting .155 (20-for-129) over that stretch.
- + The Rays are batting .205 (120-for-586) at home, 29th in the majors ahead of Seattle (.184)...they have scored 2 runs (or fewer) in five of their last 6 games at Tropicana Field and seven of their last nine.
- + In the last 7 games, opposing starters have a 1.52 ERA (41.1-IP, 7-ER) against the Rays...in the last 9 games, opposing starters have a 2.70 ERA (50-IP, 15-ER) and bullpens have a 6.00 ERA (30-IP, 20-ER).

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—This season the Rays are batting .200 (62-for-310) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the Brewers at .209...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP in major league history was .210 by the 1981 Mets, and the lowest in AL history was .217 by the 1988 Orioles...with RISP and 2 outs, the Rays are batting .151 (22-for-146), last in the majors (29th: Nationals, .162)...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP and 2 out in major league history was .173 by the 2011 Giants.

- + This season the Rays are batting .139 (19-for-137) with RISP at Tropicana Field, compared to .249 (43-for-173) with RISP on the road...they have 5 hits in their last 70 AB with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 109 times with RISP, most in the AL and tied for most in the majors...**Willy Adames** is tied for 2nd in the majors with 15 SO with RISP; **Randy Arozarena** is tied for 5th (14).

THREE TRUE OUTCOMES—The Rays rank 11th in the AL with 38 HR, 3rd in the AL with 128 BB and lead the majors with 384 SO...the Rays are 17-9 in games with a home run, 8-1 when hitting multiple homers and 2-9 when held without a homer...39.2 pct. (550 of 1,401) of their plate appearances have resulted in a homer, walk or strikeout, the 4th-highest rate in the majors behind the Giants (40.0 pct.), Tigers (39.9) and Cubs (39.6).

- + Last season the Rays were held without a homer 19 times but went 14-5 (.737) in those games, the highest winning pct. since the 1906 Cubs went 99-34 (.744) in homerless games...their 14 wins without the benefit of a homer last season were the most in the majors.
- + **Mike Zunino's** solo homer last night went 472 feet, the 2nd-longest by a Ray in the StatCast era (since 2015) behind **Avisail Garcia** (485) on May 14, 2019 at MIA...it was the longest at Tropicana Field (Rays

or visitor) in the StatCast era and tied for the 4th-longest in Tropicana Field history (see Page 281 of the 2021 Rays Media Guide).

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays rank 11th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.76 ERA (333-IP, 139-ER)...the Rays have pitched to a 2.84 ERA (88.2-IP, 28-ER) in their last 10 games and a 2.91 ERA (151.2-IP, 49-ER) in their last 17 games...last night was the sixth time this season the Rays lost when allowing 3 runs (or fewer), tied for 3rd in the majors behind the Tigers (8) and Marlins (7)...all 6 losses have come since April 25 vs. TOR.

- + The Rays have yielded 3 runs (or fewer) 21 times this season, tied for most in the AL and tied for 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (23)...this includes seven of the last 8 games and 14 of the last 17.
- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.30 ERA (270.1-IP, 99-ER) in 30 games, which ranks 7th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.58 ERA (80.1-IP, 23-ER) in the last 18 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.83...since April 10, the bullpen is 9th in the majors with a 3.15 ERA (137-IP, 48-ER) in 30 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 59 runs in the 7th inning or later, 7th-most in the majors...however, in the last 18 games the Rays have allowed 14 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games...these 59 runs are three shy of matching their total from the abbreviated 2020 season...the Rays have yielded 4 HR in the 7th inning, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras.
- + The Rays are 10-10 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 5-6 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

PITCHING PLANS—Tonight's game will be started by **Collin McHugh**, his second start of the season (Thurs at LAA)...in his last start he retired all 6 BF including 5 SO (all swinging), his most since a start of 5.2 IP on April 26, 2019 vs. CLE (9, with HOU)...tonight is the seventh time this season the Rays are using an opener (4-2) and third time against the Yankees (1-1)...including postseason, since the debut of the opener on May 19, 2018, the Rays have used one 114 times and are 69-45 (.605) in those games.

RAYS vs. YANKEES—Tonight the Rays are attempting to avoid back-to-back losses to the Yankees (including postseason) for the first time since July 16-18, 2019 at NYY (0-3)...the Rays are 5-2 against the Yankees this season (2-2 at home, 3-0 on the road) and 14-16 against all other opponents...most recently, the Rays swept a 3-game series at Yankee Stadium (April 16-18)...it marked the fourth sweep of 3 games (or more) at Yankee Stadium in franchise history, following Aug 18-20, 2020 (3-0), June 30-July 2, 2014 (3-0) and Sep 24-26, 2013 (3-0)...said another way, it was their second sweep in the last three series at Yankee Stadium, compared to two sweeps in 51 series of 3 games (or more) in the Bronx from 1998-2019.

- + The Rays have won six consecutive regular-season series over the Yankees, extending the longest such streak in franchise history...it marks the longest streak in the majors since the Blue Jays won six straight series against them from 2015-16, according to Stats LLC.
- + The Rays have outscored them, 37-23, this season...Rays pitching has held them to 3 runs (or fewer) in four consecutive games.
- + Since Sep 24, 2019, the Rays are 15-4 against them in the regular season with a +32 run differential (90-58)...tonight is the eighth of 19 meetings between the two clubs this season, which includes 16 in advance of the trade deadline...the Rays and Yankees end the regular season facing each other in a 3-game series in the Bronx.

FROM THE OTHER SIDE—Including postseason, tonight will be the seventh time the Rays face **Gerrit Cole** since he signed with the Yankees in December 2019...the Rays are 4-2 in those games, most recently a 4-2 win on April 18 in the Bronx, and Cole is 1-2 with a 3.97 ERA (34-IP, 15-ER)...his win came in Game 1 of the 2020 ALDS at Petco Park (6-IP, 3-ER, 2-HR).

- + Since Aug 19, 2020, the Rays have won three straight regular-season games when facing Cole, and Cole has never defeated the Rays in the regular season...he is 0-4 with a 3.91 ERA (48.1-IP, 21-ER) in eight career starts vs. TB, while his teams are 3-5 in those games.
