**TIGERS SHUT OUT IN OPENER IN CHICAGO:** The Tigers lost the series opener to the White Sox, 3-0, last night. Making his Major League debut, Reese Olson threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits with a walk and six strikeouts. Mason Englert pitched 1.1 scoreless innings in relief, while Will Vest threw a shutout inning. Offensively, Javier Báez had two hits, including a triple, while Miguel Cabrera, Eric Haase, Andy Ibáñez and Spencer Torkelson each had one hit.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** Alex Lange was named American League Reliever of the Month on Friday, earning the award for the first time in his career and becoming the second Tiger to win the award, joining Shane Greene (April, 2019). Lange made 10 appearances during May, posting a 2-0 record with seven saves, a 0.84 ERA (10.2IP/1ER) and 17 strikeouts. He ranked tied for second in the AL in saves during the month, while he was third in opponent batting average (.091) and eighth in ERA among AL relievers (min. 10 innings pitched).

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Reese Olson was impressive in his Major League debut last night, giving up two runs on two hits with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings. Olson carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning until allowing a single to Romy Gonzalez. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Olson became the first Tigers pitcher to throw at least 5.0 no-hit innings in his debut since Bill Slayback pitched 7.0 hitless innings on June 26, 1972 vs. New York (AL). Olson became the second Major League pitcher to do so in 2023, joining Seattle's Bryce Miller, who worked 5.1 no-hit innings on May 2 at Oakland.

**MIGGY NEARING DAVE WINFIELD ON ALL-TIME HITS LIST:** Miguel Cabrera went 1x2 with a walk in last night's game. Cabrera's hit was the 3,107th of his Major League career. He enters today's game just three hits shy of tying Dave Winfield for 22nd on the all-time hits list.

**TIGERS AND WHITE SOX:** The Tigers and White Sox continue their season series today. Detroit has won three of the first five meetings from Chicago (AL) this season. The White Sox went 12-7 against the Tigers last season, but the two sides split 10 meetings at Guaranteed Rate Field.

**AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** The Tigers continue divisional play today against the White Sox. Detroit is 9-5 against American League Central teams so far this season, winning all four of its

series against divisional opponents. The Tigers have finished below .500 against AL Central foes in each of the last five 162-game seasons, including a 34-42 record last season.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Tigers are 0-1 on their current six-game road trip, which includes three games at Chicago (AL) (0-1) and three games at Philadelphia (June 5-7). Detroit is 12-16 on the road this season, but has won four of its last five road series. As a team, the Tigers are hitting .224/.298/.344 away from Comerica Park, while the pitching staff has a 4.41 ERA (243.0IP/119ER).

- Lorenzen will make his ninth start of the season today at Chicago (AL).
- Did not factor into the decision in his most recent start last Saturday against the White Sox, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing two unearned runs on two hits with a walk and four strikeouts...carried a perfect game until two outs in the sixth inning when Romy Gonzalez singled to center.
- Allowed one earned run or less in four of his five starts during May, compiling a 2-1 record with a 1.95 ERA (32.1IP/7ER) and 20 strikeouts...among qualified Major League pitchers in May, he ranked tied for sixth in ERA and ninth in WHIP (0.87).
- Has faced the White Sox seven times in his career, including four starts, posting a 1-0 record with a 2.79 ERA (29.0IP/9ER) and 19 strikeouts... in three career outings, including two starts, at Guaranteed Rate Field, he has a 1-0 record with a 3.60 ERA (15.0IP/6ER) and four strikeouts.

- Went 1x3 with a RBI and a walk on April 1 at Tampa Bay...the hit was the 3,090th of his career, passing Ichiro Suzuki for 23rd in MLB history.
- The 2023 season marks the 21st of his decorated Major League career...one of the best hitters of his generation, Cabrera is among the leaders of active players (min. 800 games) in many offensive categories, including first in batting average (.307), hits (3,107), doubles (611), home runs (507), RBI (1,854) and runs scored (1,534), second in walks (1,238) and sixth in on-base percentage (.383) and seventh in slugging percentage (.521).
