They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 120-67 (.642) since 2022 during Interleague Play, which marks the best record in the majors....the team has gone 18-9 (.667) against American League opponents in 2026.

Kyle-ing On

Kyle Harrison is 6-0 with a 0.91 ERA over his last 7 starts with opponents batting just .189 (27-for-143, 2hr)....Harrison has a 0.91 WHIP during this stretch while producing 55 strikeouts and 9 walks in 39.2 innings pitched.

THIS EVENING'S GAME: Is the fourth game [3-0] of a 6-game road trip to Colorado (3-0) and Las Vegas (3g)....following an off day on Thursday, the team will return to American Family Field for a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Philadelphia (3g) and Cleveland (3g)....the next road trip will cover 6 games from 6/19-6/24 against Atlanta (3g) and Cincinnati (3g).

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Zerpa is on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (387g, 230-157, .594) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (74 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 36, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 5.0 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 14-5-2 in series play....the team is 9-1-2 over its last 12 series with its only loss coming to the Dodgers from 5/22-5/24 (1-2).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 21-13 at home, going 7-3-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 19-10 on the road, going 7-2-1 in series play....the team is 11-2 in its last 13 road games with a current 4-game winning streak, tying a season high [also 5/18-5/29].

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 21 replay challenges this season, going 16-5....their last challenge (lost) came on 5/30 at Houston as a safe call at home plate involving Cam Smith stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25)....missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 803 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (895), Astros (836) and Yankees (826).

HARRISON AT A GLANCE: Kyle Harrison, 24, will be making his 12th start of the 2026 season.....Harrison last started last Tuesday vs. San Francisco and earned an 8-3 win (5.2ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 12k, 1hr, 106 pitches).....the team is 9-2 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .205 (43-for-210, 4hr).....he is 6-0 with a 0.91 ERA in his last 7 starts (39.2ip, 27h, 4r, 4er, 9bb, 55k, 2hr).....he tossed 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings from 5/14-6/2.....he was acquired from Boston with LHP Shane Drohan and INF David Hamilton on February 9 for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection.

LAST SEASON: Harrison went 1-1 with a 4.04 ERA in 11 games/6 starts between San Francisco (8g, 4gs) and Boston (3g, 2gs).....he was traded to Boston on June 15 as part of the deal that sent INF/DH Rafael Devers to the Giants.....Harrison also went 5-2 with a 3.66 ERA in 18 starts between Triple-A Sacramento (6gs) and Triple-A Worcester (12gs).

CAREER: Is 16-10 with a 3.75 ERA in 53 games/48 starts (252ip, 232h, 110r, 105er, 83bb, 264k, 34hr).....is in his fourth Major League season pitching for San Francisco (2023-25), Boston (2025) and Milwaukee (2026).....was selected by San Francisco in the third round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of De La Salle (CA) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-2 with a 2.43 ERA in 8 starts (40.2ip, 11er).....is 4-1 with a 1.50 ERA in 7 starts this season (36ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 7-7 with a 3.95 ERA in 26 games/23 starts (123ip, 54er).....is 3-0 with a 1.69 ERA in 4 starts this season (21.1ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. ATHLETICS: His only career outing against the A's came with the Red Sox in relief on 9/10/25 at Sutter Health Park in Sacramento (3ip, 3h, 0r, 0bb, 2k, 1hbp).

ODDS & ENDS: Harrison committed to play at UCLA prior to being drafted.....his younger brother, Connor "Bear" Harrison, is a junior catcher at Texas A&M.....his grandfather, Skip Guinn, pitched in the Major Leagues with Atlanta (1968) and Houston (1969 and 1971).....Harrison enjoys hiking, golf, traveling and cooking.
